Trader held for black marketing VGF rice

UP chairman among five sued for embezzling the relief item

Police on Friday arrested a rice trader on charge of black marketing government allocated rice meant for vulnerable group feeding (VGF) programme ahead of the Eid-ul-Fitr in Santhia upazila under the district.

A mobile court led by Santhia Upazila Nirbahi Officer Md Shafikul Islam raided the warehouse of trader Md Selim Uddin at Punduria Bazar of the upazila and seized 14 bags of special VGF rice there, said Shahed Mahamud, officer in charge of Santhia

Police Station.

Police arrested Selim Uddin from the spot and Md Mahidul Faruk, project implementation officer (PIO) in the upazila, filed a case with Santhia Police Station accusing Karamza union parishad (UP) chairman Md Shamsur Rahman, local UP member Md Moznu Mia, rice trader Selim Uddin, Kader Ali and Motleb Hossain on Friday, he said.

The accused embezzled the government allocated relief rice in collusion with each other, the complainant stated in the case.

Twenty four tonnes of VGF rice was

allotted for the ultra-poor people in Karamza union of Santhia upazila ahead of Eid-ul-Fitr, said PIO Md Mahidul Faruk.

"UP chairman Shamsur Rahman released the rice received from the government depot on June 30. But most of the rice was sold in the black market instead of supplying for the poor people," he said.

Aggrieved locals brought out a procession in Karamza union demanding punishment of the people involved in embezzling relief rice.

8 robbers arrested in Mymensingh

Police arrested eight alleged robbers from Sarisha area in Ishwarganj upazila of the district early yesterday.

The arrestees are Babul Mia, 34, Ismail Hossain, 35, Saju Miah, 33, Abu Sayeed, 29, Nazrul Islam, 32, Mansur Ali, 28, Chan Mia, 31, and Al-Amin, 25.

Police said a gang of 12 to 13 robbers waylaid trader Habibur Rahman of Maheshpur in the upazila in Mrigali area on Ishwarganj-Atharabari Road around 2:30am and looted money and his motorbike.

The same gang looted money and other valuables from two passengers of a private car on the road around 3:00am. Hearing screams of the victims, locals informed the police of the matter, said Borhan Uddin, officer-in-charge (OC) of Ishwarganj Police Station.

Being informed, police rushed to the spot and chased the gang. They later raided the villages of Sarisha union and arrested eight of the gang members, the OC added.

36 held while returning from India illegally

Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) arrested 21 Bangladeshi nationals from Hili border under Hakimpur upazila early yesterday while they were returning home from India through the border without passports.

The border guards also seized Indian Rupees 22,400 and 21 mobile phone sets from their possession.

Quoting the arrestees, BGB said the detainees went India in search of jobs and worked as brick kiln workers in Punjab since February this year.

BGB personnel caught them while they were returning to the country through the border without passports early yesterday, Abdul Jabbar, in-charge of Hili Check-Post, said.

Away in Benapole, BGB detained 15 Bangladeshis while they were returning to the country through Putkhali border under Benapole Port Police Station on early Friday, reports our correspondent.

Ayub Ali, company commander of BGB 26 Battalion, said a team of the border guards, acting on secret information, raided the area around 5:30am and arrested them while they were returning home though the border without valid documents.

The arrestees include 11 women, three men and a child. They all hail from different areas of Bagerhat and Narail districts.

They were later handed over to Benapole Port Police Station.

Indian medicines seized

Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) seized smuggled Indian medicines from bordering Monakasha village in Shibganj upazila of the district yesterday.

BGB sources said, being tipped-off, a patrol team of the BGB from the border observation post (BoP) raided the village around 8:30am and seized the medicines.

BGB later handed the seized medicines over to customs authority.

Special tribunal for Khaleda after Eid: Inu

Information Minister Hasanul Haq Inu has said a special tribunal will be formed after the Eid-ul-Fitr for quick disposal of the cases against BNP Chairperson Khaleda Zia during the BNP-led alliance's agitation that continued for 93 days.

"She [Khaleda] led the countrywide arson attacks that killed around 150 innocent people," Inu told journalists at a programme arranged by the local administration in Mirpur upazila under Kushtia district yesterday.

The information minister inaugurated a

newly constructed building of Mirzanagar Government Primary School there.

Everybody accused in crimes, irrespective of his/her rank, will be tried during the rule of Sheikh Hasina, Inu said, adding that the killing of people by arson attack is comparable to the genocide conducted in 1971.

"Khaleda committed crime against humanity and so, she should not go unpunished. She will be able to continue politics if she can prove innocence, otherwise she must quit politics," Inu said.

Inu came to Kushtia on Friday and left for Dhaka yesterday afternoon.

2 injured in BSF firing on Jhenidah border

Two Bangladeshi cattle traders were injured in BSF firing on Shyamkur border under Moheshpur upazila of the district early yesterday.

The injured, Abdur Rashid, 45, and his nephew Tarikul Islam, 25, son of Abdul Momin, are residents of Anantapur village in the upazila.

Quoting Tarikul, police said a team of Indian border guards from Fatepur camp in Nadia district of Paschim Banga opened fire on a group of cattle traders

while they were returning home with cattle from India through the border around 5:00am.

Rashid and Tarikul sustained bullet injuries while others escaped unhurt, Shahidul Islam Shahin, officer-in-charge of Moheshpur Police Station, said.

Bullet-hit Tarikul, however, crossed the border and is undergoing treatment at Jibonnagar Upazila Health Complex.

Rashid, who failed to cross the border, was caught by the BSF personnel.

He was admitted to Shaktinagar Hospital in Nadia.
