PANCHAGARH ENCLAVES

26 more people opt for Indian nationality

Twenty-six inhabitants of 23 Indian enclaves in Boda upazila of Panchagarh district expressed their desire to become Indian nationals on the second day of a 10-day joint survey by India and Bangladesh on Tuesday.

Earlier 40 inhabitants of the Indian enclaves inside Panchagarh wanted to become Indian nationals during the first day of the survey on Monday, said Shahin Reza, executive magistrate and in-charge of the control room set up for the survey work.

So far, 305 people including children have got their names registered during the two days, he said.

Eighteen camps were set up for running

the survey-related activities in a total of 36 enclaves inside the district.

According to the 2011 census, the enclaves in Panchagarh cover around 11,900 acres of land with a population of 19,043.

There are 111 Indian enclaves in Bangladesh, including 59 in Lalmonirhat, 36 in Panchagarh, 12 in Kurigram and four in Nilphamari districts, and 51 Bangladeshi enclaves in Cooch Behar district of Pashchimbanga in India. The Indian enclaves in Bangladesh comprise 17,149 acres of land while Bangladeshi enclaves in India cover 7,110 acres.

A joint census conducted in July 2011 found 37,334 people living in Indian enclaves in Bangladesh and 14,215 people in Bangladeshi enclaves in India.

Man gets life for killing girl after rape

A Pabna court yesterday sentenced a man to life imprisonment for killing a girl after rape in Sadar upazila in 2005.

The convict is Abdul Momin, 32, son of Jamat Ali of Bhajendrapur village in the upazila. The court also fined him Tk 1 lakh.

Judge Gazi Rahman of Women and Children Repression Prevention Tribunal pronounced the verdict in a crowded court room.

The judge also acquitted another accused, Abdus Salam, as charges brought against him could not be proved.

According to the prosecution, Momin raped Shrifia Khatun of the same village and then strangled her on June 12, 2005. Sharifa's father Lalu Pramanik filed a case with the Pabna Police Station the following day, accusing Momin and Salam. Police later pressed charges against the two.

After examining the case record and evidence, the judge found Momin guilty

and sentenced him to life imprisonment, said Public Prosecutor advocate Abdus Samad Khan Ratan.

Away in Gaibandha, a seven-year-old girl, who was stabbed in an attack at Dakkhin Hatibandha village in Sundarganj upazila of the district on Tuesday, died at Rangpur Medical College Hospital (RMCH) yesterday, reports our correspondent.

Quoting locals, police said one Alam Badsha of the village borrowed Tk 2000 from his neighbour Lal Mia. Despite repeated requests for the last two years, Badsha did not repay the money.

On Tuesday around 12:00 noon, Lal Mia along with his daughter Monika went to Badsha's house and asked him to repay the money.

As he denied paying the money back, an altercation took place between the two. At one stage, Badsha stabbed Monika with a sharp weapon.

Monika succumbed to her injuries at RMCH yesterday.

3 held for felling govt trees

Forest officials arrested three youths for their alleged involvement in felling and taking government trees near the Monu River in Raysri area under Sadar upazila of the district on Tuesday. The arrestees are Bishwajit Deb, 30, son of Rashed Chandra Deb of Dhanshi village, Jahir Miah, 26, son of Rahman Miah of Raysri village, and his younger brother Ajim Uddin, 20. Moulvibazar Forest officer Firoz Alam confirmed the incident.

Youth electrocuted

A young man died from electrocution at Sagordari Bazar in Keshabpur upazila of Jessor district on Tuesday night. The deceased was identified as Akram Hossain, 40, son of Moslem Biswas of Madhyakul village. Police said Moslem came in contact with a snapped electric wire while he was working at Sagordari Bazar at night. He died on the spot.

Nine Indian cattle seized

A special taskforce in a drive seized nine cattle worth about Tk 8.10 lakh from Dariapur area in Chapainawabganj municipality yesterday morning. Lt Col Abu Zafar Sheikh Mohammad Bazul Haque, commanding officer of BGB-9 Battalion, said on secret information, a special taskforce, including Executive Magistrate Gonopati Roy and the border guards, raided the area at around 9:30am and seized nine bullocks brought from India illegally. None was arrested in this connection, said the CO.

15 shops gutted

At least 15 shops were gutted in a fire at Gridokalindia Bazar in Faridganj upazila of the district on Tuesday. Witnesses said the fire originated from an electric short circuit at a timber shop around 3:00pm and soon engulfed 14 other adjoining shops. On information, a fire fighting unit from Chandpur rushed in and doused the flame. The affected shop owners claimed that the loss caused by the fire could go up to Tk 40 lakh.

Lightning kills two

UNB, Nilphamari

A man and a housewife were killed by lightning in Saidpur upazila of the district on Tuesday. The deceased are Charbhola Nath, 45, son of late Chandan Mohan of Singria Siburhat Bahadurpara village, and Nur Nahar Begum, 45, wife of late Abdur Razzak of Khalisha Dhulia village. Locals said a thunderbolt struck Charbhola while he was working at his farmland at around 11:30am. He died on the spot. In another incident, Nur Nahar was hit by a lightning strike while she was going to the field to bring her cows.

60 grams of heroin recovered

Department of Narcotics Control seized 60 grams of heroin from a local union parishad member's house at Pustigasha village in Ullapara upazila of the district on Tuesday noon. Inspector of the department (Shahjadpur Circle) Ilias Hossain Talukdar said on information, they raided the house of Bachchu Akanda, member of Ramkrisnapur Union Parishad, and seized the heroin. However, Bachchu Akanda managed to flee, sensing the presence of the officials. A case was filed with Salanga Police Station in this connection.

3 jailed for selling false stamps in Dinajpur

Another held in Bogra for keeping 43 passports

A court here yesterday sentenced two men to life imprisonment while another to 10 years in jail for storing and selling false stamps.

The convicts are Ibrahim Hossain, 55, son of Joyal Abedin of Eidgah Residential area in the district town, and owner of Bhai Bhai Stamp Vendor, Mahbubur Rahman, 40, son of Afzal Ali of Dinajpur Satellite town, and Ayub Ali, 35, son of Riaz Uddin of Sokharia village in Biral upazila.

Senior Judge Mahmudul Karim of Dinajpur District and Sessions Judge Court 2 also fined them Tk 50,000 each. In default, they are to suffer another one year in prison.

According to the prosecution, members of Criminal Investigation Department (CID) in Dinajpur, acting on a tip-off, raided Bhai Bhai Stamp Vendor in Court area of the town on December 26 in 2002 and seized false stamps worth Tk 4 lakh.

Later, an official of CID filed a case, accusing the three in this connection.

Away in Bogra, Detective Branch (DB) of police arrested a youth from Shandhabari village in Gabtoli upazila early Tuesday on charge of keeping 43 passports in his possession illegally.

The arrestee is Atiqur Rahman Atik, 30, son of Abed Ali of the village, reports our correspondent.
