

CHIRIRBANDAR UPAZILA IN DINAJPUR

5,095 students deprived of govt stipend for a year

As many as 5,095 students of 106 high schools in Chirirbandar upazila under the district have remained deprived of the government allocated stipend money since July last year.

The situation has badly affected study of a good number of students, especially the insolvent ones.

Laisur Rahman, a guard-

ian of a student who passed the SSC examinations from Pilot High School in Chirirbandar upazila, said, "If my son got the stipend money in time, it would be helpful for me to bear the expenses for his admission to college."

"We could not purchase necessary study materials due to suspension of the stipend disbursement," said Al Amin, a Class IX student of Saitara High School in the upazila.

Headmasters of several

affected high schools said most schools do not realise monthly tuition fees from the students but they need to pay other fees.

The fees have remained unpaid as most of the students are dependent on their stipend money for the purpose.

The situation has led to pressure on the fund of most schools, said the headmasters.

Under Secondary Education Stipend Project of the Directorate of

Education, Class VI and VII students get Tk 600, VIII students Tk 720, IX students Tk 900 and Class X students Tk 2100 every six months, officials said.

Contacted, Chirirbandar Upazila Education Officer Abu Sayed Md Mahfuz said, "The disbursement of the stipend money remained stopped as the project duration is over. Hopefully, the project along with disbursement of the stipend money will resume this month."

Two siblings electrocuted

Two siblings were electrocuted at Dodaria village in Monirampur upazila of Jessore district on Sunday.

The deceased are Milon, 30, and Sumon, 27, sons of Azizur Rahman of the village.

Police said one Shimul, 9, son of Robiul Islam of the area, came in contact with a snapped electric wire near a brick kiln around 9:00am.

Hearing screams, Milon and Sumon rushed to the spot and tried to save the boy but they were electrocuted.

They died on the spot, said Mollah Khair Ahmed, officer-in-charge of Monirampur Police Station.

Injured Shimul is now undergoing treatment at Jessore Medical College Hospital, said the OC.

Woman tortured to death for dowry

Brutally tortured by dowry-greedy husband and in-laws, mother of a three-month-old son died at Galachipa Upazila Health Complex yesterday noon.

The victim, Rubina Begum, 22, daughter of late Abdul Jalil Sarder of Poshurbunia village under Rangabali upazila in the district, was married with Ferdous of nearby Rasulpur village three years ago, police and family sources said.

A son was born to them three months ago.

During marriage, Rubina's family gave cash

and ornaments worth over Tk one lakh to Ferdous as dowry but he demanded more.

As Rubina refused to comply, Ferdous and his family members physically and mentally tortured Rubina.

On Saturday night, Ferdous tortured Rubina to unconsciousness, said Rafique Hossain, brother of the victim.

Hearing the matter, Rafique brought Rubina to Galachipa Upazila Health Complex on Monday morning and she died there.

"The patient was brought to the health complex at about 11:00am and she died after an hour

when we were trying to give oxygen to her," said Dr Md Zahid Hossain, resident medical officer of the health complex.

After getting the news of Rubina's death, husband Ferdous and his family members went into hiding.

Contacted, Shishir Kumer Paul, officer in charge of Galachipa Police Station, said they sent the body to Patuakhali General Hospital morgue for autopsy.

"An unnatural death case has been filed with the police station in this regard. We will take lawful step after getting the postmortem report," he added.

Five acid throwers get life

A court here yesterday sentenced five people to life imprisonment for throwing acid on a housewife and her two daughters at Ramrari village in Durgapur upazila in 2007.

The convicts are Bachchu Miah, 30, Hanif Miah, 22, Rukku Miah, 25, Jamal Hossain, 60 and Buruj Ali, 25. They all are from Ramrari village in the upazila.

The court also fined the convicts Tk 1 lakh each.

According to the prosecution, the convicts threw acid on Sheuli Akhter and her two daughters on May 19, 2007 over previous enmity, leaving them critically injured.

Sheuli filed a case with Durgapur Police Station on May 25, accusing the five.

After examining the case record and eight witnesses, Additional District and Sessions Judge Abdul Hamid, also the Judge of Acid Crimes Control Tribunal-2, handed down the verdict.

Human trafficker held in Narsingdi

The law enforcers arrested an alleged human trafficker from Kamargaon village under Shibpur upazila of the district on Sunday night.

The arrestee was identified as Farid Sarker, 50.

Apple Mahmud, additional superintendent of Police Bureau of Investigation (PBI), said Farid in collusion with other traffickers sent his neighbour Tapash Barman to Ivory Coast in exchange for Tk 8 lakh.

Tapash led a miserable life there and returned home with the help of Bangladesh Army. Later, Niranjan Barman, father of Tapash, filed a case against Farid with Shibpur Police Station.

Girl killed over land dispute

A minor girl of the district, who sustained injuries in an attack over a disputed land on Friday, died on way to Mymensingh Medical College Hospital yesterday.

The victim is Yeasmin Begum, 12, daughter of Yeasin Ali of Kalibari village in Sribardhi upazila.

Police and locals said there was a longstanding conflict between Yeasin and his neighbour Samiul Haque over the land.

As a sequel to the conflict, Samiul and his men on Friday afternoon swooped on the house of his rival, leaving Yeasin, his daughter Yeasmin and another woman seriously injured.

The injured were rushed to Sherpur Hospital. Yeasmin was referred to Mymensingh Medical College Hospital as her condition deteriorated.

She died on way to the hospital yesterday afternoon.

Trawler capsized 20 fishermen rescued from Bay

Twenty fishermen were rescued yesterday, hours after two trawlers capsized in the Bay during a storm in Barguna district.

The fishermen went missing as the fishing trawlers FB Mayer Doa and FB Dulal sank in Narikelbaria area under Pathorghata upazila around 2:00am.

Later, local fishermen in two trawlers rescued the 20 after ten hours of frantic search.

12 Chandpur Jubo Dal men sent to jail in arson case

A Chandpur court yesterday sent 12 Jubo Dal men, including the president of the district unit, to jail in a case for arson attack on a truck that left the driver and two others killed in the town in March this year.

Senior Judicial Magistrate Masrur Salekin passed the order, rejecting the bail prayers of Jubo Dal men, who surrendered before the court at noon.

According to the case statement, the Jubo Dal men set a truck afire in Chandra area under Chandpur Sadar upazila on Mahmud, 22.

March 18, leaving the driver of the vehicle and two others dead.

Police filed a case with Sadar Police Station the same day, accusing the Jubo Dal men, including the district unit president Shahjalal Mission.

Our Gaibandha correspondent adds: Palashbari police arrested the general secretary of the upazila unit of Islami Chhatra Shibir from Gaibandha town yesterday.

Acting on a tip-off, police raided a khankasharif at around 2:00pm and arrested Sultan Mahmud, 22.

Police said the Shibir leader was wanted in vandalism and arson cases filed with Palashbari Police Station.

In Satkhira, Police arrested a local leader of Jamaat-e-Islami from Debnagar village under Sadar upazila yesterday morning.

The arrestee is Maulana Zafarullah, president of Debnagar ward unit of Jamaat.

Officer-in-Charge Emdad Sheikh of Sadar Police Station police arrested the Jamaat leader, raiding his house in the area at around 9:00am.

Charge-sheeted upazila vice-chairman suspended

Adamdighi upazila parishad vice-chairman Yunuch Ali has been temporarily suspended as he was charge-sheeted in a sabotage case filed with a Bogra court.

Lutfonnahar, senior assistant secretary of Local Government, Rural Development and Cooperatives Ministry, on June 17 signed the order for suspension of the upazila



Yunuch Ali parishad vice-chairman, also upazila unit nayebe ameer of Jamaat-e-Islami.

Contacted on Monday afternoon, Rezaul Karim, Adamdighi upazila nirbahi officer, confirmed the matter.

Yunuch is a charge-sheeted accused in the case for attacking an Awami League procession in the municipality area, which was brought out marking the Jail Killing Day in November last year, said Moslem Uddin, officer in charge of Adamdighi Police Station.
