

Three confess to killing Natore madrasa boy

UNB, Natore
Three accused in the case for killing Mohammad Tanvir, a student of Ashraful Uloom Madrasa in the district, gave their confessional statement before a court here on Wednesday.

Senior Judicial Magistrate Anamul Haque Bashunia recorded their statement for three hours from 5:00pm to 8:00pm. On the night of August 25, madrasa students

Bayezid and Hossain and their friend Naim called Tanvir to their room. They slaughtered Tanvir and dumped the body into a septic tank.

Later, they demanded Tk 5 lakh as ransom from Tanvir's father.

Tanvir's father filed a general diary with Sadar Police Station the following day and informed Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) of the matter.

Members of Rab-5 arrested Bayezid by tracking his mobile phone. After interrogation, Bayezid confessed to his involvement in the murder and gave information about two other murderers.

On the basis of his statement, the elite force recovered Tanvir's body from the septic tank. They also arrested Hossain and Naim in connection with the killing.

1,500 kg hilsa seized in Satkhira

Members of Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) seized 1,500 kilograms of hilsa while those were being smuggled to India through Alipur check post area at Bhomra border point under Sadar upazila of the district yesterday.

Major Mozammel Haque, deputy commander of BGB-38 Battalion, said the border guards, acting on a tip-off, conducted a drive in the area and intercepted a truck loaded with hilsa packed in 35 cartons in the morning.

They later seized the hilsa from the vehicle, said the BGB official.

However, the smugglers and trucker managed to flee the scene, sensing the presence of the BGB members, he said.

KILLING OF 3 ALLEGED ABDUCTORS

Six accused placed on 2-day remand in Pabna

A court here yesterday granted two days' remand for six arrestees in a case for killing three suspected abductors in Santhia upazila under the district.

They are Khokon Sardar, 32, Ahsan Habib Hasan, 25, Sujon Das, 18, Bishu Das, 27, Liton Das, 20, and Abu Bakar Siddik, 16, of different villages in the upazila.

Judicial Magistrate AKM Rawshan Jahan passed the

order when the six were produced before Pabna Cognizance Court-3 in the morning, seeking five days' remand, said Md Abul Kashem, investigation officer of the case.

On August 26, an angry mob beat the three to death on suspicion of kidnapping children in the upazila.

The victims are Md Alauddin Hossain alias Alal member, 52, Abu Bakar, 48, and Aslam Hossain, 50. They hailed from different

districts. Angry people chased the victims on suspicion of kidnapping children and beat them up mercilessly in front of a shop of C&B Chotur Bazar area in the upazila, said police.

Md Rana Hossain, brother of Alal, filed a case, accusing three thousand unidentified people of the area in this connection.

Police are raiding different areas to arrest the other accused, said the IO.

Village doc arrested on rape charge

Police arrested a village doctor at Gazipur village under Benapole Port Police Station in Jessore district on Wednesday on charge of violating a young girl.

The arrestee is Shaymol Sing, 37, son of Krishno Mahon Sing of Boragup Bazar area in Kutubdia upazila of Cox's Bazar district, reports our Benapole correspondent.

Quoting the victim, Assistant Superintendent of Police Shafin Mahmud said Shaymol called the girl over mobile phone with a promise of getting her a job and confined her to the house of one Mahe Alam at Gazipur village. He later raped her.

On information, police rushed to the spot at night and rescued the girl. They also arrested the village doctor from the spot.

The victim filed a case with the police station against Shaymol in this connection, said the ASP.

UNDP envoy for full execution of CHT peace deal

Full execution of Chittagong Hill Tracts (CHT) Peace Accord is needed for peace, stability and overall sustainable development in CHT, United Nations Resident Coordinator Robert D. Watkins told the journalists at Milonchhari in the district yesterday.

"We hope the government will implement the rest of the agreement soon" said Robert, also UNDP resident representative in Bangladesh, who led a three-member UNDP dele-

gation there. "The aim of our tour is to see the progress of the ongoing development activities funded by UNDP during the post peace accord period for the development of livelihood and living standard of the people in Chittagong Hill Tracts," he said.

The UNDP envoy expressed satisfaction with the progress of different UNDP-funded projects, being implemented by Bangladesh Hill District Council.

Earlier, the team met with Kyaw Shwe Hla, chairman of Bandarban Hill District

Council (BHDC), Bandarban army commander Brig Gen Naquib Ahmed Chowdhury, and district Superintendent of Police Mizanur Rahman Chowdhury.

The hill people are getting benefit from the projects, particularly those on education, health and agriculture, BHDC Chairman Kyaw Shwe Hla said, urging the UNDP team to continue fund allocation for more development works in the region.
