'Raped' RMG worker yet to be found

 A female worker of a sweater factory, who went missing on August 26 allegedly a day after she was raped at her workplace at Hemayetpur in Savar, outside the capital, is yet to be found. Elder brother of the 20-year-old worker said his sister set off for office on that morning but did not return. When he reached the factory searching her during the lunch break, her coworkers informed him that she did not show up and was raped by "their electrician Yunus" on August 25 around 10:00pm while everyone was leaving. The brother immediately lodged a complaint with Savar police following which Yunus was arrested. But on August 29, the factory authorities got him released on bail. Admin Manager of Badrunesa Sweaters Ltd, Wahidul Islam, said he also heard "a rumour" but the girl did not complain to him. Many workers told our correspondent that they had also heard about the rape incident from others but none could ascertain what really happened. During primary information, Yunus denied the allegation, said police.

LIQUID COCAINE HAUL Another barrel's contents sent for retest

 A Chittagong court yesterday directed sending contents of one of the 107 barrels seized in Chittagong port in June to the Department of Narcotics Control (DNC) to see if it too contains liquid cocaine. Initially, the Directorate General of Drug Administration, and the Bangladesh Council of Scientific and Industrial Research confirmed the presence in a barrel, numbered 96. Later, labs of Criminal Investigation Department and the DNC reconfirmed while the latter suspected that another barrel, numbered 59, contained the contra-

band drug. Accordingly, the case's investigation officer yesterday produced a sample from barrel 59 before Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate Nurul Alam Mohammad Nipu. The barrels, with labels claiming the contents to be sunflower oil, arrived at the port on May 8 in a container shipped from Uruguay's Montevideo on being brought from Bolivia on a truck, according to investigators. Customs officials sealed the container on June 6. Police filed a case with Bandar Police Station on June 27 under the narcotics control act and six persons have so far been arrested.

EC starts updating Dhaka voters today

 The Election Commission-appointed enumerators will start going door-to-door in Dhaka metropolitan area from today to collect data of citizens to update the electoral roll and prepare National Identity (NID) cards. The data collection process will continue till September 22. Afterwards, the people, whose names would be included in the list, will have to go to the EC-designated registration centres for completing enrolment process and photo shoot, said EC officials. The EC on July 25 started the electoral roll updating programme across the country. The programme is being conducted in three phases. A total of 50,000 enumerators will work to complete the task, while upazila-level coordination committee will supervise the function.

HC orders culling

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 preserving the lagoon. The authorities have to form a citizens' committee with local representatives to assist Wasa to stop cultivation of fishes. Writ petitioner's counsel Manzill Mushid told The Daily Star that the Wasa authorities have submitted a report to the HC as per its earlier order, saying that the water of its lagoon and fishes cultivated there are poisonous and harmful for people's health. If the people consume such fishes, they might be affected with different diseases including cancer, he added. Following the petition filed by Human Rights and Peace for Bangladesh, the HC in November 2011, had asked the government to form an expert committee to recommend ways for stopping fish cultivation in the lagoon.

Have passengers'

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 commuters, said Mozammel, demanding regular government monitoring to check the malpractice. According to the proposal, passengers will pay Tk 40 for travelling the first two kilometres, instead of the existing fare of Tk 25. Moreover, for every kilometre travelled after the first two, passengers will pay Tk 12 and not Tk 7.64. Waiting charge per minute will be increased to Tk 2 from the current Tk 1.40. However, the new fare is yet to be approved by the ministry. Another committee will sit today to discuss bus fare hike in the capital and Chittagong city. As per the existing government-set bus fare chart, passengers have to pay Tk 1.50 (minibus) and Tk 1.60 (bus) for travelling per kilometre in Dhaka and Chittagong metropolitan area while Tk 1.45 for per kilometre in long route. The association leader demanded that new buses should be launched in the capital to replace the rundown buses.
