# Dealing with dampness

Before painting, many people find it helpful and beneficial to apply good quality



putty. The coat of white cement provides an extra layer of protection.

The wetness on walls may just be a symptom to another problem. There might be

internal leakages or a problem with the drainage system. Therefore, check seepages and ensure that the proper drainage system is maintained. You might need professional help for that.

Although the intensity of this problem of dampening walls is often the most during monsoon, it can actually continue to happen for the rest of the year too. This is because the moisture collected during monsoon often stays between walls, gradually taking toll on walls.

Therefore, in the first place, choose your paint wisely.
