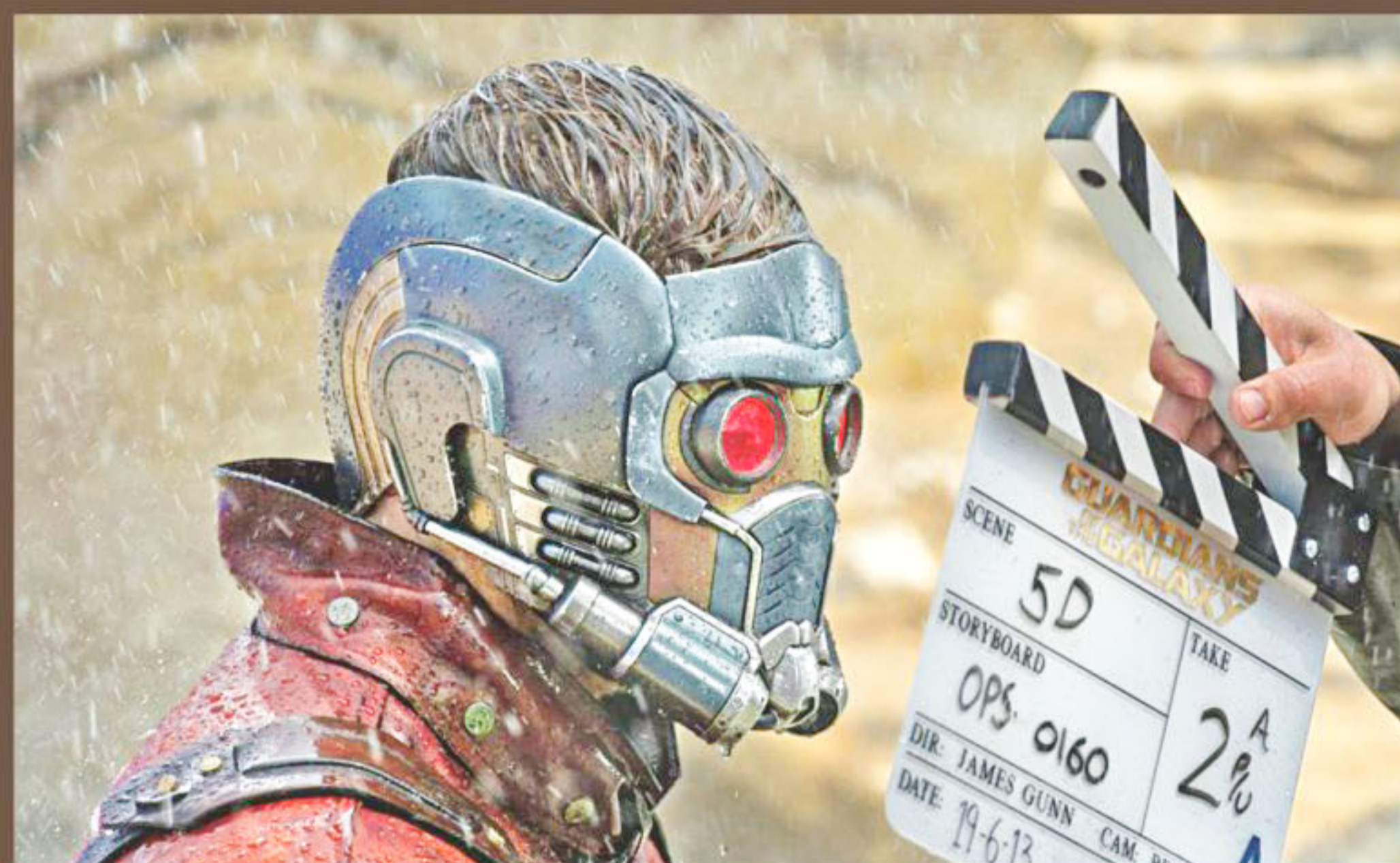
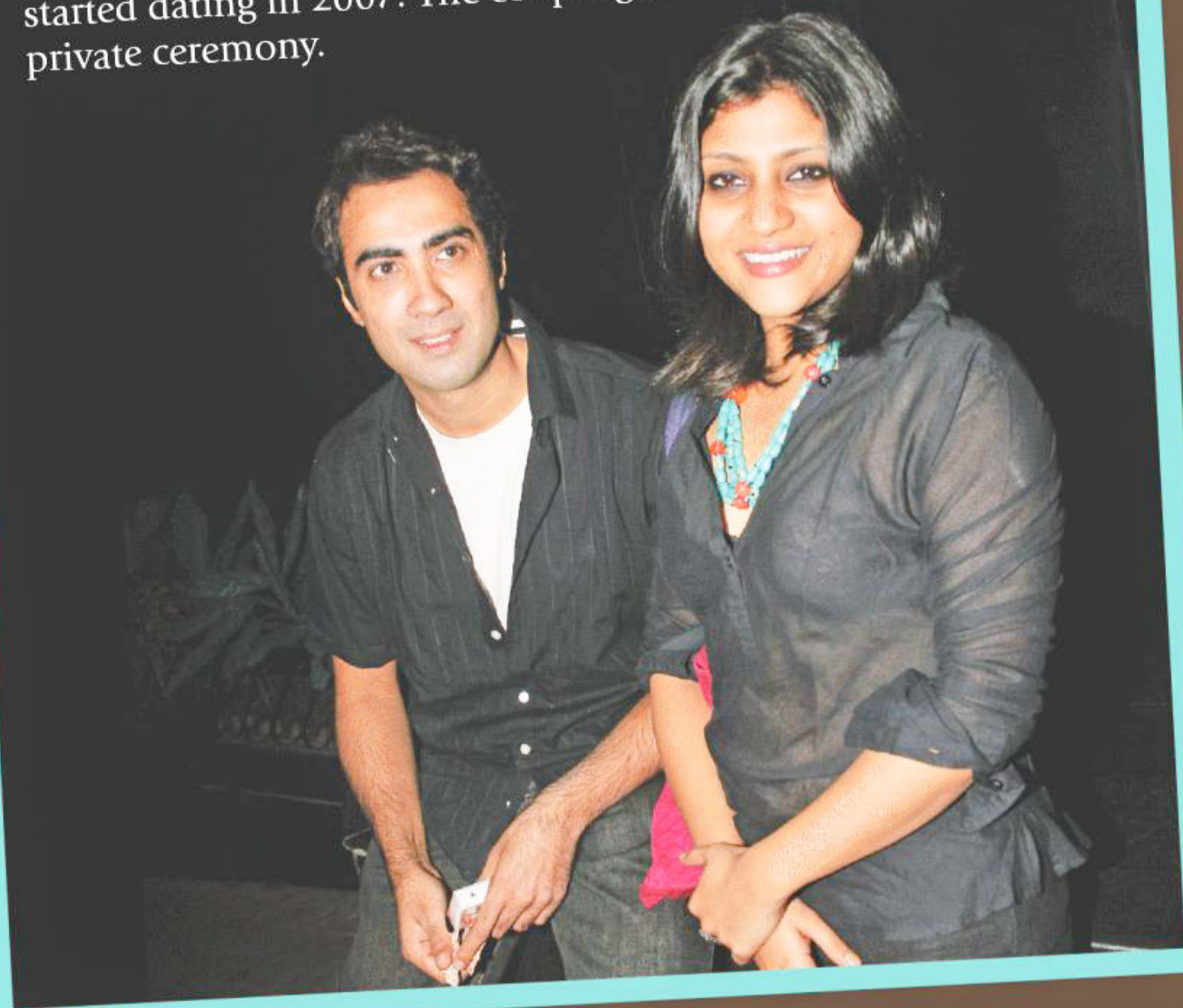


# Konkona Sen Sharma & Ranvir Shorey Announce Separation

## Filming Preparation Begins in Atlanta
