The Walking Dead alum Jon Bernthal is joining another high-profile genre series, Marvel's Daredevil. Bernthal is set to play The Punisher, one of Marvel's most popular characters, in the second season of the Netflix series. Season 2 of Marvel's Daredevil, the first of four Marvel series for Netflix, will be released in 2016. Bernthal joins Cox and co-stars Vincent D'Onofrio, Deborah Ann Woll, Elden Henson and Rosario Dawson.
