Bengal Foundation has announced an open to artists for the third edition of ONLY CONNECT, a biannual, collaborative exhibition programme. They invite expressions of interest from young artists, to participate in an exhibition in a group of three to six artists at the Daily Star-Bengal Arts Precinct in Dhaka in September/October 2015, says a press

The deadline for application is July 31. Applying artists must be under 35 years of age, and live and work in Bangladesh. Artists who have trained within the last 5 years are encouraged to apply. The sub-



mitted work must not have been previously been shown in Dhaka.

Applicants are invited to express their interest by sending a digital, or a hardcopy application by e-mail: artsprecinct@bengalfoundation.org. The total application file-size must be less that 4 MB. Video submissions must be in the form of links to YouTube, or Vimeo. Applicants can also send in entries by post or courier to Daily Star-Bengal Arts Precinct. Initiated by Bengal Foundation in July 2014, Only Connect is a biannual, collaborative, group exhibition programme that takes place in Dhaka, Bangladesh. The programme is open to young artists, and aspires to create an arena for the exploration of experimentation and the indefinite in the arts.
