

## Get prepared to serve patients outside Dhaka

Nasim asks promoted doctors

Health and Family Welfare Minister Mohammad Nasim yesterday asked the promoted doctors to remain prepared to work at district-level.

"As per instruction of Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina a total of 350 doctors have been promoted... Now I would like to tell them to be prepared to work at district-level," he said.

The minister was addressing as the chief guest the inauguration of World Breastfeeding Week-2015 at Osmani Memorial Auditorium organised by the health and family welfare ministry in cooperation with other donor agencies. "All promoted doctors will be transferred outside Dhaka where they have to stay at least two years," the minister said. This year the theme is "Breastfeeding and Work: Let's Make It Work!".

## Tea workers won't give ancestral land

Raise voice against govt move

Workers of Chandpur Tea Garden in Habiganj yesterday threatened that they would rather die than give up their ancestral land chosen for setting up a special economic zone.

"We get only Tk 69 per day for our job. Even after that we have been living happily because we have land to cultivate and reside in. But there is a conspiracy to grab our ancestral land in the name of building a special economic zone," said Sadhan Santal, president of Chandpur Tea Garden Panchayet Committee.

Supporting the garden workers' demand, National Human Rights Commission Chairman Dr Mizanur Rahman said, "If you [the government] are really courageous, then take away land from the possession of land grabbers. Only then will we understand this is courageous and will salute it."

To raise their voice, Indigenous Social Development Organisation and Tea Garden Workers jointly held a discussion on "Human Rights of Tea Garden Workers and Their Socio-Economic Development" at the capital's Jatiya Press Club.

Around 6,000 Santals are dependent on 500 acres of land of Chunarughat upazila for living and cultivation. Among them, around 1,100 work at the Chandpur Tea Garden. The government wants to take all 500 acres.

"Our predecessors made the land cutting hills and forests 150-200 years ago. There is a graveyard of our forefathers. How could we give away the land? We will rather die than leave it," said Sadhan.

In addition, many students complain of not having soaps in the toilets and inundation of the hallways due to the clogging of the sewerage system. There are also complaints that the toilets are not cleaned properly.

Mokbul Hossain, supervisor of the building, said 10 cleaners were responsible for cleaning the toilets in the building twice every day -- at 8:00am and 1:00pm.

"It's hard to keep them clean with only 10 cleaners. The number of students has increased manifold but the number of cleaners has not in the last 45 years," he added. However, the supervisor claimed that the cleaners clean the toilets with water twice every day and with bleaching powder once a week.

A three-litre phenyl pack is provided to each cleaner every month, and it is not possible to afford more of the cleaning agent with only Tk 25,000 allocated yearly for the purpose of cleaning toilets and repairing sanitary equipment, he said.

He also alleged that students often kept broken Phensedyl bottles and syringes inside the water tank of the flush, so the cleaners did not want to clean those places to avoid getting their hands cut.

Acknowledging the funding shortage, Vice Chancellor Dr AAMS Arefin Siddique said a Tk 10 crore project was launched to modernise the Arts Building.

He hoped that the toilet problem would be solved once the project was completed. However, he could not specify the time and denied that there was a shortage of cleaners.

"The students should also know how to keep the toilets clean and usable," he said.

## Pvt university students protest VAT on fees

Private university students continued their protest yesterday demanding withdrawal of 7.5 percent VAT (value added tax) imposed on the educational institutions from the fiscal 2015-16.

Farhan Habib, coordinator of the protest programme, said they would file a petition with the Supreme Court if their demand is not met. The VAT will make students unable to continue their study in private universities and turn the educational institutes into business institutes, said Fazlay Rubbi Taj, student of Daffodil University.

In the proposed budget of 2015-16, the government imposed 10 per cent VAT on private universities and medical and engineering colleges which later was reduced to 7.5 per cent following the request of the Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina.

Students of the University of Liberal Arts Bangladesh, Stamford University, Daffodil International University, Green University, East West University, BUBT, AIUB, IUBAT, and Asia-Pacific University organised yesterday's protest rally at the capital's Shahbagh under the banner, "No VAT on Education".
