

Proctor among 12 hurt as BCL men clash at PSTU

At least 12 people have been injured in a clash between two factions of Bangladesh Chhatra League at Patuakhali Science and Technology University (PSTU) in the district.

The injured include Proctor Santosh Kumer Bosh, Anisuzzaman Anis, president of the university unit of BCL, its office secretary Marshal Ovi, Mohaiminul Islam, organising secretary of M Keramat Ali Hall unit of the party, and activists Mohaiminul Islam Tanim, Ovi, Tajin and Munna.

Of them, Tanim, Ovi,

Tajin and Munna were admitted to PSTU Health Centre while the rest were given first aid.

Police and students said two BCL activists -- Kamrul Islam, student of 8th semester of food and nutrition science department and Mehedi Hasan Uzzal, student of 8th semester of BBA -- engaged in an altercation over sitting inside the university bus around 8:00pm on Sunday when they were returning to the campus from Barisal.

After returning to campus, some supporters of Kamrul assaulted Uzzal and his friend Ratul in 'Joybanga' area in front of

the administrative building.

As the news of the attack spread, the men of Uzzal and Ratul equipped with lethal weapons swooped on the supporters of Kamrul at Sher-e-Bangla Hall on the campus, triggering a clash.

Around 8:00am yesterday, the men of Kamrul attacked the supporters of Uzzal and ransacked some rooms of M Keramat Ali Hall over Sunday's incident, triggering a fresh clash. A case and counter chase also took place between the two rival groups.

During the incident, the proctor was also injured when he went to pacify the

clashing groups.

On information, the law enforcers rushed to the spot in the afternoon and brought the situation under control, said Azam Khan Faruque, officer-in-charge of Dumki Police Station.

Md Rayhan Ahmed Rimon, secretary of the university unit of the party, said the clash took place between held between 'Patuakhali and Barisal groups', not BCL groups.

Punitive steps will be taken against those responsible for the offence after investigating the incident, said the proctor.

Girl rescued 40 days after abduction

Members of the Police Bureau of Investigation (PBI) rescued a girl from Araihaazar upazila of Narayanganj district yesterday, 40 days after abduction from Sadar upazila of Narsingdi district by her brother-in-law.

On August 4, Habibur Rahman, alias Habib, brother-in-law of the victim, took her to Araihaazar of Narayanganj where he allegedly raped her.

Following the incident, the victim's father filed a case with Narsingdi court. As per court order, PBI started drives to rescue the girl.

Tipped off, the members of PBI rescued the girl yesterday afternoon. They also arrested Habib.

Habib's wife said her husband took her sister out of the house at Agdi Kandipara village on August 4, saying they were going for a walk. Later, he forcibly took her to Araihaazar and confined her to a house, she added.

Apple Mahmud, additional police superintendent of PBI, said the victim was raped by her brother-in-law.

Habib, an unemployed youth, used to stay at his in-laws' house.

Assault on teacher by stalkers sparks protest

Teachers, students and employees of Shaheed Smriti High School in Sadar upazila of the district blocked Patuakhali-Barisal highway at Telikhali Bazar point yesterday, demanding immediate arrest of stalkers who attacked a teacher of the institution the day before.

The victim is Md Mizanur Rahman, computer teacher of the school.

The blockade continued

for about one hour from 11:00am, causing immense sufferings to the passengers.

Later, the protesters organised a meeting addressed by Lutfur Rahman Manik Mia, chairman of the school managing committee, Nirodh Chandra Boitya, headmaster of the school, and Rashed Khan, secretary of Patuakhali district unit of Bangladesh Chhatra League.

The students also boycotted their classes in support of their demand.

Police said a gang allegedly led by Sohel Mollah used to stalk some female students on their way to school. The teacher often protested against the stalking.

Angered by this, the gang assaulted Mizanur when he was coming out of the school on Sunday morning.

Contacted, SM Taiqul Islam, officer-in-charge of Patuakhali Police Station, said they are raiding different areas to arrest the culprits.

College girl raped, 2 arrested

A college girl was raped by her classmate at eco park, near Bangabandhu Bridge in Sirajganj yesterday.

Police arrested the rapist and his accomplice on the spot.

The arrestees are Md Helal Hossain, 19, a second year student of Rajapur Degree College in Belkuchi upazila of Sirajganj, and Md Kabir Hossain, 20 of Khamar village in Ullapara upazila.

The victim, a second year student of the college, is undergoing treatment in the gynaecology department of Sirajganj General Hospital.

Md Asgar Ali, sub-inspector of Bangabandhu Bridge West Zone Police Station, quoting the victim's mother, said Helal along with his friend took the girl to the park on Sunday afternoon and raped her there.

Hearing screams of the victim, locals rushed to the spot and rescued her. On information, police went to the spot immediately and caught the alleged rapist and his accomplice, the SI said.

The victim's mother filed a case with the police station on Sunday night, accusing Helal and his friend Kabir.

The arrestees were yesterday produced in a court that sent them to jail, police said.

Gangs' clash leaves one dead

Two gangs of criminals clashed in Begumganj upazila of the district on Sunday night, leaving one dead and another injured.

The deceased was identified as Jashim Uddin Rubel, 20, son of Shafi Alam of Hajipur village. The injured is Fardin Islam Swadhin, 22, son of Monir Ahmed of the village.

Officer-in-Charge Md Omar Farooq of Begumganj Model Police Station, quoting locals, said there was a longstanding dispute between two rival gangs-- one is led by Rubel and the other by Swadhin--over estab-

lishing supremacy in Hajipara area.

Swadhin and his cohorts picked up Rubel from his house at around 9:00pm and beat him up severely. Relatives rushed him to a local hospital where the doctors declared him dead. The body was sent to Noakhali Abdul Malek Ukil Medical College Hospital for autopsy.

Hearing Rubel's death, members of his gang attacked Swadhin and his men. Swadhin received bullet wounds and was admitted to Noakhali General Hospital. As his condition deteriorated, he was referred to Dhaka for better treatment.

Locals besiege school, want headmaster to quit

Guardians and locals besieged Begum Rokeya Girls High School at Purbo Faridpur in Palashbari upazila of the district yesterday, demanding removal of the headmaster for alleged harassment of a girl student.

The guardians alleged that the headmaster Saiful Islam Badal called the girl, a student of Class IX, to the school's library on September 6 and sexually harassed her. The girl later

informed her parents about the matter.

The parents of the girl and other guardians filed a complaint with the president of the school managing committee and demanded removal of the headmaster. They kept the school locked on September 8, to press their demand.

The school managing committee formed a 3-member committee to investigate the matter. The committee, after investigation and as per the state-

ment of the victim, found that the headmaster had harassed her sexually. The probe committee submitted its report to the managing committee.

As the managing committee was delaying taking any step against the headmaster, locals besieged the school yesterday, demanding immediate removal and punishment of the headmaster. They also threatened that they would not send their children to the school until the headmaster was

removed.

Facing public wrath, Jahangir Alam Sarker, president of the managing committee, suspended the headmaster and assured the local people that he would take steps against him.

The headmaster has been absconding since the incident. Mamunur Rashid, upazila secondary education officer, ordered the president of the school managing committee to take appropriate action against the headmaster.

Quoting Russel's roommate Sajjatul Karim Swapnil, Md Kamrul Islam, OC of Kotwali Police Station, said Russel did not go to the college and was alone in the room. When Swapnil along with other mess members returned around 1:00 pm, they found the room locked from inside. They broke open the door and found the blood-stained body of Russel on the floor.
