Why should victims not get financial aid

HC tells government to explain in a month

The High Court yesterday asked the government to explain in four weeks why victims of arson at Kalshi Bihari camp in Mirpur last year should not be provided with financial aid.

The HC came up with the rule after hearing a writ petition filed by two Urdu speaking people of the camp seeking its order on the government to give adequate financial assistance to the victims.

Home secretary, cabinet secretary, senior secretary to the prime minister's office, inspector general of police, deputy commissioner of Dhaka, commissioner of Dhaka Metropolitan Police, deputy commissioner of police of Mirpur Zone, joint commissioner of Detective Branch and officer-in-charge of Pallabi Police Station have been made respondents to the rule.

Md Sadakat Khan and Sayeed Ali Bablu recently filed the petition saying nine people of a family were burnt alive and many others were injured when miscreants set fire to several houses at the camp in Dhaka on June 14.

Another person was killed in police firing during clashes with people of the camp over fire cracker explosion, they said in the petition, adding that the victims did not get any financial help from the government.

The petitioners said a case was filed in connection with the murder incident on June 15 last year with Pallabi Police Station, but there has been no significant progress in the investigation into the incident.

They prayed to the court to direct the authorities concerned of the government to submit the progress report on the investigation of the case.

BCC cleaners pile up garbage at land office

They were protesting jailing of colleague for same offence

Cleaners and sweepers of Barisal City Corporation yesterday piled up garbage in front of the assistant commissioner's (land) office after a mobile court convicted one of their colleagues for dumping waste on the same spot.

They also demonstrated at the land office in the city's Launch Ghat area for around four hours from 11:00am after the court, led by Executive Magistrate Md Iliasur Rahman, also the assistant commissioner (land), had jailed Saddam Hossain for 15 days.

However, Additional District Magistrate Zakir Hossain granted Saddam bail for seven days when he appealed to him, said Dipak Lal Mridha, cleanig officer of BCC.

Iliasur Rahman alleged that BCC turned the land office's main entrance into a "garbage station" and it continued dumping waste despite their repeated requests to remove those.

Finding no other suitable places, they had to dump garbage there for a year, said BCC Chief Executive Officer Ranajit Kumar, adding that they decided to change the spot.

Don't stiff low income communities

Wasa officers urged at orientation

Field-level officers and staff of Water Supply and Sewerage Authority (Wasa) should not discriminate while dealing with water supply problems of low income communities, said speakers at a programme in the capital yesterday.

They were addressing a two-day orientation organised for engineers and officers of four zones Wasa by Dushtha Shasthya Kendra (DSK) and Concerned Women for Family Development at The Daily Star Centre.

Dr Liakath Ali, director of Programmes and Policy Advocacy of WaterAid, said WASH (water, sanitation, and hygiene promotion) is a right which needs to be ensured.

"Slum dwellers, especially women, face various kinds of problem in using toilets," he said, adding that scarcity of water is the main constraint for them.

Khalilur Rahman, director (finance) of Dhaka Wasa, said the orientation will help their officers and staff learn how to deal with people's sufferings in the area more efficiently.

Deputy Managing Director of Wasa Sayed Golam Ahammad, among others, addressed the orientation on DWASA Services for Water Supply at Low Income Communities.

Bangabandhu's murder, most AL leaders queued up to join the cabinet of Khondaker Moshtaq Ahmad, who became president on August 15, 1975, the day Bangabandhu was killed.

"The Awami League should see its face in the mirror. JSD played a courageous role in ousting Moshtaq's government," JSD General Secretary Sharif Nurul Ambia told The Daily Star.

He also suggested that the AL leaders should move forward and stop going back to the past. "Please don't make the future politics difficult," Ambia said.

On Monday, BNP too questioned JSD's role in the lead-up to Bangabandhu's assassination and asked its chief to respond to the allegations.

Against the backdrop, JSD questioned

the coincidence between the speeches of BNP and Selim.

Hanif yesterday denied there was any coincidence. "Trying to locate any link between Selim Bhai and BNP's speeches is nothing but an attempt to conceal historic truth," he said.

Meanwhile, BNP's senior leader Nazrul Islam Khan yesterday said although the government was blocking the party's peaceful programmes, they would not choose an alternative path like JSD did in 1975 to go to power.

He said, "The government is obstructing our all programmes and activities, including party reform. Which alternative can we take when our peaceful programmes are hampered... some parties like JSD had chosen alternatives, but we're not that kind of political party and we don't want to follow that path."
