LIQUID COCAINE HAUL Ctg court includes smuggling charges

A Chittagong court yesterday brought the case filed in connection with seizure of a barrel of liquid cocaine under the Special Power Act to include smuggling charges.

Earlier, the case was filed under Narcotics Control Act by police.

Chittagong Metropolitan Magistrate Faridul Alam passed the order following a petition moved by the prosecution.

Public Prosecutor Advocate Md Fakruddin Chowdhury said now the police would submit two charge sheets after investigation.

After hearing on the petition, the court brought the case under Special Power Act in which an accused shall be punished with death or imprisonment for life if he or she is found guilty, said Fakruddin.

The liquid cocaine was found in a barrel that arrived at Chittagong Port on May 8 along with 106 more barrels of sunflower oil from Bolivia via Uruguay.

On June 27, when tests in two laboratories in Dhaka found presence of liquid cocaine, police filed the case with Bandar Police Station under Narcotics Control Act.

Five persons have been arrested so far in the case.

Eid trip turns fatal for 2 sisters

Four-year-old Tahia and her sister Tathoi, 2, were repeatedly asking their parents how long it was to reach their grandfather's house. They asked their parents to wake them up after they get there and went to sleep, but never got a chance to wake up.

Jahidul Islam, an engineer of Dhaka Electricity Supply Authority (DESA), was going to Kushtia from Dhaka with his two daughters and wife Tanni Yeasmin to celebrate Eid.

Their car fell into a water-filled ditch as the driver lost its control in Kushtia's Khoksa upazila around 12:30pm. The couple came out but failed to save their children.

Nine other people were killed in road accidents in Sirajganj and Manikganj yesterday.

QUESTIONABLE IMPORTED BRAZILIAN WHEAT

Appeal seeks retest by independant lab

Also supervision by SC formed body

An appeal was filed with the Supreme Court yesterday seeking its directives upon the government to test the wheat imported from Brazil at a neutral laboratory, which is beyond the government's control, after collecting its sample through a committee formed by the apex court.

Pabel Mia, a Dhaka Judges Court lawyer who earlier moved a writ petition before the High Court regarding the wheat issue, yesterday submitted the appeal to the SC.

In the petition, he also prayed to the SC to order the Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) to investigate whether there was any corruption in importing the wheat from Brazil and its release and distribution in the country.

Pabel's lawyer Shanjid Siddique told The Daily Star that the SC chamber judge may hear the appeal on July 21.

About the laboratories, he said there are such "neutral" laboratories in the country, including one working under the US embassy.

He said there was a dispute in earlier laboratory tests of the wheat, since the executive magistrates had collected the sample under the government's surveillance.

Shanjid also said as many as 22 test reports said that there are living insects in the wheat, but the directorate general of food said the wheat is fit for human consumption.

Following the writ petition of Pabel, the HC on July 8 had directed the government to take back the wheat imported from Brazil from a department or organisation if they want to return the grain, considering it to be unfit for consumption.

The HC had also asked the government not to compel anyone to receive the imported wheat if he is unwilling to do so.

Following a government appeal, the SC on July 9 stayed the HC judgment till July 26.

Pabel in his appeal also challenged the HC directive.

Meanwhile, the Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) would decide its action regarding the wheat after investigations are carried out by the government bodies, said ACC Director General M Shamsul Arefin at its monthly press briefing at its office in the capital yesterday.

FARUK MURDER

HC asks Rana to surrender to lower court

The High Court yesterday directed Amanur Rahman Khan Rana, Awami League lawmaker of Tangail-3, and his brother Shahidur Rahman Khan to surrender before a lower court in two weeks in a case for the murder of party leader Faruk Ahmed.

The court also ordered the law enforcers not to harass or arrest them till then.

The bench of Justice Farid Ahmed and Justice Mohammad Ullah passed the order on a petition filed by Amanur and Shahidur, mayor of Tangail Municipality, seeking anticipatory bail fearing arrest or harassment.

The bullet-hit body of freedom fighter Faruk, also a district AL leader, was found on January 18, 2013.

Police have found evidence of involvement of Amanur and his three brothers in the murder, according to a Prothom Alo report on September 14 last year.

Deputy Attorney General Bashir Ullah told The Daily Star that the lower court will decide whether it will grant bail to the two brothers after they surrender.

During hearing the bail petition on Sunday, petitioners' counsel Rafique-Ul Huq told the HC that his
