Outlaw jailed for 17 years

A Pabna court on Wednesday sentenced an outlaw to 17 years rigorous imprisonment for possessing illegal firearm and ammunition.

Md Imran Hossain Chowdhury, additional district judge-2, pronounced the verdict in a crowded courtroom.

The convict is Kamal Hossain, alias Kamal, 32, son of Abdul Hamid of village Sonatola under Ataikula Police Station.

Police arrested Kamal on December 27, 2011 and recovered a gun and four bullets from his possession.

10 prosecution witnesses gave their statements before the court, court sources said.

After examining the witnesses, the court pronounced the verdict, said assistant public prosecutor advocate Jahid Rana.

Bhola mayor sues three youths for stalking college girls

Bhola Municipality Mayor on Wednesday night filed a case against three youths on charge of stalking four college girls in Kalibari area of the town on Monday.

Mayor Mohammad Moniruzzaman filed the case with Sadar Police Station, accusing Antar, 19, son of Abdur Razzak, Ismail Hossain Jony, 27, son of Zakir Hossain, and

Arman Hossain, 21, of the town.

Police said the accused, riding a motorcycle, teased four college girls while they were returning to their respective houses from a coaching centre at Kalibari Road around 6:00pm on Monday evening.

As some cultural activists, who were passing through the area, protested stalking of the girls,

the youths also harassed them.

Later, they informed the municipality mayor of the incident over cell-phone and sought his help in this regard, said Mobassher Ali, officer-in-charge of Sadar Police Station.

The stalkers went into hiding soon after filing of the case, the OC said, adding that law enforcers already launched a drive to arrest the accused.

Robbers kill one, injure 3 in Satkhira

A youth was killed and three others were injured in an attack by armed robbers at Pirojpur village in Kaliganj upazila of Satkhira district early yesterday.

The deceased is Saddam Hossain, 25, son of Yusuf Ali Majhi of the village, reports our correspondent.

Shahidul Islam, brother-in-law of Saddam, said they decided to guard their house following an attack by robbers on Tuesday night.

When they were guarding the house, they saw a gang of 4/5 at their garden around

2:00am yesterday.

At one stage, Saddam caught a member of the gang while they were fleeing. The detainee started stabbing Saddam indiscriminately, leaving him dead on the spot.

The robber also attacked other members of the family, leaving three people injured when they came forward to help Saddam.

The injured were rushed to Satkhira Sadar Hospital. Of them, Ashraf Hossain and his mother Momena Khatun were stated to be critical.

The body was sent to Satkhira Sadar Hospital

morgue for autopsy, said Officer-in-Charge of Kaliganj Police Station Subhash Biswas, adding that police are raiding different areas to arrest the attackers.

In Pirojpur, the law enforcers arrested an alleged robber with a pipe gun and three bullets at his house in Bhandaria upazila town of the district on Tuesday night.

The arrestee is Mantu Kabiraz, 38, son of Azhar Kabiraz of the town, reports our correspondent.

He is an accused in eight cases, including those for robbery and drug peddling, said police.

Alleged mugger killed in mob beating

An alleged mugger was killed in a mob beating in Dasherhat area of Subarnachar upazila town in the district yesterday.

The deceased was identified as Md Babul, 28, son of Abul Majhi of Char Jublee village, said police.

Nizam Uddin, officer-in-charge of Char Jabbar Police Station, said Babul along with his accomplice hired a motorbike at Bhumihin Bazar for going to the town at around 12:30am.

When they reached

Dasherhat area, the duo stabbed the motorbike driver, Nuruzzaman, to take away the vehicle.

Hearing screams, locals rushed to the spot, caught Babul red-handed and gave him a good beating. However, his cohort managed to flee the scene.

Injured Babul and the motorbike driver were later sent to the upazila health complex where he died in the morning.

The body was sent to Noakhali Abdul Malek Ukil Medical College Hospital morgue for autopsy, said the OC, adding that a case was filed in this connection.

Housewife murdered

A housewife was killed allegedly by her nephew in C&B Ghat area under Kurigram municipality yesterday. The deceased is Abeya Khatun, 55, wife of Ahad Ali of the area. Police and family sources said Janu, 30, son of Umed Ali of the area, killed his aunt Abeya Khatun following an altercation over a family matter in the afternoon. Janu's parents were also injured during the incident. The law enforcers arrested Janu in this connection, said Assistant Superintendent of Police Masud Alam.

Prisoner dies

A prisoner of the district jail died of heart attack at a hospital on Wednesday evening. The deceased is Abdul Mannan, 48, son of late Barkat Ullah of Patgram village in Patgram upazila. He was taken to the prison in a drug case filed with Patgram Police Station on April 27 this year, said jail sources. Mannan suffered a heart attack at the jail and then died at Lalmonirhat Sadar Hospital, said the sources.

Minor girl raped

A 12-year-old girl was raped allegedly by her cousin in Shyamoli residential area under Srimangal upazila of the district on Wednesday evening. The accused is Kadir Miah, 28, son of Mizan Miah. Locals said Kadir raped the girl at their house in absence of her parents. As she cried for help, locals rushed to the spot and rescued the girl. However, Kadir managed to flee the scene. The victim was sent to the upazila health complex. Police are raiding different areas to arrest the culprit, said Md Abdul Jalil, officer-in-charge of Srimangal Police Station.

Schoolgirl found dead

Police recovered the body of an eight-year-old girl from a field at Panchakala village in Bera upazila of the district yesterday. The deceased, Mim, daughter of Abdul Mazid of the village, was a student of Class I at a local primary school, said Moshir Rahman, officer-in-charge of Bera Police Station. Police said Mim went out of their house on Wednesday morning and remained missing since then. Locals spotted her body wrapped in a sack and informed the police. Being informed police went to the spot, recovered the body and sent it to Pabna Medical College Hospital for autopsy.
