

Fresh areas inundated in Gaibandha

Floodwater starts receding from Bogra, Kurigram, Jamalpur

With inundation of fresh areas in six more unions and a portion of Gaibandha municipality, the flood situation in the district deteriorated further yesterday.

However, the situation in Bogra, Kurigram and Jamalpur districts started improving the same day.

In Gaibandha, the Brahmaputra and Ghagot rivers were flowing 28 and 25 centimetres above the danger mark in the last 24 hours, devouring a number of homesteads and a vast tract of cropland in the areas under seven upazilas of the district, reports our correspondent.

Gaibandha-Laxmipur road in Sadar upazila went under knee-deep water, disrupting communications with the district headquarters.

The situation worsened following breach of Sonail flood control dyke, said local Water Development Board (WDB) sources.

"My three bighas of land with transplanted aman seedlings remained under floodwater for the last two

weeks," said Abdul Ghani, a farmer of Gideri union in Sadar upazila.

According to our Bogra correspondent, flood situation in the district started improving as the Jamuna was flowing below the danger level yesterday.

According to WDB, over 1.50 lakh people in five upazilas of the district have been marooned.

The district administration has distributed 150 tonnes of rice and Tk 9.15 lakh among the flood victims.

Away in Kurigram, the situation in the district was improving slightly as floodwater in many areas started receding, reports our correspondent.

However, the Brahmaputra was flowing 8 cm above the danger mark, said local WDB sources.

At least five lakh people of 450 villages in nine upazilas have still remained marooned, said district relief and rehabilitation office sources.

About 55,000 hectares of farmlands have been damaged due to the floods, said the sources.

According to district primary education office, at least 176 schools in char and low lying land areas remained closed as floodwater entered the institutions.

Our Jamalpur correspondent reports: Flood situation improved as water level of the Jamuna River receded 18 cm at Bahadurabad Ghat point in the district yesterday.

However, the river was flowing 34 cm above the danger mark at the point at 12:00 noon, said WDB sources.

Around 2.80 lakh people in seven upazilas of the district have been marooned, said sources at district relief and rehabilitation office.

Meanwhile, the authorities shut 77 schools, colleges and madrasas due to the floods, said Shamsul Haque Khan, district education officer.

The district administration has allocated 335 tonnes of rice and Tk 7.67 lakh for the marooned people, said Additional Deputy Commissioner Anwar Hossain.

500 guava trees felled

Criminals felled at least 500 guava and 40 mango trees at an orchard at Chaugasi village in Sadar upazila of the district early yesterday. Rafiqul Islam, owner of the orchard, alleged that Yousuf Ali of the village threatened to destroy the orchard over grazing of goats on Tuesday afternoon. Rafiqul said Yousuf might have cut down the trees worth about Tk 12 lakh over the issue. A case was filed in this connection, said police.

Housewife commits 'suicide'

A housewife allegedly committed suicide at Purbo Madraz village in Charfashion upazila of the district on Tuesday night. The deceased is Jhumur, 20, wife of fisherman Shahid Bepari of the village. Police and locals said Jhumur took her life by hanging herself from the ceiling of her room following an altercation over a family matter. The body was sent to Bhola Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy. Shahid went into hiding soon after the incident. A case was filed in this connection.

Girl raped

A five-year-old girl was raped allegedly by a youth at Baisha village in Keshabpur upazila of Jessore district yesterday. Mahatab Uddin, officer-in-charge of Keshabpur Police Station, said Raju Ahmed, 20, son of Nasir Marol of the village, forcibly took the girl to a nearby garden and raped her. Hearing screams, locals rushed to the spot, rescued the victim and sent her to the upazila health complex. However, Raju managed to flee the scene.

Five houses gutted

At least five houses and four shops were gutted in a fire in a bazar area of the district town yesterday. Fire service sources said the fire originated from an electric short circuit at a shop in the area and soon engulfed the adjoining shops and houses. On information, army personnel and firefighters rushed to the spot and doused the blaze after one and a half hours of frantic efforts. The affected house and shop owners claimed that the loss caused by the fire could go up to Tk 20 lakh.

3 drug peddlers jailed

A mobile court sentenced three drug peddlers to different jail terms in Badarganj upazila of the district yesterday afternoon. The convicts are Sohrab Ali, 60, son of Jonab Ali of Shahapur-Mistripara area under Badarganj municipality, Bhobananda Roy, 42, son of Ambika Roy of the same area and Hasanur Rahman, 35, son of Momdel Mian of Shyampur-Collegepara village in Sadar upazila. Md Anwarul Habib, inspector of Rangpur Sadar Circle of Narcotics Control Department (DNC), said Executive Magistrate Khondkar Ishtiaq Ahmed led the court.

Stalker beats up youth

Stalker of a girl beat up her brother as he protested the stalking in Hakimpur upazila of the district yesterday. The injured is Jahrul Islam of Boaldar village in the upazila. Family members said Md Mokaddes Ali, son of Akbar Hossain of Boaldar village, and a Class XII student of Boaldar School and College, used to stalk the sister of Jahrul on her way to school. On Sunday, Jahrul protested the stalking. Following the incident, the stalker and his brother Babar Ali beat up Jahrul mercilessly, leaving him injured, said Mokhesur Rahman, officer-in-charge of Hakimpur Police Station.

Municipality, village declared free from drug, robbery

Akkelpur municipality and Gopinathpur village in Akkelpur upazila of Joypurhat district have been declared free from drug trading, robbery, mugging and stealing.

Superintendent of Police Mollah Nazrul Islam came up with the declaration at a programme organised by his department on Tuesday.

As chief guest District and Sessions Judge KM Julfikar Ali attended the programme addressed by

Deputy Commissioner Md Abdur Rahim, Chief Judicial Magistrate Ismat Ara and OC of Akkelpur Police Station Ashrafur Islam.

Under the slogan 'Hate drug, not addicts and traders', over four thousand people gathered at the rally held at the playground of Mojibur Rahman Degree College, said locals.

At least 72 illegal drug traders of the municipality area surrendered at the programme and promised not to continue such business further. Similar num-

ber of addicts also promised to give up their bad habit from now. Besides, 23 robbers and burglars also surrendered at the venue.

Later, the chief guest distributed 38 sewing machine sets and 33 auto-rickshaws among them as part of rehabilitation programme so that they can stay away from such illegal drug trading.

The SP also urged the locals to keep informing if any stealing, robbery, and drug trading incident is reported in the areas.

Land dispute leaves one dead in Shibganj

A man was killed and another injured by their rivals over a land dispute at Dohbagi village in Shibganj upazila of Chapainawabganj yesterday.

The deceased was identified as Rozbul Haque, 28, son of Mofazzal Haque of the village.

Moinul Islam, officer-in-charge of Shibganj Police Station, said there had been a dispute over a land between Rozbul and his neighbour Manirul Haque.

When Rozbul and his elder brother Esharul Haque, 30, were returning home from Tartipur Haat after selling cattle on Tuesday night, Manirul and his men attacked the duo with sharp weapons at Daktarpara area at around 8:30pm, leaving them critically injured.

Locals rushed the two siblings to Shibganj Upazila Health Complex, from where the doctors sent them to Rajshahi Medical College Hospital (RMCH).

Rozbul died at the hospital at around 1:00am yesterday. Esharul is under treatment at the hospital.

Police arrested 12 people, including Manirul, in connection with the incident.
