15 held on border

Members of Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) arrested 15 people, including three women and two children, while they were entering Bangladesh from India through Puthkhal border in Jessore district yesterday. Subedar Safuddin of Puthkhal BGB camp said the border guards chased a gang of human traffickers while they were entering the border area from India in the morning. Sensing the presence of the BGB men, the traffickers fled the scene. Later, the law enforcers arrested 15 people from the spot. They had been living in India illegally for long, said the BGB official. The arrestees hail from Gopalganj and Jessore districts.

Woman's body found

Police recovered the decomposed body of an unidentified woman from a drum at Tangail bus terminal in the district on Wednesday night. Police said two people came to the terminal with the drum around 9:00pm and bought tickets of a Kishoreganj-bound bus. Later, they left the spot, leaving the drum, said Mostafizur Rahman, officer-in-charge of Tangail Model Police Station. The woman might have been killed several days ago, said police.

Shibir man jailed for stalking

A mobile court here yesterday sentenced a Shibir man to one year's imprisonment for stalking a schoolgirl. The convict is Jewel Rana, 28, publication secretary of Bagatipara upazila unit of Shibir, and son of Abdul Kader of Gaopara village in the upazila. Bagatipara police said Rana used to stalk the girl on her way to school. On information, police arrested the Shibir leader at noon and produced him before the court, led by Executive Magistrate Khandaker Farhad Ahmed, which punished him.

Kid drowns in pond

UNB, Sherpur

A minor boy drowned in a pond at Nayapara in Sribordi upazila of the district on Wednesday morning. The dead is Siam, 6, son of Chingu Miah of the village. Locals said Siam slipped into the pond near their house when he was playing on its bank. Later, local people recovered the body from the pond.

3 arrested with pistol, bombs

Police arrested three criminals with a pistol and three bombs at Sangarpasha village in Abhoynagar upazila of Jessore district on Tuesday night. The arrestees are Santo Roy, 34, son of Narayan Chandra Roy, Simanto Mallik, 24, son of Danbir Mallik, and Saddam Hossain, 26, son of Oliar Rahman. Nasir Uddin, officer-in-charge of Abhoynagar Police Station, said local people caught the trio and seized the pistol and bombs when they tried to extort money from Sheikh Asaduzaman, a former UP member. Later, the villagers handed over them to police after giving a good beating.

15 Shibir men held

Police arrested 15 leaders and activists of Islami Chhatra Shibir with 17 bombs and 250 grams of gunpowder at an abandoned house at Khaserhat in Shibganj upazila of the district yesterday. A police team, acting on a tip-off, raided the house and arrested 15 leaders and activists, including its finance secretary of district committee Al Amin, when they were holding a secret meeting there around 3:30pm, said Moinul Islam, officer-in-charge of Shibganj Police Station.

BSF returns eight cattle

Indian Border Security Force (BSF) returned eight cattle following a company commander level flag meeting with Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) on Bujruk border in Haripur upazila of the district yesterday. BGB sources said farmers Abdul Barek, Nazrul and Alamgir of Shinghari village in the upazila went to graze their cattle on the border on Wednesday afternoon. At one stage, BSF took four cows and four buffaloes to Indian territory forcibly. Later, BGB sent a letter to BSF to return the cattle.

Cattle trader shot by BSF, dies

A Bangladeshi cattle trader, who was earlier shot by the Indian Border Security Force (BSF) on Chapar border in Haripur upazila, died at Rangpur Medical College Hospital on Wednesday evening.

The dead, Moinul Haque, 30, was son of Abdur Rafiq of Bhaturia Mulkan village of the upazila.

On September 9, the BSF members of Moheshgaon camp opened fire on two Bangladeshi cattle traders, Moinul Haque and Mobarak Hossain, when they were entering India.

The cattle traders received bullet wounds, according to locals and BGB sources.

Later, the BSF troops picked up Mobarak from the border. He is now under treatment at a hospital in Uttar Dinajpur of West Bengal. Moinul somehow managed to return to Bangladesh.

Moinul was first admitted to Thakurgaon Sadar Hospital and later shifted to Rangpur Medical College Hospital as his condition deteriorated.

SHERPUR, PABNA

Abducted kid, 2 traders rescued: Four held

Three abducted people, including a kid, were rescued from Sherpur and Pabna districts on Wednesday.

Members of Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) rescued a five-year-old girl from Sadar upazila of Sherpur district on the day, four days into her abduction, reports our correspondent.

The victim hails from Shirichala village in Jaydevpur upazila of Gazipur district, said police.

On September 12, two youths -- Alamgir and Samad -- allegedly abducted the girl from Shirichala village. The following day, they demanded ransom from the family over phone.

Following a complaint filed by the victim's father, a team of Rab-14, acting on a tip-off, raided Bajitkhila Bazar area in Sherpur town at night and rescued the girl.

However, none was arrested in this connection, said Md Mazharul Karim, officer-in-charge of Sherpur Police Station.

In Pabna, police rescued two traders from Mothurapur village in Chatmohar upazila of the district the same day, hours after their abduction.

They also arrested four people for their alleged involvement in the abduction.

The victims are Helal Uddin, 35, of Mirpara village, and Masud Parveez, 37 of Vobanipur village in Natore Sadar upazila.

In the afternoon, a gang abducted the two for Tk 2 lakh ransom.

On secret information, the law enforcers raided Mothurapur village at night and rescued the traders, OC Subroto Kumar of Chatmohar Police Station said, adding that they also arrested the four from the spot.

The arrestees are Hasinur Sheikh, 27, Abdur Rahim, 35, Mukul Hossain, 28, and Abdul Alim, 25, of Mothurapur village.

Four get life for murder

A Bogra court on Tuesday sentenced four youths to life imprisonment for killing a college student in the town in 2001.

The convicts are Helal Hossain, of Phulbari Madhyapara, Mizanur Rahman, Md Gulshan, and Golam Masum Liton, of Phulbari Southpara in the town.

Additional District and Sessions judge Md Hafizur Rahman handed down the verdict.

According to the case statement, Mahamudul Hasan Bidyut, 18, of Phulbari Madhyapara, was hacked to death by the four as a sequel to previous enmity on October 5, 2001.

Assignment Country: Bangladesh

The World Bank ("the Bank") is financing various projects in Bangladesh and has a fiduciary responsibility to ensure that the proceeds are used for the purposes intended with proper attention being given to economy, efficiency, and mitigating chances of misuse. The Bank's supervision employs a set of complementary instruments (Procurement Reviews: prior, post, and independent; and Financial Management Review) to fulfill its fiduciary mandate in a cost-effective manner.

For each project, one or more implementing entities (also referred to as "implementing agencies" or "borrowers"), located at various levels throughout the country (central, district, etc.) manage a project's procurement and financial management (FM) related aspects including the purchase of goods, civil works, consultancy and other services, and other expenditures.

Conducting an **Integrated Fiduciary Review** includes selecting a sample of contracts, based on project's procurement risk and sample of other expenditures based on FM risk and performing a detailed review of the procurement and FM procedures followed to determine their compliance with the agreed provisions in the legal agreement. In addition, fiduciary reviews examine the systemic processes and controls surrounding the fiduciary (Procurement & FM) practices of the borrower based on the contracts and other expenditure reviewed and suggests measures for improvement, if any. IFR also comprises asset verification, IT asset implementation review, accuracy and effectiveness of automated financial management system, end-use review, price comparability and technical review. The review will be conducted using forensic techniques and tools to report indications of fraud or corruption and irregularities. More detailed procedures for conducting integrated fiduciary reviews are outlined in this document.

The World Bank now invites eligible reputed chartered accountants/audit firms to submit their Expression of Interest (EOI) for the above services. Given the nature of this integrated fiduciary review covering wide geographical locations including remote places, it is expected that the assignment will require mainly national input, with global experience as needed to ensure overall quality assurance. Interested consultants (firms) are invited to provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar operating conditions, availability of appropriate professional qualification and experience among staff.). Consultants may associate to enhance their qualifications in the form of joint venture or sub consultant. The EOIs would be reviewed on the basis of the following:

- Experience of the consultant (firm) in similar tasks/assignments covering procurement, financial management and technical with forensic techniques and tools.
- Registration/global affiliation of consultant (firm)
- Availability of key professional staff covering the field mentioned in criteria "a" above.
- Demonstrated capacity to handle such assignment in terms of resources.
- Support service of the consultant (firm).
