

BCL men lock IU offices, main entrance

The former students agitate demanding jobs at the university

Academic and administrative activities at Islamic University (IU) in Kushtia have remained stalled after a group of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) activists, also former students of the university, locked its offices on Monday.

The BCL men also kept the institution's main gate closed since early morning yesterday, preventing vehicles from entering the campus.

No class and examination were held there yesterday.

Around 40/50 former activists of BCL led by Asiqur Rahman Japan, former vice president of the IU unit of BCL, Touhidur Rahman Hitlar, former organising secretary of the unit, and Mohammad Ali Shimul took position in front of the administrative building and different academic buildings, campus sources said.

Asiqur Rahman Japan and Mohammad Ali Shimul passed from the university four years ago and Touhidur Rahman Hitlar passed five years ago.

A number of IU teachers and officials gathered at different locations of Kushtia and Jhenidah towns but they could not go to the campus as no transport of the university moved from its temporary depot at Customs intersection in Kushtia town yesterday, said official

sources of the university.

"We dared not start the buses as the BCL men threatened to set the vehicles afire if there is any attempt to move," said a driver of the university, seeking anonymity.

The former BCL activists are demanding that the university authorities create posts for their recruitment, campus sources said, adding that during the last three

years, the jobseekers went into agitation 6/7 times, creating deadlock at the university.

"A group of former students, who completed study 4/5 years ago, are still demanding that the university authorities provide them with jobs of different administrative posts. Their agitation is creating troubles for smooth academic activi-

ties at the university," said IU Vice Chancellor Abdul Hakim Sarker.

"I have informed the higher authorities of the matter," he said.

Fratricide

A man was killed allegedly by his younger brother over a trifling matter at Dakkhin Gotamari village in Hatibandha upazila of the district on Monday night.

The deceased is Jalal Hossain, 40, son of Kabir Uddin of the village.

Quoting victim's family members, police said Jalal had an altercation with his younger brother Nazrul Islam over setting an electric bulb in the yard.

At one stage of altercation, Nazrul hit Jalal with a bamboo stick on the head and fled the scene, leaving him critically injured.

Family members took Jalal to Hatibandha Upazila Health Complex where the doctors declared him dead.

On information, police recovered the body and sent it to Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy.

Victim's wife Khadiza Begum lodged a murder case with Hatibandha Police Station yesterday morning accusing, eight people, including Nazrul Islam, said Abdul Motin, officer-in-charge of Hatibandha Police Station.

UZ chairman jailed for using electricity illegally

The chairman of Tentulia Upazila Parishad in Panchagarh district and three others have been sent to jail on theft charge.

Senior Judicial Magistrate of Bangladesh Power Development Board in Dinajpur region Md Kamruzzaman passed the order when they surrendered to the court on Sunday.

The accused are Rezaul Karim Shahin, chairman of Tentulia Upazila Parishad, Abul Kashem Rumel, Morshed Alam Sarkar and Mosharaf Hossain.

The four, directors of Desh Clinic and Diagnostic Centre in the district town, had been consuming electricity illegally for long.

On May 28, a mobile court, led by Md Kamruzzaman, in a drive found the allegation of irregularities true and filed a case against the four.

Abducted schoolboy found murdered in Panchagarh

The body of a schoolboy, abducted from Balarampur Tantipara village in Debiganj upazila of Panchagarh district on Thursday night, was found in a pond at Chilahati Sarkarpara village in the upazila on Monday evening.

Police recovered the body of Payel, 15, a Class X student of Phulbari High School in the upazila at around 7:00pm. They arrested three people in connection with the abduction and murder.

Local union parishad chairman Md Shahidul

Alam said Payel, 15, son of Sultan Ali of Balarampur Tantipara village, went missing on Thursday night. Later a gang demanded Tk 3lakh as ransom from Payel's father Sultan Ali over cellphone, the chairman added.

Victim's uncle Mohir Uddin filed a general diary (GD) with Debiganj Police Station the following day.

Police on Monday arrested three people. They are Nuruzzaman, 28, Farhad Hossain, 23, of Tantipara village in Debiganj upazila; and Abdur Rahman, 23, son of Bara Bau of Kajoldighi vil-

lage in Boda upazila of Panchagarh.

During preliminary interrogation, the arrestees confessed to killing the boy after abduction and dumping the body into the pond at Chilahati Sarkarpara village.

On the basis of their statements, police recovered Payel's body and sent it to Panchagarh Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy.

Officer-in-Charge Kaife Ali of Debiganj Police Station said victim's father Sultan Ali filed a murder case with the police station, accusing the three.

Power office vandalised protesting outage

A group of local people staged demonstration in Charfashion municipality of the district yesterday, protesting frequent power outage.

They also demanded ensuring uninterrupted power supply in Charfashion upazila.

Over 30 people equipped with sticks and iron rods attacked West Zone Power Distribution Company office, its office for receiving complaints and Rural Electrification

Board (REB) office in the municipality area at noon and vandalised computer, stencil and other equipment to realise their demand.

Later, they held an agitation programme by burning tyres on Sadar road.

They got electricity only for two or three hours in a day in the last one week and there was no power in the upazila for last 24 hours, said the protestors.

Despite repeated calls, the authorities con-

cerned are yet to take any steps in this regard, they alleged.

Sabuj Roy, acting resident engineer of West Zone Power Distribution Company office in Charfashion, said basically they have to depend on Bhola office as they have no sub-station.

On information, police rushed to the spot and brought the situation under control, said Abul Bashar, officer-in-charge of Charfashion Police Station.

Clash over building bridge leaves 2 dead in Sunamganj

Two people were killed and 15 others injured in a clash between two groups of villagers over building a bridge at Basiakhauri village in South Sunamganj upazila of Sunamganj district on Monday evening.

The deceased were identified as Arju Miah, 65, and Abul Kalam, 45, of the village.

Sub-Inspector Mukit Chowdhury of South Sunamganj Police Station said two groups—one led by Moshahid Khan and another by Nur Ali Miah—locked in an altercation

over building a bridge on a canal in the area.

At one stage, both sides equipped with sharp weapons attacked each other, leaving Arju Miah and Abul Kalam dead on the spot and 15 others injured.

Of the injured, 10 were admitted to Sunamganj Sadar Hospital while the rest

given first aid at the upazila health complex.

Being informed, police went to the spot and dispersed the clashing groups. They arrested two people on the spot.

Additional police have been deployed in the area to avert any further clash.
