Downpours lead to flooding in Dinajpur, Jamalpur towns

Heavy downpour caused massive waterlogging in Dinajpur and Jamal district towns yesterday, much to the sufferings of the residents.

Torrential rain continuing for 15 hours till yesterday morning submerged a large portion of Dinajpur town and adjacent areas, reports our correspondent.

The most affected areas are Kalitola, Chotogurga, Mirzapur, Bangibechaghat and Khanchanghat in the town.

At different places, people were seen shifting their home furniture to other places to save it from water.

"We spent a sleepless night," said Sova of Kalitola area.

Uday Basak, a resident of Kalitola Haripara, said the flooding caused by rainwater washed away most of their light belongings like plastic made utensils.

Knee-deep water gathered on Balubari-Phulbari bus stand road on Sunday night as the drainage system in the municipality is too poor, said Abdur Rahman, a resident of Balubari area.

The Met office of Dinajpur recorded 196mm rainfall during the 15 hours from 3:00pm Sunday to 6:00am yesterday morning, which is highest rainfall in this season.

Water level of different rivers has also risen following the rainfall in last two days.

Around 2,000 bighas of paddy land in the district went under water.

Ashiqur Rahman, senior station officer of Dinajpur Met office, has predicted more rainfall.

The office recorded 590mm rainfall in August this year.

Our Jamalpur correspondent adds: Incessant rain for nine hours from 3:00am to 12:00pm yesterday caused massive water-logging on roads, grounds of educational institutions, kitchen markets and business centres in different areas of the

district town.

Roads at Ikbalpur, Nayapara, Banakura, Sardarpara Mukandabari Mridhapara, Langoljora, Panch Rasta More, Malgudam Road and around two kilometre of the main road from Gatepar to Lambagachh went under knee-deep water, much to the suffering of the townspeople, especially school-going students.

"A section of residents throw polythene bags, plastic garbage and other wastes to drains and canals. The unwise act badly affects drainage system and it causes waterlogging during heavy rainfall," said Nurul Islam, secretary of Jamalpur municipality.

Youth rescued 2 days into abduction

Members of Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) rescued a youth from Hazigari area in Sadar upazila of the district on Sunday, two days after his abduction.

They also arrested two people for their alleged involvement in the abduction, said Major AFM Azmal Hossain Khan, company commander of Rab-12.

The victim is Shamim Mia, 27, son of Khairul Islam of Khamargobindapur area in Sadar upazila of Gaibandha district.

Rab and family sources said Shamim went missing on August 28. Later, a general diary was filed with Gaibandha Sadar Police Station.

Acting on a tip-off, the elite force raided Hazigari area on Sunday night and rescued Shamim. They also arrested the abductors from the spot.

The arrestees are Shahed Sheikh alias Moni Sheikh, 25, son of Shahanur Sheikh, and Md Kamruzzaman, 24, son of Abdul Zabbar of Purbo Palsha village in Bogra Sadar upazila.

Rape of madrasa girl sparks protest in Pirojpur

A human chain was formed in Mathbaria upazila of Pirojpur district yesterday, demanding arrest and exemplary punishment of the culprit who raped a madrasa girl at Paschim Lakkhan village in the upazila on the night of August 13.

Several thousand students from eight educational institutions joined the hour-long programme at Bandhabpara Bazaar in the upazila at 12:00 noon. Addressing a rally at the venue, the speakers demanded immediate arrest

of the rapist.

At around 9:00pm on the night, Hasan Akon, 20, son of Abu Saleh Akon, went to the neighbouring house of the victim, and asked for a matchbox. Taking advantage of the fact that the victim's mother lives abroad and her father was out of the house at that time, Akon raped the girl.

The victim's father filed a case with the Mathbaria Police Station the following day, accusing Hasan.

Khandakar Mostafizur Rahman, officer-in-charge of Mathbaria Police Station, said they are trying to arrest

the rapist.

Meanwhile, Pirojpur district police have taken steps to create awareness among the people against women and children repression. They have pasted colour posters at different spots in the district, urging the people to prevent those crimes.

The cellphone number of the superintendent of police (SP) has been given in the poster. By typing 373, anyone will be able to send message to 01713374330 informing the police about any incident of stalking and repression of women and children.

Four rice mills fined for polluting environment

SHOOTING AT NATORE RALLY Ex-minister Dulu among 100 sued

At least 100 BNP men, including president of district unit and former deputy minister Ruhul Quddus Talukder Dulu, have been sued on charge of shooting at a Jubo League rally in the town on Saturday.

Two men of Jubo League and Bangladesh Chhatra League were injured in the shooting, said Mizanur Rahman, officer-in-charge of Natore Police Station.

Nazim Uddin, secretary of ward No 9 unit of Awami League, and 8 No ward unit Jubo League president Qamrul Islam on Sunday filed two cases in connection with the incident, he said.

On Saturday evening, BNP activists allegedly led by Faisal Alam Babul, joint secretary of district unit of Swetchhasebak Dal, opened fire on the Jubo League rally near Mamun Bakery at Tebaria in the town.

Nazmul Islam, joint convener of Natore municipality unit of Jubo League, and Rajib Hossain, an activist of Chhatra League, were bullet-hit in the incident.

Later, Nazmul and Rajib were admitted to Natore Sadar Hospital and Rajshahi Medical College Hospital respectively.

Police arrested 23 BNP men in this connection, said the OC.

ATTACK ON KABI NAZRUL UNIV DEAN

Two including prime accused arrested

Police yesterday arrested two persons including prime accused Tariqul Hasan Tareq on charge of assaulting Dr Subrata Kumar Dey, dean of business administration faculty of Jatiya Kabi Nazrul Islam University, on Wednesday night.

Dr Dey, also director of finance and accounts department of the university in Trishal upazila under Mymensingh district, was beaten up allegedly by Tareq, a contractor of Dhaka-based Haider Construction, and his men over paying back his security money pending with the university, said sources.

Tareq went into hiding after the incident. "On information, a police team led by sub-inspector Shibirul Islam arrested Tareq from Tejgoan area in Dhaka this morning. He has been taken to Mymensingh Kotwali Police Station and is being interrogated," said Md Kamrul Islam, officer-in-charge of the police station.

Police also arrested Anwarul Haque from his Charnikhola residence in Ishwarganj upazila for his alleged involvement in the assault on Dr Dey. Anwarul, president of

Projonmo League Ishwarganj upazila unit was handed over to Mymensingh Detective Branch of Police in the afternoon, said Borhan Uddin, officer in charge of Ishwarganj Police Station.

Earlier on Wednesday night, a case was lodged with Kotwali Police Station under Speedy Trial Act against 10/15 people including Tareq, police said.

Dr Dey was assaulted when he was on way to his residence in Mymensingh town Wednesday night. Hearing scream, locals rescued him and took him to Mymensingh Medical College Hospital.

The teachers and students of the university observed a strike yesterday demanding arrest of all other accused and their exemplary punishment.

"We demand arrest of all the accused, making the contractor 'black listed' and seizing his security money by Thursday. If the demands are not met, we will go for strike from Sunday next. However, the examinations will be held," said Tapon Kumar Sarker, secretary of Jatiya Kabi Nazrul Islam University Shikkhak Samity.
