

MILKY MURDER

No probe report even after 2yrs

Even after two years into Jubo League leader Milky's murder, the investigators could not find out yet the masterminds behind the killing in Dhaka, leaving the family in utter despair and insecurity.

The family expressed no confidence in the charge sheet submitted by Rapid Action Battalion on April 15 last year as it left out two of the

main accused, whose names were in the first information report (FIR).

The names of Zahidul Islam Tipu, general secretary of Motijheel Thana Awami League, and Wahidul Alam Arif, then general secretary of Dhaka city (south) Jubo League, have been left out due to their strong political dominance in Motijheel, claimed the victim's relatives and friends.

Later on June 17 last year, a Dhaka court asked the Criminal Investigation Department (CID) to conduct investigation.

In submitting its probe report, CID had extended the date seven times and finally it was asked by the court on June 29 this year to do so by next August 18, a court source said.

Riazul Haque Khan Milky, organising secretary of Jubo League's Dhaka city (south) unit, was shot dead before a Gulshan shopping mall on July 30, 2013.

A CCTV footage shows prime accused SM Zahid Siddique Tarek, clad in a white punjabi, shooting Milky.

Tarek, who was joint secretary of Dhaka city (south) Jubo League, was killed in a shootout with Rab within 18 hours of his arrest following the incident.

Ctg Manila hill owner fined Tk 10 lakh for landslide

The Department of Environment (DoE) yesterday fined the owner of Manila hill Tk 10 lakh for keeping 2,500 sacks of sand on the hill slope which resulted in a landslide in Chittagong city on Sunday.

Ziad Rahman, owner of the hill, kept the sacks on the hill slope without consulting any engineer of the hill managing committee, said Azadur Rahman Mallick, director of DoE Chittagong (metropolitan).

As a result, a portion of the hill collapsed on the west side of the main building of District Shilpakala Academy and damaged its wall and windows, he added.

The owner was also ordered to take initiative to repair the damaged portion of the academy and pay the fine within seven days.

The order was given following a two-day hearing.

Road crashes kill 5

Five people were killed and 23 others injured in road accidents in three districts yesterday and Tuesday.

Our Rangpur correspondent reports, Abdul Jalil, 45, of Islampur-Mandolpara village was killed when a microbus ran him over while he was crossing Rangpur-Dhaka highway in front of Shah Amanat Filling Station in Mithapukur upazila on Tuesday.

In Rangpur city, Abdus Sattar, 50, of Charan village was killed and five people were injured as they fell from the roof of a bus after it hit the road-divider while trying to save a bicycle on RK road in Madhya Babukha area yesterday.

In the same upazila, 10 passengers of a three-wheeler were injured when a truck collided head-on with it on Rangpur-Dhaka highway in front of Piraband

Union Parishad office yesterday.

Our Pabna correspondent reports, two people were killed and three others injured as a pick-up van hit an auto-rickshaw on Hatikumrul-Bonpara highway in Tarash upazila of Sirajganj yesterday.

The deceased were Shaheb Ali, 40, and Milton Hossain, 32, of Hamkuria village.

Our Bogra correspondent reports, Masud Rana, 38, of Gazaria village was killed and five people were injured when a bus hit a CNG-run auto-rickshaw on Bogra-Shariakandi road at Kathaltola in Shariakandi upazila on Tuesday.

Meanwhile, our staff correspondent report, a Kashimpur jail-bound prison van, carrying 18 Jama'at Mujahideen Bangladesh inmates, ploughed through a footpath after a wheel of the vehicle went off in the capital's Airport area yesterday. None was injured in the incident.

15-yr-old girl gang raped in Savar

A 15-year-old girl was gang-raped at Omorpur in Savar, outside the capital, on Tuesday evening.

The girl went to the village with her friend Md Ibrahim when three youths, confining the latter to a room, raped the girl, said Md Emdadul Haque, sub-inspector of Savar Model Police Station, quoting the girl.

The victim filed a rape case against three youths mentioning one name Md Khokon. Police are conducting drives to arrest the criminals.

17pc engage in child labour

Says a report of Unicef, BBS, BIDS about capital's 10-14 age group

About 17 percent of the capital's 10 to 14-year-olds are engaged in child labour, which is in stark contrast to the national average, 6 percent, as per one Unicef report.

Another shows that about 22 percent of the capital's six to 10-year-olds are out of school, 13 percent of whom have never been to school and six percent dropped out. The national averages for the latter two are 11 and two percent respectively.

The findings came up in "Ending child labour in Bangladesh" and "Out-of-school children in Bangladesh" which Unicef prepared in collaboration with the Bangladesh Bureau of

Statistics (BBS) and the Bangladesh Institute of Development Studies (BIDS), along with another one "Towards ending child marriage in Bangladesh".

The three policy briefs are based on Population and Housing Census 2011,

Multiple Indicator Cluster Survey (MICS) 2006 and 2009, the Household Income and Expenditure Survey (HIES) 2010, Bangladesh Demographic Health Survey (BDHS) and other secondary literature.

They were launched at a programme Unicef organised at the capital's Bangabandhu International Conference Centre yesterday morning.

"Bangladesh has more than 1.4 million children out of school, estimated 1 million children of the age 10-14 years are engaged in labour, 1.3 million children married before the age of 15 years and 3.8 million before the age of 18 years," said Edouard Beigbeder, a Unicef representative.

8 MONTHS INTO DETENTION

Bangladeshi ship with 22 crew released from Guinea

A Bangladeshi ship and its 22 crew were released yesterday after being detained for around eight months at Conakry port in Guinea with its rice cargo.

After being freed through a diplomatic channel, MV Dahiatul Kalbi with the crew started heading towards Bangladesh, its manager Capt Matiu told The Daily Star last night.

The vessel had been in the African country as charterers filed lawsuits with a local court saying that the rice got damaged due to the late arrival of the ship. Losing the legal battle, the ship's owner and the Department of Shipping in Bangladesh sought the foreign ministry's assistance in this regard. The ship was loaded with rice from Kakinada port and steel coils from Paradip port in India last year. It sailed out of India on July 22 and reached Conakry port on October 30.

Facebook hacker arrested in capital

The Detective Branch (DB) of police arrested a hacker, who has so far hacked 100 Facebook accounts especially of female users to blackmail them, in the capital's Merul Badda yesterday.

Mahmudul Hasan, 20, a fourth semester computer science and technology student of East-West University, hacked FB accounts, gathered their personal pictures and information and finally threatened the account holders to leak those on social media if they did not accept his indecent proposals.

Following a complaint filed by a victim's husband on July 1, DB made the arrest.

At a press conference at Dhaka Metropolitan Police media centre, Monirul Islam, joint commissioner (media and public relations) of DMP, urged the public to inform police about every hacking incident on social media.

Hackers especially take advantage of new Facebook users who are not completely aware of every settings of Facebook and thus take control of the account and post off seen pictures or videos on timeline with tagging victim's friend circle.
