Beaten by headmaster, 3 girls hospitalised

School committee suspends him as locals agitate

The headmaster of Golapganj High School in Birganj upazila under the district was suspended following a public outrage over mercilessly beating three female students yesterday.

The three girls, all Class VIII students of the school, were admitted to Birganj Upazila Health Complex, as they were injured due to the beating.

They are Momotaj Parvin Borsha, 14, daughter of Sajedul Islam of Satkhamar village, Shanta Islam, 13, daughter of Rafiqul Islam of Chhilararaju village, and Tanjila Akter, 14, daughter of Ziarul Islam of Debipur village.

They had serious injury marks, said Dr Nurul Aziz, medical officer of the health complex.

After going to Class VIII

yesterday, headmaster Sahidul Haque called Momotaj in front of his table and asked her a question, witnesses said.

As the girl failed to answer, headmaster Sahidul Haque started beating her on both legs. Then he made her kneel down outside the classroom.

Later the teacher called her in the classroom again, but she was unable to walk due to pain.

"Then the headmaster again started beating her. As our classmates Shanta and Tanjila protested the beating, the teacher also started beating them with the stick," said Mamun, a student of the same class.

Informed by other friends, parents of the three girls came to school and took them to Birganj Upazila Health Complex.

As the news spread, hundreds of people of surround-

ing villages thronged in front of the school at noon.

They seriously protested the incident and demanded removal of the headmaster.

Around 4:30pm, Birganj Upazila Nirbahi Officer (UNO) Russell Monjur assured the locals that the teacher would be suspended.

The UNO accompanied by Birganj Police Station Officer in Charge (OC) Jahangir Alam took the headmaster to the police station.

"We brought him to the police station for his safety," said OC Jahangir Alam.

The headmaster has already been suspended, said Shudhansu Shekhar, president of the school managing committee.

A five-member probe team led by Shudhansu Shekhar has been formed to investigate the incident.

Woman arrested with Yaba

Schoolboy drowns in pond

A boy drowned in a pond on his school premises in the city on Monday afternoon. The deceased was identified as Ivan Ahmed Antar, 14, son of Rafiqul Islam of Keranipara area in the city. RM Mizanur Rahman, headmaster of Rangpur Zila School, said the eight grader along with his classmates went to take a dip in the pond and drowned. An unnatural death case was filed with Rangpur Kotwali Police Station in this connection, said the headmaster.

20 shops gutted

At least 20 shops were gutted in a devastating fire at a market in Sonali Road area under Char Fashion municipality of the district early Monday. Locals said the fire originated at a shop and soon engulfed the adjoining shops. On information, firefighters rushed to the spot and doused the flame after two hours of frantic efforts. The affected shop owners claimed that the loss caused by the fire could go up to Tk 3 crore.

UP member held with pistol

Police arrested a man with a pistol and two bullets at his house at Kuniar Char village in Ishwarganj upazila of the district early Monday. The arrestee is Murtaz Ali, 50, a member of Maizbagh Union Parishad. Murtaz is accused in five cases, including one for murder, said Burhan Uddin, officer-in-charge of Ishwarganj Police Station.

2 Jubo League men attacked

Students of Michael Madhusudan College (MM College) vandalised houses of two local Jubo League leaders following a conflict over establishing supremacy on the college campus in the district town on Monday. Officer-in-Charge of Kotwali Police Station Sikdar Akkash said a group of MM College students attacked the houses of Ashikuzzaman and Chanchal, activists of the district Jubo League unit, and vandalised the houses over establishing supremacy in MM College area. The attackers blasted two crude bombs during the incident, he said.

Shrimp fry seized

Police seized one lakh shrimp fry from a bus in Jhumur area of the district town early yesterday. A police team, acting on a tip-off, raided a Khulna-bound bus from Ramgati area and seized the shrimp fry. None was arrested in this connection, said Superintendent of Police Nasim Miah.

Criminals kill cattle trader, take away Tk 50,000

Criminals stabbed a cattle trader to death and took away Tk 50,000 from him at Pujkhola village in Amtali upazila of Barguna district on Monday night.

The victim is Farid Uddin, 33, son of Abu Hawlader of the village.

Police quoted victim's family members as saying that a gang of 4/5 attacked Farid with sharp weapons while he along with his maternal uncle Musa Sharif was returning home from nearby Banati cattle market

around 10:00pm, leaving him dead on the spot.

Musa, however, escaped unhurt from the spot and informed the villagers and the police.

Police went to the spot, recovered the body and sent it to Barguna General Hospital morgue for autopsy, said Pulok Chandra Roy, OC of Amtali Police Station.

Away in Gaibandha, armed robbers looted 17 cattle from different dwelling houses at Purbo Khatiyamari village in Fulchhari upazila early yesterday.

Police said a gang entered several cowsheds owned by different villagers around 3:00am, took the family members hostage at gunpoint and took away the cattle by engine boats.

Earlier, on Monday, police detained one Sanowar, 27, a member of a robbers' gang from Kochkhali area in the upazila, said Atiar Rahman, officer-in-charge of Fulchhari Police Station.

Sanowar is an accused in a number of cases, including those for robbery, with different police stations of the district, the OC added.
