Lionel Messi and Sergio Aguero stole the show as Argentina warmed up for the start of World Cup qualifying next month with a 7-0 thrashing of Bolivia on Friday.

Aguero scored twice and set up two more for Ezequiel Lavezzi in a one-sided victory at Houston's BBVA Compass Stadium as Messi grabbed a quickfire double after coming on as a second half substitute. Angel Correa added the seventh.


It was Argentina's first match since their agonizing Copa America final defeat to Chile in July, when Gerardo Martino's men failed to end their 22-year wait for a major title.

Aguero created the first goal for Paris Saint-Germain's Lavezzi after only six minutes, lofting a superb pass into the path of the midfielder who controlled well and rifled home.



Rooney equals Charlton

Wayne Rooney equalled Bobby Charlton's 45-yearold England scoring record on Saturday when he netted his 49th international goal in a 2016 European Championship qualifier away to San Marino.

The England captain converted a 13th-minute penalty to give England a 1-0 lead in Serravalle after Cypriot referee Leontios Trattou spotted a foul in the box.

Rooney's goal gave the 29-year-old Manchester United striker an identical international record to Charlton, a member of England's fabled 1966 World Cup-winning team, with his 49th goal coming in his 106th appearance.

He will have to wait to take possession of the record outright, however, having been substituted by manager Roy Hodgson in the second half with England 3-0 up. England went on to win 6-0.

Rooney is also closing in on Charlton's United scoring record and requires 17 goals to surpass the former midfielder's tally of 249.

Germany go top

Malaysia coach steps down

The coach of Malaysia's national football team announced his resignation on Saturday just days after his squad was thrashed 10-0 by the United Arab Emirates during a World Cup qualifying match.

Dollah Salleh's tenure as head coach comes to a premature end after he signed a two-and-a-half year contract in July last year, in a bid to lift the team out of the doldrums.

"Who can accept a 10-0 defeat? That is why I quit," Salleh, who was one of the top footballers from the region in the 1980s and 1990s, told AFP. "Historically, it is the

worst ever defeat for the national team."

Real Madrid are to pledge 1m euro to aid refugees taken in by Spain during the current crisis.


Los Blancos have followed in the footsteps of Bayern Munich and Celtic in donating money to help those that are fleeing from war.


