

Man gets life for killing father

A court here yesterday sentenced a man to life imprisonment for killing his father in Jaldhaka upazila of the district on January 23, 2012.

The deceased is Azgar Ali, 58.

According to the prosecution, Azgar had expressed his desire to get married for a second time some days after the death of his wife.

At this, his two sons, Mosfiqur Rahman, 27, and Golam Mostofa, 24, became furious and made frantic efforts to persuade Azgar to change his decision, but failed.

Azgar was found strangled on the night of January 23, 2012.

Afsar Ali, elder brother of the deceased, filed a murder case with Jaldhaka Police Station the following day,

accusing the two brothers.

Police arrested the two brothers and produced them before the Additional District and Sessions Judge's Court, where younger brother Golam Mostofa confessed to killing his father.

After that, police submitted the charge sheet to the court, excluding the name of elder brother Mosfiqur Rahman on the basis of the confessional statement of Golam Mostofa.

Advocate Azizul Islam, lawyer for the state, said the court, excluding the name of elder brother Mosfiqur Rahman on the basis of the confessional statement of the lone accused, and found Mostofa guilty under Section 302 of the Penal Code.

Md Mahbul Alam, Additional District and Sessions Judge of Nilphamari, pronounced the verdict and fined him Tk 10 thousand. In default, he is to serve six

BEATING OF STUDENT

Aggrieved locals confine teacher for hours

Aggrieved guardians kept a teacher of Balapukur Government Primary School in Aditmari upazila under the district confined to the office room for four hours yesterday as she mercilessly beat a student in the classroom.

The school managing committee members freed the teacher in the afternoon, giving assurance of justice in a meeting to be held today.

Teacher Mukta Banu beat Class V student Shanta

Akhter, 11, yesterday noon as punishment for three days' absence, school sources said.

As Shanta fell sick, the matter was spread among the guardians and locals.

Shanta's father Nazrul Islam of Balapukur village and other students' guardians rushed to the school and confined the teacher for four hours from 12:30pm to 4:30pm.

Mukta Banu often beats the students in the classrooms although three other teachers of the school do not, students said.

Several guardians said their repeated request to Mukta Banu not to beat the students earlier fell into deaf ears.

Contacted, Mukta Banu said, "I gave mild punishment to the student as she was absent for three days. I did it for her betterment."

School managing committee Chairman Abdul Jalil said, "It is bad to beat students in the classroom. Schoolteachers, managing committee members and students' guardians will sit tomorrow [Thursday] for settlement of the matter."

3 gamblers sent to jail, 4 others fined

A mobile court sentenced three gamblers to one month's imprisonment at Sarpukur village in Aditmari upazila of Lalmonirhat district early yesterday, reports our correspondent.

The convicts are Shahidul Islam, 25, son of Taher Ali, Golzar Ali, 50, son of late Azizur Rahman and Jaynal Abedin, 45, son of late Maful Uddin of Patantari village in the upazila.

Upazila Nirbahi Officer Jahurul Islam led the court, said police.

In Bogra, a mobile court on Tuesday fined four gamblers arrested from Dhunat upazila office area in the district, reports our correspondent.

They are Abdul Kafi, 48, son of Keramat Ali, Anil Kumar, 25, son of Provat Kumar, Saiful Islam, 27, son of Abdul Hamid, and Abdul Alim, 34, son of Yakub Ali of Bilchhapri village under the upazila.

Acting on a tip-off, police raided Bichapri village on Monday and arrested the four while they were gambling.

They were produced before the mobile court of Executive Magistrate Hafizur Rahman, also the upazila nirbahi officer, yesterday. After hearing, the court pronounced the verdict.

Contacted, Mizanur Rahman, officer-in-charge of Dhunat Police Station, said the court fined them Tk 1500. They were released after paying the fine.

Bandarban ex-mayor arrested

Both of them allegedly made the comment demeaning Bangabandhu through Facebook recently, said Amir Hossain, investigation officer of Sadar Police Station. A case will be filed against the duo under Information and Communication Technology Act, he said.

Lightning kills schoolgirl

A schoolgirl was killed by lightning at Jamdia village in Bagharpara upazila of Jessore district on Tuesday night. The dead is Suraiya Khatun, 9, daughter of Mostain Hossain, and a student of Class III of Samdia Government Primary School in the area. Family sources said a thunderbolt hit the girl and her grandmother while they were sitting in the veranda of their house. Suraiya died on the spot.

2 drug peddlers held

Police arrested two drug peddlers with 500 bottles of phensidyl in Dhob Pukur area under Shibganj upazila of the district on Tuesday night. The arrestees are Sahbul Hossain, 35, son of Mansur Hossain of Binodpur-Kapratola village, and Mohammad Wasim, 25, son of Harunur Rashid of Koilar Diar in the upazila. A police team, on secret information, raided the area and arrested the duo with the phensidyl, said Shaymol Kumar, sub-inspector of Shibganj Police Station.

Jubo League man stabbed

A local Jubo League leader was stabbed by an activist of a rival faction in Sadar upazila on Tuesday afternoon. The injured is Saiful Islam Sentu, president of 11 No ward unit of Jubo League, and son of Sobhan Sheikh of Hossainpur area. Police said local Jubo League activist Sohel locked into an altercation with Saiful over a tender-related issue on the upazila parishad office premises around 3:00pm. At one stage, Sohel stabbed Saiful indiscriminately, leaving him seriously injured. He was admitted to Sirajganj Sadar Hospital.

Stalker jailed

A mobile court yesterday sentenced a stalker at Kathalbari union under Kurigram Sadar upazila to one year's imprisonment. The convict is Moula Mia, 25, son of Afer Ali of Shanwashi village in Holokhona union under the upazila. Locals held Moula at Kumarpara area of Kathalbari union while he was teasing the girl on her way to school at 10:00am, and handed him over to the police.

Three human traffickers arrested in Cox's Bazar

Three human traffickers were arrested in Ukhia and Teknaf upazilas of the district yesterday.

The detainees are Moulvi Ali Ahmed, 45, son of Thanda Mian of Lafargona village in Teknaf upazila; Imam Hossain, 30, son of Sabbir Ahmed of Tulatali village, and Sayed Ahmed

alias Saya, 30, of Sonarpara village under Ukhia upazila.

Md Ataur Rahman Khandaker, officer-in-charge (OC) of Teknaf Police Station, said law enforcers arrested Ali Ahmed, an absconding accused in several cases for murder and human trafficking, in a raid at Lafargona village at around 7:00am.

Police arrested Imam Hossain and Saya from Sonarpara village. The two, were wanted in human trafficking cases, said Officer-in-Charge Jahurul Islam Khan of Ukhia Police Station.

Later, the arrestees were produced before the Teknaf and Ukhia senior judicial magistrate's court, which sent them to jail.

The fellowship program is a continuation of 50 (Ph.D., M.Sc. and Diploma) SAWA Fellowships provided previously under the Crossing Boundaries Project (www.saciwaters.org/CB; www.buet.ac.bd/iwfm) over a 5-year period (2006-2011). SAWA Fellowships are now being provided by IWFM, BUET under the IDRC-South Asian Water (SAWA) Fellowship Project with financial support from the International Development Research Centre (IDRC), Canada (www.idrc.ca). The other academic partner institutions of the project from South Asian region are Anna University from India, University of Peradeniya from Sri Lanka and Nepal Engineering College from Nepal. The Project is administered by Saci/WATERS (South Asian Consortium for Interdisciplinary Water Resources Studies), India (www.saciwaters.org).

The research focus of the SAWA Fellows will be Climate Change and Food Security in the Context of IWRM. The overall research outline of the fellowship program can be found at the IWFM website (www.buet.ac.bd/iwfm).

SAWA Fellowship

Seven full-time student fellowships will be provided for pursuing M.Sc. (WRD) (Tk. 20,000/- per month).

Fellows will have opportunities to attend regional workshops and form network with fellows in other partner institutions of South Asia.

Preference will be given to women candidates

Admission Requirement

For admission in M.Sc. (WRD), an applicant must have either a four-year Bachelor's degree in Civil Engineering/Water Resources Engineering/Agricultural Engineering/Urban and Regional Planning/Environmental Science/Environmental Science and Management/Soil, Water and Environment/Geography and Environment/Geology/Disaster Management or its equivalent having a minimum GPA of 2.5 out of 4.0 or P.G. Dip. (WRD) or its equivalent having a minimum GPA of 2.65 out of 4.0 from any recognized institution.

In addition, all other rules and regulations of BUET regarding admission will be applicable.

Deadlines for Application

To apply for admission and fellowship, an applicant must complete the online Application Form using the website <http://www.buet.ac.bd>, and submit the hardcopy of the completed Application Form together with the supporting documents to the BUET Registrar's Office within the period from **29 August to 21 September, 2015**.

Selection Procedure

Candidates for fellowship will be selected on the basis of two stage written examination/interview, one for admission and the other for fellowship.
