### AG concerned over incident of securing bail thru false documents

last year.

Attorney General (AG) Mahbubey Alam yesterday expressed grave concern at a reported incident of getting bail of an accused from the High Court through submitting false documents.

According a report published in the daily Prothom Alo, accused Lucky Aktar alias Mukta obtained bail from an HC bench, claiming herself as an accused in a narcotic case on July 9. She, however, is an accused in a gold smuggling case.

Later on the bench identified false documents and cancelled her bail, the report said.

Yesterday, while talking to reporters at his office, the attorney general said a section of fraud and dishonest lawyers place false information to the court for securing orders in favour of them.

He suggested that a specific bench of the HC should be constituted for hearing such allegations against the lawyers and for their trial and punishment.

The Bangladesh Bar Council, licensing and regulatory body of lawyers, has received many of such allegations, but huge time is needed for their disposals, Mahbubey Alam added.

# Three suspects denied bail

A Dhaka court yesterday rejected bail of three alleged members of banned militant outfit Ansarullah Bangla Team and sent them to jail after completion of their three-day remand in blogger and writer Avijit Roy killing case.

The suspected militants are Towhidur Rahman, a Bangladeshi-born British citizen and information technology expert, Sadek Ali and Aminul Mollick.

In yesterday's report, the investigation officer said he gathered important information about the killing and they need to be confined until the investigation completes.

Earlier on August 19, another Dhaka court placed them on a seven-day remand.

Avijit was hacked to death on the Dhaka University campus in February.

Rapid Action Battalion arrested them in the capital's Nilkhet and Dhanmondi on August 17 and 18.

## Road crash kills two

Two passengers of a CNG-run auto-rickshaw were killed and its driver injured after a bus hit the three-wheeler in the capital's Kakrail area early yesterday.

Rubel Sheikh, 28, a tanker driver by profession, and his helper Mohammad Asif, 25, both inhabitants of Adamjee area in Narayanganj, were declared dead on arrival at Dhaka Medical College Hospital. CNG driver Firoz was receiving treatment at the hospital.

Police seized the bus from the spot but its driver and his deputy fled the scene.

Abul Mansur Ahmad was a rare personality who amalgamated politics, journalism and literature in his writings with a perfect blend of satire and wit to represent social reality and political history, said speakers yesterday. His writings are universal and perfect for imbuing the

new generation with human values, speakers said at a programme organised by Abul Mansur Ahmad Janmobarshiki Udjapon Parishad at Jaitya Press Club marking his 117th birth anniversary.

Addressing as the chief guest, Prime Minister's Media Adviser Iqbal Sobhan Chowdhury said his each and every work was done for the welfare of the society. "And it is high time we followed his life and works," he added.

Mahfuz Anam, editor and publisher of The Daily Star, said his father, Abul Mansur, never compromised when it was about dignity. Journalist Rahat Khan, who presided over the

programme, said Abul Mansur was a versatile person. Cultural personality M Hamid said many discussions

were held only on the crisis of value but Mansur showed the way to building them. President of Jatiya Press Club Md Shafiqur Rahman,

journalist Amanullah Kabir, and IT expert Mostafa Zabbar spoke among others. A successful politician, Abul Mansur Ahmad was the provin-

cial education minister in the United Front cabinet under Sher-

e-Bangla AK Fazlul Huq in 1954 and the central commerce and industries minister in the Awami League government of the then prime minister Hossain Shaheed Suhrawardy in 1957. He was known for his strong stand on matters of interest to East Abul Mansur Ahmad's publications include great satires like Aina, Asmani Purdah, Gulliverer Safar Nama, and Food

Conference. His works also include important writings on social and political history of Bengal. He has two autobiographical writings -- Atma Katha (About Myself), and Amar Dekha Rajnitir Panchash Bachhar (50 years of politics as I have seen it). Abul Mansur Ahmad always propagated secularism in a

manner unparalleled in the forties, fifties and sixties. His contribution towards opposition movement in the early days of Pakistan was extremely significant.

He wrote about the language issue from the early forties and contributed to the Language Movement as the editor of the Ittehad. He was the author of Ekush Dafa, the election manifesto of Jukta Front (a grand coalition of the three giants of politics back then, Sher-e-Bangla AK Fazlul Huq, Moulana Bhashani, and Shaheed Suhrawardy) in the 1954 election, in which the Muslim League was routed as a political party. The 21-point programme (Ekush Dafa) was the first comprehensive articulation of the political, economic and cultural demands of the Bangalees of the then eastern part of Pakistan.
