## Police obstruct protest march to ministry

Police yesterday barred the leaders and activists of the Communist Party of Bangladesh (CPB), and Bangladesher Samajtantrik Dal (BSD) from laying siege to the power, energy and mineral resources ministry to protest the government's decision to hike gas and power tariff.

While the leaders and activists were going towards the ministry, the law enforcers blocked their way near gate no-5 of Bangladesh Secretariat in the capital.

The protesters, numbering around 150, then sat on the road there and held a protest rally.

They criticised the government for its decision to hike gas and power tariff and urged it to reduce the existing price.

Speakers said the companies generating power and distributing gas are already making profit.

Ruhin Hossain Prince, presidium member of the Communist Party of Bangladesh, said, "With the price hike money will pour into the companies from pockets of the common people." The parties threatened to go for

tougher programmes if the government does not meet their demand within eight days.

Khalequzzaman, general secretary of BSD, said increase of the price of

power and gas is illogical and it is a move against the people.

"History shows that no one retained power for long by going against the people," he said, and suggested the government learn from the past.

Syed Abu Jafar Ahmed, general secretary of CPB, said if their demand was not met, they would observe a sitin on September 8.

Retail customers will have to spend, on average, 2.93 percent more on electricity and Tk 200 more on gas stoves from September 1. Industries that use gas to produce electricity through generators will see gas tariff double -- Tk 8.36 from Tk 4.18 per cubic metre.

#### SCBA demands re-election to Bar Council

Alleges unprecedented irregularities

The Supreme Court Bar Association (SCBA), dominated by pro-BNP lawyers, yesterday demanded suspension of the results of recently held elections to Bangladesh Bar Council, and holding its re-election citing "unprecedented irregularities."

SCBA Secretary AM Mahbub Uddin Khokon urged the chief justice to appoint a judge to investigate the "unprecedented irregularities and unlawful activities" in the elections and take steps to prepare a correct voter-list for holding a re-election.

While addressing a briefing in the SCBA auditorium, he claimed a total of 1,342 SCBA lawyers could not cast votes and names of total 7,417 lawyers of Dhaka Bar Association were deleted from the voter list.

He claimed that many lawyers of different bars across the country could not cast their votes and if they had cast votes in a free and fair manner then pro-BNP lawyers' panel -- Jatiyatabadi Ainjibi Oikya Panel -- would win all 14 posts in the Bar Council election.

Referring to the decision to build a deep-sea port in Pairabond instead of the predeclared Sonadia in Cox's Bazar, ABM Mohiuddin Chowdhury, former Chittagong City Corporation mayor, yesterday alleged that people of Chittagong have been deceived.

He also claimed that the authorities concerned have decided to shift the route of the proposed Asian Highway to Sylhet from Chittagong as well.

Speaking at a press conference, he demanded construction of a link road between Chittagong port and the proposed Asian Highway for development of the country.

Mohiuddin, also president of the city unit Awami League, said building a deep-sea port in Sonadia was an electoral pledge of the prime minister. To that end, a feasibility study at a huge cost was conducted, which gave the green signal to build the port in Sonadia. He claimed that several experts
