

US-Bangla aircraft skids off runway at Syedpur Airport

Operations at Syedpur Airport in Nilphamari were halted for two hours yesterday after a wheel of an aircraft of US-Bangla airlines skidded off the runway.

"The aircraft landed at the airport around 7:30am and while it took a turn at the end of the runway before entering taxiway one of its wheels slid for a yard into a muddy field," Shahin Ahmed, airport manager, told The Daily Star.

"The wheels then stuck in boggy land with a bang," Shahin said, adding that the runway was slippery due to overnight rain and the pilot might not control the speed.

None of the 74 passengers was, however, hurt in the incident.

Following the incident, the passengers panicked, locals quoted them as saying.

Five Jamaat men arrested

10 shops gutted in Tangail

The damage caused by the fire would be Tk 60 lakh, the market authorities claimed.

Rangpur road crash kills bicyclist

Take steps to remove Sust VC

Suranjit urges education minister

Awami League leader Suranjit Sengupta yesterday urged the education minister to take immediate steps to remove the vice chancellor of Shahjalal University of Science and Technology in Sylhet (Sust).

"Closing eyes does not help stop a catastrophe. So consider a problem to be a problem and take immediate steps to solve it," he said, pointing to Education Minister Nurul Islam Nahid, at a discussion at the Institute of Diploma Engineers, Bangladesh in the capital.

The senior AL leader made such remarks amid the ongoing movement of a section of teachers demanding removal of VC Prof Aminul Haque Bhuiyan.

Suranjit, also a member of the AL Advisory Council, said the VC was accused of using students to misbehave with the teachers. "And that is why he [the VC] should go willingly. Otherwise, the ministry [education ministry] will have to remove him."

On August 30, alleged BCL activists swooped on agitating teachers at the university in Sylhet during the latter's scheduled demonstration to stop the VC from entering his office. Several teachers, including Prof Yasmeen Haque, wife of Prof Zafar Iqbal, were assaulted at the time.

Protesting the assault, the teachers observed a three-day programme including work stoppage, token hunger strike and rally on the campus since Tuesday.

On Thursday, a group of students expressed solidarity with them and staged a sit-in. Both the teachers and students threatened to go for tougher movement if the VC is not removed by today.

Bid to establish HC circuit bench at Ctg faces barriers

Says SK Sinha

Chief Justice Surendra Kumer Sinha yesterday said there are some constitutional barriers to establishing the Circuit Bench of High Court in Chittagong.

Sinha was addressing a discussion organised by the High Court er Circuit Bench Bastabayan Parishad in Chittagong Circuit House auditorium.

SK Sinha said there are some technical problems as well in establishing the circuit bench.

Suppose three judges are appointed for Chittagong but for constituting a full bench,

many files would have to be sent to the capital and again sent back to Chittagong, said Sinha terming it another problem besides lack of manpower and structure issues.

Sinha said different sections and even the government have asked him to think about setting up a circuit bench in Chittagong.

"Everywhere I have said that I would think about it", he mentioned, adding, "We have to consider all difficulties before approving the circuit bench so that people get justice."

Public Prosecutor Abul Hashem also Convener of the Parishad and Chittagong District Bar Association President Mujibul Haque also spoke.

6 hurt in clash between visitors at safari park
