Demolition of illegal structures begins in Tangail town

Tangail district administration has started demolishing illegal structures on the government land at different places in the town.

The drive started on Monday and over 100 illegal structures have been demolished since then.

On Tuesday, the administration knocked down illegal structures, includ-

ing tea stalls, medicine and other shops around Tangail Medical College Hospital.

The structures were hampering the movement of patients coming to the hospital and also causing traffic jam and other problems in the area, hospital sources said.

Such structures were also demolished in Old Bus Stand and Mymensingh

Road areas in the last two days.

Additional Deputy Commissioner (revenue) of Tangail Lal Hossain, Civil Surgeon Dr Syed Ibne Sayid, and Executive Engineer of Roads and Highways Department Noor-e-Alam, were present during the drive.

7 Joypurhat Jamaat men remanded

A court here yesterday granted two-day remand for seven leaders and activists of Jamaat-e-Islami in a sabotage case.

Judge Tajul Islam Mia of Senior Judicial Magistrate's Court passed the order after Joypurhat police produced them before the court seeking a five-day remand.

The arrestees are Dr Fazlur Rahman Syeed, ameer of Jamaat's Joypurhat district unit, Taslim Uddin, ameer of Panchbibi upazila unit, its secretary Sujaul Islam, Anwar Hossain, secretary of Sadar upazila unit, and Jamaat activist Abdul Amin and Jubayer Hossain.

Anwarul Islam, officer-in-charge of Sadar Police Station, said law enforcers on July 22, arrested the Jamaat men from Haripur upazila in Dinajpur while they were holding a secret meeting there.

Teenage boy commits 'suicide'

The HEQEP intends to apply part of the proceeds of this credit to payments for consultancy services of the following positions to establish BdREN.

i. Director, Network Operations (Package No. S-20-AF) - 1 position

Qualification, experiences and skills required:

- Bachelor degree in Electrical & Electronics/Computer Science & Engineering/Communication Engineering/Telecommunication or M.Sc in Applied Physics/Computer Science.
- At least 10 years of experience in Telecommunications/Data Communication System of which, 5 years of experience in designing of network, preparation of technical specification, system testing & commissioning and operation & maintenance of IP/transmission networks in any large organisation.
- Strong interpersonal and managerial skills.

ii. Manager, Customer Relationship & Event Management (Package No. S-21.5-AF) - 1 position

200 cannabis plants destroyed

Members of Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) destroyed around 200 cannabis plants at a field in the remote char area of the Jamuna River in Sirajganj district on Tuesday night. They also arrested two people on charge of cultivating the plants on one acre of land. The arrestees are Abdus Salam, 38, and Moyan Uddin, 33, of the area, said Additional Superintendent of Police Mohiuddin Faruki, commander of Tangail Rab camp. Acting on a tip-off, a team of Rab-12 raided the area and found the cannabis plants on the land. They later destroyed the plants and arrested the two from the spot.

Human trafficker arrested

Police arrested an alleged member of a gang of human traffickers from a bus in Bhababiganj bus stand area of the district town on Monday. The arrestee is Nahid Hossain, a resident of the area. Nazrul Islam, officer in-charge of Sadar Police Station, said Nahid had long been involved in trafficking people from various upazilas of the district in the name of giving them jobs. On secret information, police conducted a drive in the area at noon and arrested the trafficker while he was going to Dhaka by the bus, the OC added.

Boy electrocuted

A teenage boy was electrocuted at Hatbari village under Sarishabari municipality of the district on Tuesday afternoon. The deceased is Hasan Ali, 16, son of Sultan Mahmud of the village. Locals and family sources said the boy came in contact with a live electric wire while he was working on a switch board at his house. He was rushed to the upazila health complex where the on-duty doctors declared him dead.

Man found dead

Police recovered the body of a man from a mango orchard in Shiala Colony area of the district town yesterday. The dead is Lokman Ali, 50, son of Kalimuddin of Shiala Colony area. Sarwar Hossain, officer-in-charge of Sadar Police Station, said criminals might have killed Lokman as the body bore several injury marks.

Two car lifters held
