

A few local activists allegedly belonging to Jubo League yesterday felled a roadside tree at Matherganj village beside Dinajpur-Parbatipur road in Chirirbandar upazila under the district and tried to fell another when villagers foiled the bid.

The tree fellers came to Matherganj village with six to seven hired labourers around 7:15am yesterday and started axing trees on both sides of Dinajpur-Parbatipur road there, witnesses said.

Within half an hour, they felled a giant rain tree near the Bailey .A case was filed with bridge at Matherganj village and then started cutting another tree on

the other side of the valuable trees on both sides road.

As locals gathered there and asked the men why they were felling those trees, their leader said he was awarded a tender to fell 160 trees, said Md Chanchal, a local journalist of Chirirbandar.

Villagers requested them to show the tender papers, but the latter failed.

As the number of people gathering at the spot rose, the tree fellers left the spot around 10:30am.
