## Poor feeling the pinch

Vegetables, egg, onion, lentil dearer; rice stable; chicken prices down

On Wednesday afternoon, a middle-aged woman went to the capital's Farmgate vegetable bazaar. Looking uncertain, she asked the vendor for a quarter kilo of carrots.

On the scales, there were just three carrots. But suddenly, the woman lifted one carrot from the weighing machine, put it back in the vendor's basket and placed two pointed gourds on the scales instead (prices of carrots and pointed gourds are same). She asked the seller to pack those, paid him and left.

Thinking it might embarrass her, this correspondent did not ask her why she bought so small quantity of vegetables. The reason, however, was obvious and it became clear soon afterwards.

Before the woman could vanish into the crowd, a youth came to the same shop, held up a sheaf of red spinach and asked the price. "It's Tk 30."

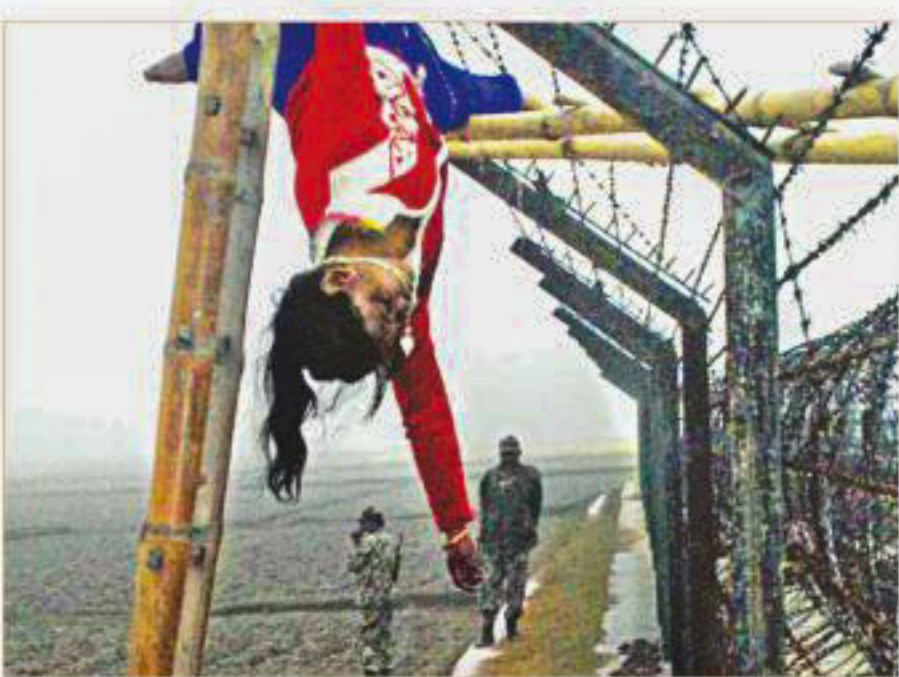

## Six cops linked to yaba racket

Finds police probe into the trade in Cox's Bazar; six other policemen accused of negligence in duty

A police investigation has found direct links of six policemen with a yaba smuggling syndicate based in Cox's Bazar, say police officials.

The probe by a high-powered team also detected negligence of six police officers, including the superintendent of police (SP) and additional SP of Cox's Bazar, and assistant SP of Teknaf circle, in carrying out duties.

Their negligence helped illegal trade of yaba, a highly addictive stimulant, continue and flourish in the district.

The team submitted its report to the inspector general of police a couple of days ago, recommending departmental action against the 12 policemen, officials at the police headquarters told The Daily Star.

The investigation was launched after Mahfuzur Rahman, assistant sub-inspector of Special Branch (SB) of police in Dhaka, and his driver were arrested with 6.8 lakh yaba pills worth Tk 27.20 crore in Feni on June 20.

Referring to the report, an official at the police

headquarters said SP Shyamol Kumar Nath, Additional SP Tofael Ahmed and Assistant SP Jasimuddin Majumder didn't supervise the cases filed in connection with yaba smuggling.

For a lack of supervision, their subordinates didn't include many of the culprits in the charge sheets of the cases, letting them off the hook and run the illegal business.

On many occasions, DB officials in the district didn't record seizure of yaba pills or showed figures lower than the actual number of pills seized during drives.

Three other police personnel -- Inspector Abdur Razzak and Constable Azibor Rahman of SB in Dhaka and Record Officer of Cox's Bazar Badiul Alam -- were also found guilty of negligence in duty.

The six policemen, who have direct links with the yaba smuggling syndicate, include arrested ASI Mahfuzur, Inspector Kamrul Hasan, Sub-inspector Belal and Constable Dulal of Detective Branch of Police in Cox's Bazar and SI Ashique of highway police.

## BRUTALITY ON WOMEN, CHILDREN Call for fast trial of perpetrators

Expressing disappointment over the delayed submission of charge sheets in the cases of recent brutality against women and children, distinguished personalities and many national and international organisations yesterday urged the government to start trial of these cases soon.

Unicef, the parliamentary standing committee on women and children affairs ministry, National Human Rights Commission Chairman Mizanur Rahman, Jatiya Party Chairman HM Ershad, others, expressed their concern over the delayed trials of the perpetrators who committed these crimes.

"Unicef strongly believes that the Government of Bangladesh will do everything within its power to bring perpetrators to justice and help to end such violence against children," the organisation said in a statement.

"Unicef Bangladesh observes with alarm the recent incidents of children being subjected to violence and publicly beaten to death in some parts

## AL warns against extortion

The ruling Awami League yesterday warned its different units and front organisations not to indulge in "extortion" for hosting any programme marking the National Mourning Day.

It suggested that the programmes be organised with its own funds.

AL General Secretary Syed Ashrafur Islam came up with the directives at a joint meeting between party leadership and leaders of the front organisations, held at party President Sheikh Hasina's Dhanmondi office yesterday, meeting sources said.

They said Ashraf, just before concluding the meeting, warned that the party would be tough on specific allegations of extortion against anyone. He also asked all front organisations not to host any programme "to extort money".
