The calories in frappes range from 200 to a whopping 800 calories, based on the size of the drink. The range of recommended calories is from 1,600 to 2,400 calories per day for adult women and 2,000 to 3,000 calories per day for adult men, depending on age and physical activity level. Thus, one frappe itself could eat up a huge portion of your daily calorie intake! So, if you are watching your silhouette, beware! I would recommend you reach for a healthy smoothie instead and leave the frappe as a reward for shedding a few pounds...








Hi. I'm a 19 year old. I got my keloid on my ear as a result of a bad piercing. I went to my doctor and she said she won't treat it with a steroid injection as I have acne problem which can get worse after injection. Why did I get keloid? What do you recommend for my treatment?

Dear Mashiyat,

Keloids of the ear and earlobe from piercings are quite common. Keloids are the result of abnormal wound healing. Usually they occur at the site of skin damage spontaneously after acne, burns, chicken pox, cuts, insect bites, piercings, surgery, tattoos or vaccinations.



Whether or not a keloid will form is not determined by the severity of the wound but due to deformed healing process, even from a minor skin abrasion.

A mainstay for both treatment and prevention is the injection of steroids such as triamcinolone directly into the keloid but patients with acne or menstrual irregularities



may face that the situation is getting worse sometimes, so better to avoid in such cases.


In your situation, my recommendation would be removal of keloid by Doide laser which helps to heal it fast with no bleeding or infection and later use of silicone sheet dressing and postoperative compression for more perfection.

You are most welcome if you are planning for the treatment by Diode laser. It will be the safest and the most advanced option for you. Take care.
