Eyes on banks as Greek stock exchange to reopen

Attention will be focused on Greece's embattled banks on Monday when the Athens stock exchange reopens after a sixweek shutdown over the country's debt crisis.

The banks are in a vulnerable position because of outflows of billions of euros (dollars) from deposits over the past six months.

Some 40 billion euros (\$44 billion) has been withdrawn from Greek banks since December, according to the country's banks association. And according to news reports on Sunday, the top four lenders -- National Bank, Piraeus Bank, Alpha Bank and Eurobank - will undergo an asset quality review later this month.

Stress tests will follow in the autumn to determine the recapitalisation requirements of each bank with European rescue funds.

Greek officials want to complete the operation before new European regulations come into effect from January 1.

As of 2016, bank shareholders and depositors will foot the lion's share of recapitalisation costs -- a process known as "bail-in" -- instead of European taxpayers.

Greek banks were also recapitalised in 2013 with funds from the country's last EU-IMF rescue package.

The reopening of the market comes after senior EU and IMF auditors held their first meetings with Greek ministers to finalise

the new three-year bailout which could be worth up to 86 billion euros (\$94 billion).

The last session was on June 26, a few hours before Prime Minister Alexis Tsipras announced a referendum on the bailout conditions demanded by Greece's international creditors. The main index had closed at 797.52 points, up 2.03 percent jump.

Over that weekend, Greeks rushed to bank cash machines, prompting the government to impose capital controls from June 29, followed by the closure of the banks and the stock exchange.

The aim was to protect the banking sector following the huge withdrawals by people nervous about Greece's economic and financial future. For the duration of the crisis, Greece's banks have been relying on one lifeline: an ECB credit facility called an Emergency Liquidity Assistance (ELA).

The Frankfurt-based lender last week left the ELA unchanged at 90.4 billion euros

The banks reopened after three weeks on July 20, but withdrawals and money transfers abroad remain under tight controls. Greeks can withdraw only up to 420 euros (\$460) a week. The capital controls were slightly eased for businesses last week but economic activity, especially imports, continues to encounter numerous obsta-

Pakistan's Japanese-dominated car market poised for new entrants

Pakistan's car market has been dominated by Japanese automakers for decades, but a mini-economic revival looks set to attract new players from Europe and Korea into the mix.

Despite heavy taxation on imported vehicles, enthusiasm for owning a car in Pakistan has remained undented -- thanks in part to underdeveloped public transport in the country's sprawling cities, but also the social status it brings.

Toyota, Suzuki and Honda car assembly plants already work around the clock in the southern port city of Karachi and eastern Lahore -- yet customers can still wait for up to four months for new vehicles to be delivered.

Now demand for cars in the South Asian giant of 200 million people is accelerating even more quickly, as economic growth has reached its fastest pace since 2008 while renewed investor confidence and easing inflation have spurred consumer spending.

Keen to cash in, a delegation from German auto giant

Company spokesman Christoph Adomat told AFP that while "Volkswagen is constantly evaluating market opportunities on a worldwide basis... there are no decisions for an investment from Volkswagen side in Pakistan".

> "There are a number of other companies from (South) Korea and Europe that we are talking to who are thinking of setting up assembly plants in Pakistan," he said, without naming the firms.

US and European cars dominated Pakistan's roads in the early years after it gained independence from Britain in 1947.

But fuel prices made their compact, efficient Japanese rivals more popular and from the 1960s onwards manufacturers like Toyota, Suzuki and Honda gained a stranglehold on the market.

Italy's Fiat made a brief foray in the 1990s, while South Korea's Hyundai as well as Daewoo-owned Chevrolet tried -- and failed -- to gain a foothold in the 2000s before the financial crisis forced them to exit.

Because Pakistan charges heavy

duties on imported cars less than three years old, Japanese companies with in-country assembly operations can set prices significantly above the regional average.

The bottom-of-the-range Suzuki Mehran costs the equivalent of \$6,300 in Pakistan but sells for around \$3,900 in neighbouring India. The most popular Corolla 1.3 sedan starts at 1.6 million rupees (\$16,000), but buyers have

MtGox Bitcoin CEO 'misused customer funds': Japanese media

Mark Karpeles, the head of the collapsed MtGox Bitcoin exchange who was arrested in Tokyo, is facing fresh allegations that he misused \$8.9 million in customers' deposits, Japanese media reported Sunday.

French-born Karpeles, 30, was arrested on Saturday after a series of fraud allegations led to the Tokyobased exchange's spectacular collapse last year and hammered the digital currency's reputation.

Karpeles is suspected of manipulating data on the exchange's computer system in 2013 to artificially create about \$1.0 million in Bitcoins, while police were also investigating his possible involvement in a massive loss of the virtual currency in 2014.
