

# Ruet students seek withdrawal of new credit system

Over a hundred students of Rajshahi University of Engineering and Technology (Ruet) demonstrated on the campus yesterday demanding that the authorities withdraw the "new credit system".

They laid siege to the vice chancellor's office for three hours from 11:00am pressing home their demand. The agitators withdrew after the VC came out of his office with police protection.

They also shut offices of Ruet. Earlier in the morning, the students formed a human chain and then organised a rally near the administrative building.

Mahmud Hossain, one of the agitating students, said under the new system if a student cannot manage to secure 33 credits out of 40 in one year, he or she has to repeat the year with junior students.

He said before the system, students who fell short of the

She received the award for her paper "A Bias-Corrected Approach to Rotnitzky Jewell Criteria for Appropriate Correlation Structure Selection in Generalized Estimating Equations".

The work was carried out under the supervision of Prof Mahbub Latif of ISRT. The other collaborators of the work

# Road crashes kill five, injure 11

Our Gaibandha correspondent reports, a person was killed and five others were injured when an iron-laden truck hit a roadside tree and fell into a ditch at Dakhin Bural on Fulchhari-Balashi road yesterday.

The deceased was Aka Mia, 30. The injured were sent to Fulchhari Health Complex.

Our Bogra correspondent reports, Nofer Uddin, 60, of Sherpur upazila, died as he fell on Bogra-Dhaka highway after being hit by a motorcycle and then a bus ran him over at Mirzapur yesterday.

The motorcyclist Abdul Hamid, 28, of Matal Chapor village, also skidded off the road and was admitted to Sherpur Health Complex with injuries.

Meanwhile, three auto-rickshaw passengers were injured

when a bus hit the vehicle at Noymail in Shahjahan upazila.

Shahidul Islam, 45, Rahima Begum, 50 and Ayub Ali, 56, were admitted to Shaheed Ziaur Rahman Medical College and Hospital (SZMCH).

In another incident, two persons were injured when a bus hit a stationary covered-van at Dhankundi in Sherpur upazila.

The van driver, Jashim Uddin, 30, and his helper Abdus Salam, 26, were admitted to SZMCH.

Our Natore correspondent adds, two truck helpers, Razu Hossain, 22, of Natore sadar upazila, and Rabiul Islam, 30, of Baraigram upazila, died when the vehicle collided head-on with a bus in Airmari bridge area.

Meanwhile, an unidentified lorry driver died when the vehicle collided with an oncoming bus at Karbala on Natore-Dhaka highway.

# 2 human traffickers held in Ctg

## Six including four Rohingyas stopped from illegal migration

Detectives yesterday detained two alleged human traffickers in Chittagong city's Garibullah Shah Mazar area and stopped six persons, including four Rohingyas, from illegally migrating to Saudi Arabia.

The two traffickers are Mahmudul Hasan, 46, of Cox's Bazar, and Abul Kalam, 41, of Satkania.

All six persons Md Ershad and Md Ayub of the port city, and Md Javed, Nurul Haque, Abdul Hafez and Syedul Amin of Myanmar, were lured with good job offers and were supposed to be sent to Sylhet and from there to Saudi Arabia through airways, said police.

Each of the six was supposed to give the traffickers Tk 5 lakh in two phases before and after migration, said Assistant Commissioner Fayzul Islam of the Detective Branch (DB) of Chittagong Metropolitan Police.

One case was filed against the traffickers, while another was filed against the four Rohingyas for intruding into the country.

# Medical students keep demanding restoration of 'carry on' system

Every mayor feels the need of city government while they start working, Nasir said, adding that he would discuss the issue with other mayors.

Nasir also said he would take every risk to implement the city master plans for the welfare of the residents.

As a mayor, he said, he would maintain transparency and honesty in his work and would brook no corruption and political influence.

The new mayor said Chittagong City Corporation (CCC) would start collecting garbage at night from September 1, to reduce traffic congestion and give people respite from the malodour spreading during waste collection.

About the chronic and debilitating waterlogging of his city, Nasir said the corporation would prepare a comprehensive master plan to improve the drainage and sewerage system, and it had already got positive responses from the World Bank and Japan International Cooperation Agency (Jica) for funding.

Initiatives were also taken to reclaim canals from the grabbers, he said.

About the poor condition of the port city towers, Nasir said quality was not maintained during their construction.

It is necessary to take initiatives in a more planned way to repair roads, and he will ensure the quality of repairs, he said.

Saif Islam Dilal, president of CJFD, also addressed the press conference.
