Marriageable age for females must be unconditionally 18

Demands Samajik Protirodh Committee

The minimum legal marriageable age for females should be kept at 18 without attaching any condition in the new child marriage restraint act, demanded Samajik Protirodh Committee yesterday.

The committee, a platform of 70 rights and development organisations,

at a human chain in front of the capital's Jatiya Press Club, noted that decreasing the legal marriageable age from 18 would hamper females' health, education and progress, said a statement of the committee signed by Bangladesh Mahila Parishad President Ayesha Khanam.

Human and women's rights organisations in the country have been protesting since a clause allowing marriage of girls at 16 with consent of parents and court was attached to the minimum marriageable age provision in the draft law.

The committee threatened to wage a tougher movement if their demand is not met.

Apex court asks Mostofa to surrender to trial court

For examination of acquittal by HC

The Supreme Court yesterday directed former superintendent of police of Habiganj Mostofa Kamal to immediately surrender before the lower court for hearing an ACC appeal against a High Court verdict that acquitted him in a bribery case.

The apex court, however, asked the lower court to grant bail to Mostofa after he furnishes a bail bond on surrender.

On December 19 last year a Dhaka court sentenced Mostofa to 35 years rigorous imprisonment and acquitted sub-inspector Md Wahed Miah of Habiganj police from the charges.

Following an appeal filed by Mostofa, the High Court on June 4 last year acquitted the suspended SP in the bribery case.

Later, the Anti-Corruption Commission took up the case and filed a leave-to-appeal petition against the HC verdict.

After hearing the leave-to-appeal petition, a four-member bench of the Appellate Division, headed by Chief Justice Surendra Kumar Sinha, yesterday also allowed the ACC to move a regular appeal before it against the High Court verdict.

According to the prosecution, police detained Salahuddin Ahmed, owner of SA Paribahan Ltd, and some of his staff in Habiganj on December 22, 2002 while going to Sylhet with Tk 20 lakh. Police told them that they were arrested for security reasons. Police took the money and did not return to them.

Teachers' rift widening

The teachers loyal to the VC yesterday made the accusations at a human chain and a press conference on the campus, under the banner Mohan Muktiyuddher Chetonyay O Muktochinta Charchai Oikyaboddho Shikkhak Parishad, also a pro-AL platform.

Shahriar was found hanging in his room in Surma residential area of Sylhet city, a

half-an-hour walk from the campus, on September 3. It was not clear whether Shahriar, who was an activist of anti-war crimes Gonojagoron Mancha, was murdered or committed suicide. His friends said Shahriar had been receiving death threats since 2013.

Addressing a mourning rally on the campus yesterday, Prof Muhammed Zafar Iqbal said Shahriar was a very animated young man; he could not commit suicide. He demanded a high-profile investigation into his death. "Why will he keep his laptop open and mobile phone charging if he intended to commit suicide?" he asked. "If he committed suicide, we will accept it but he was not that kind of boy," he added.

Mohan Muktiyuddher Chetonyay Udbuddho Chhatra, Shikkhak, Karmakarta, Karmachari Brindo, a group aligned with the opponents of the VC, organised the mourning rally.

SC orders HC to

The same court on March 19, 2008 sentenced Shahidul to 10 years imprisonment for amassing wealth worth over Tk 18 lakh illegally.

Earlier, the SC scrapped acquittals of 18 corruption suspects and sent their appeals to the HC for rehearing, he said.

The 18 include Relief and Disaster Minister Mofazzal Hossain Chowdhury Maya, former BNP state ministers Iqbal Hasan Mahmood Tuku and Mir Mohammad Nasiruddin and his son Mir Helal Uddin, independent lawmaker Haji Mohammad Selim and BNP leader Amanullah Aman.
