Unrest at icddr,b

Local staff abstain from work for two hours; seek pay comparable to UN scale, stop to recruitment of foreigners to posts not related to science

Employees of icddr,b observed a two hours' work abstention from 10:00am on its Dhaka premises yesterday demanding, among others, salaries consistent with that provided by the United Nations as per the international health research organisation's ordinance of 1978.

At a rally, they also called upon the International Centre for Diarrhoeal Disease Research, Bangladesh (icddr,b) to cancel a contract through which 40,500 square feet of its space was leased out at a "throwaway price" for 49 years.

They sought cutting down food costs at its canteen, reportedly raised from Tk 40 to Tk 120, along with monthly transport costs, increased from Tk 275 to Tk 1,800; festival bonus and increasing the retirement age.

The workers also urged for a stop to recruiting foreigners to posts not related to science, saying the 17 already present in the management section had been appointed "unnecessarily". However, there was no issue over recruiting foreigners to posts be appropriate for them to comment at this related to science.

"We, the local staff, get only 40 percent of the UN salary scale while foreign staff get 106 percent," said Dr Firoze Ahmed, general secretary of icddr,b's Staff Welfare Association (SWA).

Recently, a new post, chief operating officer, was created and a foreigner appointed which is totally unnecessary, he said.

Another SWA leader said promotions have been halted, except for a few favourites of the authority, for the last three years.

He demanded that the copyright of the prestigious Journal of Health, Population and Nutrition of icddr,b be bought back from a UK company.

Asked, the icddr,b communication department sent a statement, saying icddr,b appreciates SWA's role in expressing concerns.

"As we go through a period of change, icddr,b management will continue to meet with SWA on a regular basis to ensure that the view of all staff members are heard," said the statement.

It, however, refrained from making any specific comments on the demands, saying those are management issues and it will not point of time.

Recover Gazipur forest land from grabbers

JS body asks forest department

The Parliamentary Standing Committee on Public Accounts yesterday asked the forest department to soon recover forest land in Gazipur from grabbers.

The parliamentary watchdog made the directive on the basis of audit objections raised by the Office of the Comptroller and Auditor General (CAG), on the activities of the department between the fiscal year 1999-2000 to 2008-09, at its meeting held at the Jatiya Sangsad Bhaban.

According to the audit objections, a total of 12,684 acres of forest land is under illegal occupation in Gazipur.

The meeting also asked the authorities concerned to submit a progress report to the public accounts committee in this regard and stressed the need for formation of monitoring committees at central and divisional levels to ensure regular inspection and evaluation of the forest department's activities and to stop timber smuggling.

The committee also recommended bringing all the forest officials under accountability and assessment of the quantity of forest land, actual forest, numbers of trees as per species and total amount of wood should be continued.

Chaired by Committee Chairman Mahiuddin Khan Alamgir, the meeting was attended by its members M Abdus Shahid, Panchanan Biswas, Begum Rebeka Momin, M Shamsul Huq Tuku, Moin Uddin Khan Badol, AKM Maidul Islam and M Rustam Ali Farazi.

Suspended SCC mayor Ariful denied bail

A Habiganj court yesterday rejected the bail petition of suspended Sylhet City Corporation mayor Ariful Haque Chowdhury in an explosion case filed for killing former finance minister SAMS Kibria.

On last November 13, Criminal Investigation Department submitted a supplementary charge-sheet against 32 people, including former state minister for home Lutfozzaman Khan Babar, former prime minister Khaleda Zia's political secretary Harris Chowdhury and Ariful Haque in the murder case.

Ariful surrendered before the court on last December 31.

RANA PLAZA COLLAPSE CASE Court to decide on charges July 8

A Dhaka court will decide on July 8 whether charges will be accepted against 42 accused including Sohel Rana in two cases over Rana Plaza building collapse that killed at least 1,136 people on April 24, 2013.

Responding to a verbal appeal of Additional Public Prosecutor Anwarul Kabir Babul, the court ordered Kashimpur prison superintendent to show cause why Sohel Rana was not produced during yesterday's proceeding. Three cases -- one for violation of building code, one for



50,000 poor women

A month-long fair organised on the Shyamoli club field, the only one in the locality, in the capital by one "Shyamoli Club" in complete violation of the

353 women and 210 children under 168 families in a bid to mainstreaming them," he stated. They, so far, saved around Tk 47,000 from their daily

incomes, disbursed Tk 63,000 as loan among 13 small business women and recovered Tk 23,000 against the disbursed money.
