Boy abducted from Dhaka rescued in Thakurgaon

Rapid Action Battalion (Rab)-13 in Nilphamari rescued a minor boy from abductors at Chourasta intersection in adjacent Thakurgaon town on Monday, 11 days after the same force rescued five-year-old Riad, abducted from Gazipur in Dhaka, on August 13.

The boy rescued on Monday is Safid, 5, son of Md Shamim, a golf club employee in the capital.

"Safid was abducted from Khilkhet area in Dhaka city by his teenage aunt and her middle-aged boyfriend. Rab also arrested the two abductors," said Aklamul Hossain, commander of Rab-13 camp in Nilphamari.

"Pinki Begum, 14, daughter of Liton Mia, 45, a vegetable vendor working at Mirpur-14 in the capital, had intimacy with Kohinor Begum, 15, sister-in-law of Safid's father Shamim. Liton developed an affair with Kohinor although he is married and has two adolescent children," he said.

Liton Mia told Kohinor that they would marry soon and instigated her to abduct her nephew Safid for realising ransom money to meet their need.

With the help of Kohinor, Liton abducted Safid on Thursday noon and they took the victim to Thakurgaon by bus.

Liton hails from Digolgram village in Panchagarh district, bordering Thakurgaon and

Nilphamari districts.

As the abductors demanded Tk 3 lakh as ransom from Shamim through mobile phone for getting back his son, he lodged a GD with the local police station and informed Rab-1 of the matter.

Rab-1 conveyed the matter to Rab-13 in Nilphamari.

Applying modern technology, the elite force detected the location of the abductors who were staying at a house in Thakurgaon for three days.

About 7:30pm of Monday, Rab raided the house, rescued the boy and arrested the two abductors from the spot.

After interrogation at Nilphamari camp, Rab handed over the arrestees to police.

50 injured in clash over land dispute

At least 50 people were injured in a clash over a land dispute between two groups of people of Madhabpur and Khargaon villages under Chhatak upazila of Sunamganj district.

According to sources, there had been longstanding dispute between Tota Miah of Madhabpur village

and Mohiuddin of Khargaon village over the ownership of a land on the border of the two villages.

Mohiuddin's men attacked Tota Miah and his men while they were working on the disputed land at around 9:00am. The rival groups locked in a clash, leaving at least 50 people from both sides injured.

Of the injured, 36 were admitted to Chhatak

Upazila Health Complex and Sunamganj Sadar Hospital, while the rest to Sylhet MAG Osmani Medical College Hospital.

On information, police rushed to the spot and fired nine rounds of teargas shells to bring the situation under control.

Contacted, Ashraful Islam, officer-in-charge of Chhatak Police Station, said police have been deployed in the area to fend-off further trouble.

Two kids drown in canal

Two children drowned in a canal at Durakuti village in Sadar upazila of the district yesterday afternoon. The deceased are Mohit Islam, 2, son of Abdul Mannan, and his cousin Mahim Islam, 3, son of Sirazul Islam of the village. Family sources said the two fell into the canal beside their house while playing on its bank and drowned.

Drug peddler gets life

A court here yesterday sentenced a drug peddler to life imprisonment and fined him Tk 5,000. The lifer is Omar Ali, 40, son of late Shahanat Ullah of Talpatti Char village in Gangachara upazila. According to the prosecution, members of Narcotics Control Department in the district arrested Omar Ali with 112 bottles of phensidyl at his house on October 11, 2004. A case was filed with Gangachara Model Police Station against Omar Ali. After examining witnesses and evidence, Additional District and Sessions Judge Abu Zafar Md Kamruzzaman found him guilty and pronounced the verdict.

Husband kills wife

A housewife was killed allegedly by her husband at Ghion village in Nachole upazila of the district yesterday. The deceased is Selina Begum, 50, wife of Hazrat Ali of the village. Tarikul Islam, officer-in-charge of Nachole Police Station, said Hazrat stabbed Selina, leaving her critically injured following an altercation over family matter around 4:00am. She later died on way to Rajshahi Medical College and Hospital. Police arrested Hazrat in this connection, said the OC.

Man hacked to death

A man was hacked to death by rivals in Sadar upazila of the district on Monday. The deceased is Delwar Sheikh, 60, of Purbo Kadamtawla village. Family sources said Delwar and his brother Babul Sheikh, 55, went out of house following a phone from an unknown caller around 9:30pm. Later, they were found injured at a garden near their home. The two were rushed to Pirojpur Sadar Hospital where on-duty doctors declared Delwar dead. Police arrested one Nasir Sheikh, son of late Jalil Sheikh of the area, in this connection, said SP Md Walid Hossain.

Youth electrocuted

A youth was electrocuted in Birampur upazila of the district yesterday. The dead is Mizanur Rahman, son of Mahmud Hasan of Bhaduria village. Police said the youth came in contact with a live electric wire when he was going to toilet at their house in the morning. He died on the spot.

Lightning injures 30

The injured include Farida Begum, 27, Dipti Akhter, 8, Rabeya Akhter, 12, Marzia Akhter, 8, Maharup Hossain, 7, Ramisa Begum, 44, Samiul Islam, 13, Rumana Akhter, 9, Mahfuza Akhter, 11, Suzon Islam, 12, of Banglabari village, Akhlina Begum, 45, of Mirzaccourt village, Habiba Akhter, 7, of Dhabolsuti village, Alam Hossain, 35, of Jagatber village, Mariom Akhter, 10, and Dipu Islam, 12, of Ufarmara village, Shaheda Bewa, 62, of Panbari village, and Enamul Haque, 35, Akhi Akhter, 22, of Mominpur village. Of them, 21 were admitted to the upazila health complex, said hospital sources.

One held with firearm

Later, he was handed over to Hakimpur police.

Indian clothes seized

Members of Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) seized Indian sarees, three pieces and tea worth about Tk 5.40 crore at Buikura village in Abhoynagar upazila of Jessore district early yesterday. Lt Col Jahangir Hossain, commanding officer of BGB-26 Battalion, said on secret information, the border guards raided the area and seized the smuggled items. None was arrested in this connection, said the CO.

SHIMULIA-KAWRAKANDI ROUTE

Poor navigability of river disrupts ferry services

Ferry service in the Shimulia-Kawrakandi route, which is known as the gateway to 21 districts of southern part of the country, has been disrupted for the last five days due to poor navigability and strong current in the Padma, causing suffering to commuters.

Almost all passenger buses changed their route yesterday to avoid Shimulia ghat, while three to four hundred goods-laden trucks got stuck on both sides of the Shimulia-

Kawrakandi route.

Md Ashiquzzaman, assistant general manager of Bangladesh Inland Water Transport Corporation (BIWTC) said, "Ferry Kusumkali and ferry Camelia are plying the river for the last two days and they have made only four trips, while the 18 ferries on the route generally made 70 to 80 trips a day. The rest 16 ferries are not running."

Ferry service has been hampered for almost three weeks on this route and travellers are crossing the river by launches and speed-boats, risking their lives.

Meanwhile, a team of 12 members conducted survey on the route yesterday, and two powerful dredgers of Padma Bridge Project will start dredging in the channel of the river today.

Md Sultan Ahmed Khan, executive engineer (Dredging) of Bangladesh Inland Water Transport Authority (BIWTA), said "Using these dredgers will help ferry service return to normalcy."

Dredging is needed to have enough water in the channel, but the silt coming with the strong current fills up of the channel, the engineer said.
