Man held with 3.6kg gold at airport

 Customs officials detained a man with 31 gold bars weighing 3.6kg at Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport in the capital yesterday.
 Mohammad Didar, son of Alam Abdul of Keraniganj, was captured after he had arrived in Dhaka from Saudi Arabia by a Biman Bangladesh Airlines flight at 3:05pm, said SM Sohel Rahman, joint commissioner of Customs at the airport.

Fake stamps worth Tk 60cr seized

 Criminal Investigation Department seized fake stamps worth around Tk 60 crore after raiding a printing press in the capital's Mirpur yesterday.
 The seizure was made following information from one Bulbul, who was arrested a week ago with fake stamps, Abdul Latif, a sub-inspector of CID, told reporters on the spot. None was arrested as the press was locked from the outside.

Man dies from electrocution

 A man died from electrocution in Panchbibi upazila of Joypurhat yesterday.
 Quoting locals, Panchbibi police said Ofir Uddin, 45, of Koshgari village of the upazila, died as he touched his tin-shed shop which was already electrified by a live electric wire.

TECHNICAL EDUCATION BOARD Students to get e-books, apps

BSS, Dhaka
 The government has taken initiatives to transform textbook contents of technical education into e-books and mobile applications (apps).
 The education ministry will, at first, transform textbook contents of 65 different trades of SSC (vocational) course into e-books and mobile apps in the next five months, said sources.
 Principals of different technical and vocational institute would be responsible to make the e-books and mobile apps with technical help from Buet. The project would be funded by Bangladesh Technical Education Board.
 "We have already started making all books from class VI to X at secondary level into Interactive Digital Textbook, and our next initiative is to turn textbook contents of different trades of technical education into e-books and mobile apps," Education Secretary Md Nazrul Islam Khan told the news agency yesterday.
 He said Interactive Digital Textbook of class VI of secondary level would be inaugurated in September, while deadline for turning the books of 65 different trades of SSC vocational into e-book and mobile apps has been set in October.
 The education secretary said the government has a plan to provide tabs to students so that they can read the e-books and mobile apps using the technological devices.

Journo Balu's anniversary of death today

 Journalists will observe the 11th death anniversary of Dainik Janmabhumi editor Humayun Kabir Balu today through various programmes.
 The events include placing wreaths at his memorial plaque at 10:30am, a discussion at 11:00am and a milad mahfil at Khulna Press Club, mourning procession in the city around 10:00am. Khulna unit of Awami League will place wreaths there. Balu was killed in a bomb attack on this day in 2004 before his residence-cum-office in the city. The family will also hold a doa mahfil.

Incessant rain disrupts life in capital

 Incessant rainfall triggered by monsoon inundated many parts of the capital for the second consecutive day yesterday, causing misery to residents.
 "During monsoon, the people of the city suffer when commuting as most roads are potholed. Rain or no rain you must suffer in this dirty city," said Mujibul Huq, an engineer.
 Many roads of the capital were submerged by water due to two consecutive days' rainfall. The rain slowed down vehicular movement leading to heavier traffic on the roads.
 The rainwater submerged roads in Mirpur-10, Shenpara-Parbata and Kazipara, Rokeya Sarani, Bijoysharani, Moghbazar, Mouchak, Malibagh, Shantinagar, Kakrail, Sabujbagh, Khilgaon, Merul Badda, Rampura, Motijheel, Shyampur and Demra.
 Commuters faced problems in reaching their destinations due to heavy traffic triggered by the torrential rains.
 Moreover, the Moghbazar-Mouchak flyover construction site tormented the travellers most.
 Commuters are facing unbearable misery while travelling through roads connecting Moghbazar, Mouchak, Malibagh, Shantinagar, Eskaton, Dilu Road, Siddheshwari, Shatrasta and Rampura to the construction work as the roads are riddled with huge potholes.
 "A little bit of rain makes life miserable for those who use these areas and even the police find it difficult to clear the traffic on this stretch," Mujibul Huq added.
 The Met Office recoded 18mm of rain from 6:00am to 3:00pm yesterday and 83mm rainfall from 6:00am Thursday to 6:00am Friday.
 There seems to be no relief in sight as the Met Office forecasted that that light to moderate rain or thundershowers accompanied by temporary gusty wind is likely to occur in the capital today.

Lightning kills 3 in Sunamganj
