Sorry tale of road to Nazrul university in Trishal

Repeated demands of students, locals for repair fall on deaf ears

Hundreds of Jatiya Kabi Kazi Nazrul Islam University students are suffering due to the poor condition of the road to the campus from Trishal in Mymensingh. The uncountable potholes and cracks in the roadway have been left unrepaired for a long time.

"It's difficult to attend classes on time because of the dilapidated road," says Sajib Ahmed, a final year student of the Human Resources Management

Department. This year's heavy rainfall has added salt to our wounds, he added.

Students, along with local residents have made several demands over recent months to the municipality mayor for the road's repair, but to no effect.

"It seems we are crying in the woods with none to hear us," lamented one student, Sumaiya Sadmin.

Not only students are affected, but visitors to the country's lone culture-based university must also

rely on the poor quality road. With the nearby attraction of Nazrul Smriti Kendra at Namapara in Trishal where Nazrul stayed during his boyhood, visitors are many. We feel embarrassed that the painful journey is for visitors their first impression of our campus, students said.

Mohit Ul Alam, vice-chancellor of the university said that because the institution is yet to provide residential facilities for all students, many have to attend classes from residences

outside the campus, which means they face serious transport difficulties. Only 700 students out of some 4000 students at the university currently live on campus.

The road must be repaired soon, urged the vice-chancellor.

ABM Anisuzzaman, the mayor of Trishal municipality said, "I submitted a proposal of Tk 1 crore 87 lakh for a grant from the World Bank last month and it might be approved soon. We can start the repair work after approval."

AL-JSD clash leaves 20 hurt in Bheramara

At least 20 people were injured in a clash between the activists of ruling Awami League and its ally Jatiya Samajtantrik Dal (JSD) in Farkpur rail gate area under Bheramara upazila of Kushtia district yesterday afternoon.

The clash took place when JSD president and Information Minister Hasanul Haq Inu made a visit to the district.

The incident was a sequel to Monday's clash when the men of the two parties engaged in a clash, leaving at least 15 people from both sides injured.

Sources said a group of people allegedly belonging to local AL attacked JSD activist Serajul Islam in the area around 3:30pm yesterday. The attackers also beat up Seraj's son Nishan, 15.

At one stage, the activists of both parties locked in a clash, leaving at least 20 people from both sides injured.

AL men also torched a motorcycle of JSD activist Asad during the incident, said the sources.

Tazul Islam, officer-in-charge of Bheramara Police Station, said the situation is now under control.

On Monday night, a group of JSD men allegedly led by Nurul Islam Hasan, who recently joined the party from AL, attacked Jubo League office in Farkpur rail gate area, triggering a clash. At least 15 people were injured during the incident.

Protesting the incident, local Awami League on Wednesday organised a rally in the area.

Addressing the rally, the speakers demanded punishment of the attackers.

Inu, also lawmaker from Kushtia-2 (Bheramara-Mirpur), came to the district to join two programmes on Wednesday night.

13,347 fishermen get ID cards in Jamalpur

As many as 15,758 fishermen of seven upazilas, including seven municipalities in Jamalpur district, have been registered.

Most of them have already received identity cards (ID) while the rest will get ID cards soon, according to the officials of the Directorate of Fisheries.

After being registered by the authorities concerned, 13,347 fishermen of Jamalpur sadar, Islampur, Meladah, Madarganj and Dewanganj upazilas got ID cards, sources at District Fisheries Office (DFO) said.

The remaining 1179 registered fishermen in

Baksiganj upazila and 1232 in Saishabari upazila are going to receive the ID cards within a short time, said Mohammad Munir Uddin, district fisheries officer.

The registered fishermen in the district would be allowed to catch fish in 43,819.03 hectares of water bodies in seven upazilas along with the municipalities. The area covered by rivers is 8,528.78 hectares, 3290.25 hectares by beels and 32,000 hectares by flood plains (plabon bhumi), said Abu Hanifa, assistant director of DFO.

Lawmaker Alhaj Rezaul Karim Hira of Jamalpur 5 constituency (Sadar

upazila) inaugurated the ID card distribution among the fishermen of Sadar upazila at a programme organised by the upazila fisheries department recently.

The lawmaker in his speech said the fishermen who have been registered and have already got, or are going to get ID cards, would never be deprived of the right to catch fish in the water bodies.

"People, who are involved in fishing, do have legal rights to avail of the opportunities to earn their livelihood," he added.

He called upon the card holders not to catch fish in the water bodies during breeding and rearing seasons (Baishakh to Srabon).

Two youths held for killing girl after rape in Chandpur

Chandpur police in separate drives on Tuesday and Wednesday arrested two youths from Laxmipur and Gazipur districts on charge of killing a seven-year-old girl after rape in Faridganj upazila of the district in July 26 this year.

The arrestees are Md Jewel, 22, son of Telu Mian, and Md Masum Hossain alias Mintu, 25, son of Mijan Munshi of Sakadi village under Faridganj upazila. Mintu is a worker at

a furniture shop in Faridganj.

Chandpur Superintendent of Police (SP) Shamsunnahar said a joint team of DB police and Faridganj police arrested Mintu from a clubhouse at Hajirhat area in Laxmipur district on Tuesday night.

The following day, police detained Jewel from a house at Kapasia Bus Stand area in Gazipur district.

Sub-Inspector (SI) Khandaker Md Ismail said Jewel and Mamun swooped on the victim, Rubina Akter, while she was returning

home from school during heavy rain on July 26. They took her to an abandoned house and raped her there.

At one stage, when Rubina started bleeding profusely, the two strangled her to death and dumped the body in a beel (water body) nearby.

As the girl did not return home, the parents led a frantic search in vain. Later, they filed a general diary (GD) with Faridganj Police Station in this connection.

Locals found the body in the water body on August 25. On information, police

went to the spot and recovered the body.

Investigation Officer (IO) of the case Mobarak Hossain, also sub-inspector (SI) of Faridganj Police Station, said Montu gave confessional statement to the court under Section 164.

However, Jewel refused to give any confessional statement. Police produced him before the Court of Senior Judicial Magistrate Rajib Kumar Biswas, seeking a ten-day remand.

The Court, however, granted a five-day remand.
