

# Robbers kill fisherman, injure 45 others in Bay

Armed robbers shot dead a fisherman and injured 45 others in Kutubdia Channel of the Bay of Bengal near Char Nizam in Monpura upazila of the district on Friday.

The deceased is Sidu Majhi, 35, of ward No 3 under Daulatkhan municipality of the district.

Of the injured, 20 fishermen were given primary treatment at Daulatkhan Upazila Health Complex and later referred to Bhola Sadar Hospital.

Among them, 11 were identified as Dulal, Maksud, Shah Alam, Maksud (2), Miraz, Alamgir, Hadis, Nur Islam, Jasim, Mezbah and Mizan, while the identity of the rest could not be known.

The injured fishermen, who returned to the shore, said Sidu along with several other fishermen from Daulatkhan upazila went to catch fish in the sea on Thursday morning.

On Friday afternoon, over 50 robbers on two trawlers opened fire on

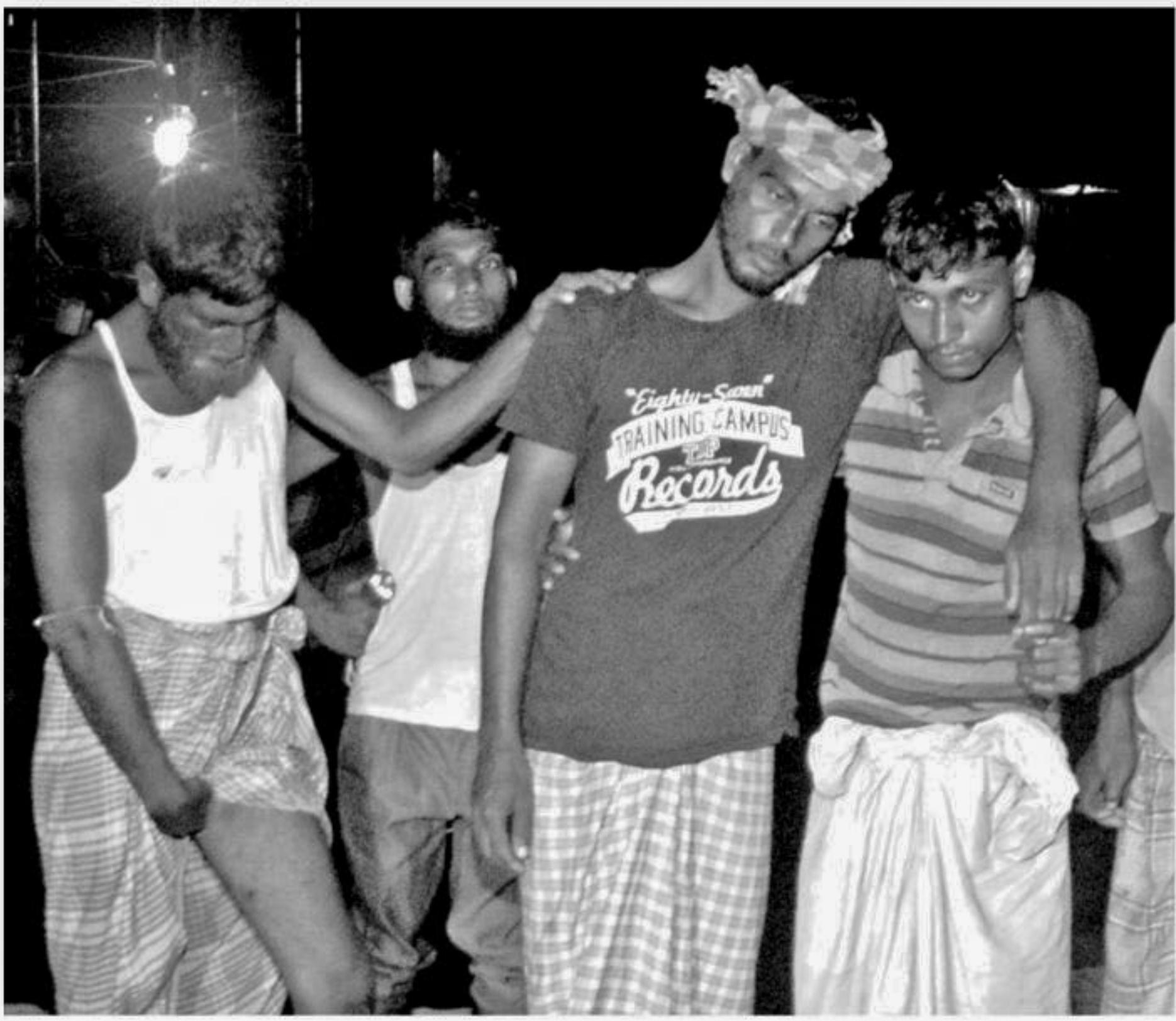

20/25 fishing trawlers, leaving Sidu dead on the spot and 45 others injured.

At least three trawlers sank in the sea after those were hit by the trawlers carrying the

robbers, said Moslem Uddin, boatman of 'FB Faria'.

However, all the fishermen of the trawlers managed to swim ashore, Moslem added.

Contacted, Abul Bashar,

officer-in-charge of Daulatkhan Police Station, said the incident occurred between Monpura and Hatia upazilas and they have already informed the police stations concerned.

## 6 cops closed on bribery charge in Thakurgaon

Six policemen of Pirganj Police Station were closed to Thakurgaon police lines on Friday evening for their alleged involvement in taking bribes from several motorbike owners.

The withdrawn policemen are sub-inspectors Nuru Alam and Md Mamun, and constables Abdul Jalil, Monoranjan, Mostafa Kamal and Md Shohag.

Superintendent of Police (SP) Farhad Ahmed ordered Assistant Superintendent of Police (ASP) Abul Kalam Azad to investigate the matter.

The policemen went to Gogar village in Ranishankoil upazila on Thursday evening and intercepted several motorbikes on Pirganj-Ranishankoil road in the name of conducting drive to seize motorbikes plying without registration.

Seeing that the policemen were releasing the bikes after taking bribes, the locals protested and confined them to a house.

On information, the OCs of Ranishankoil Police Station and Pirganj Police Station went to the spot and freed the cops through arbitration in which local public representatives were also present.

Later on Friday evening, the SP ordered to close them to the district police lines.

### BANK ROBBERY

## Two guards shown arrested

None of the robbers, who looted over Tk 21 lakh from a branch of Agrani Bank in Jessore early Friday, has been arrested, police said.

Night guards of the bank, Ansar members Biswajit and Shahidul Islam, who were detained for quizzing on Friday, were shown arrested yesterday, said AKM Ariful Haque, Additional Superintendent of Police in Jessore.

Two committees of Agrani Bank -- one headed by Deputy General Manager Wahiduzzaman, also the head of Vigilance Division of the head office, and the other headed by Assistant General Manager Mrinal Kanti Bakshi of Jessore branch -- were formed to investigate the robbery.

The robbers entered the bank at around 3:30am by cutting a window and tying up the night-guards. They then cut the vault with a blowtorch, took away the money.

## Indian cattle trader shot dead by BSF

An Indian cattle trader was killed and two others were injured as Indian Border Security Force (BSF) opened fire on a group of cattle traders along Kushkhali border in Sadar upazila of the district early Friday.

The deceased was identified as Bhola Sarder, 30, son of Anisur Sarder of Nawbatkhali village under Sharupnagar Police Station at Bashirhat sub-division.

Sources said some cattle smugglers were bringing Indian cattle to the border when the BSF members of Amudia Camp chased them. At one stage, the smugglers attacked the BSF members, who opened fire in retaliation, leaving Bhola and two others injured.

Bhola was rushed to local Badartala Hospital in Bashirhat where he succumbed to his injuries yesterday.

Subedar Haider Ali of in Taluigacha Camp in Satkhira under Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) - 38 Battalion, said the incident took place in Indian territory opposite the Kushkhali border.

# Madrasa boy rescued 4 days into abduction, 2 arrested

Police rescued a madrasa boy of Dhaka city, who was abducted four days ago, from the district town yesterday.

They also arrested two people for their alleged involvement in the abduction.

The victim is Saidur Rahman Abed, 11, son of Shahin Sakir of Bongsal area in the capital, and a student of Darul Quran Madrasa in Malitola area under Bongsal Police Station.

Police said on September

15, a gang abducted Saidur on his way to the madrasa from home. They later took him to a remote village in Kishoreganj upazila of Nilphamari.

Following a general diary filed by the victim's father, a joint team from Nilphamari and Rangpur police stations conducted a drive at the village but the abductors left the spot with the boy, sensing the presence of police.

In another drive, the law enforcers rescued Saidur from a house in Anando Babur Pool area of the town yesterday morning. They

also arrested two from the spot.

The arrestees are Ashraful Islam, 35, supervisor of Al Jamiatul Rahmania Madrasa in the area, and Mahibullah Huq Pappu, 20, of Sabujpara area in the town.

Police are also raiding different areas to arrest other accused, including Ashraful's brother-in-law Masud, in this connection.

The victim's father filed a case for abduction and human trafficking, said Shahjahan Pasha, officer-in-charge of Nilphamari Police Station.

# Two traders murdered in Dinajpur, Joypurhat

Two traders were murdered in Dinajpur and Joypurhat on Friday.

One of them, a betel leaf trader, was burnt to death in Dinajpur, while the other, a medicine trader, was stabbed to death in Joypurhat, said police.

The deceased are Mokhlesur Rahman Dhola, 28, son of Dulu Mia, of Ramnagar area under Dinajpur Municipality, and Tariqul Islam, 28 son of Abdul Kuddus Ali Mondal of Khanjanpur village under Joypurhat Municipality.

According to family members, Mokhlesur went

to his shop on Friday afternoon but did not return home. At around 10.00pm, locals found his burnt body covered with waste near his house and informed the police.

Dinajpur police recovered the body and sent it to Dinajpur Medical College Hospital for autopsy.

Dulu Mia, father of the victim, said local goons had threatened his son because he refused to give them money.

Md Khalequzzaman, officer-in-charge of Dinajpur Police Station, said Dulu Mia identified his son's body.

In Joypurhat, family

members said Tariqul Islam used to go home after closing his shop at 10.00pm every night, but he did not return home on Friday night.

Locals later found his body on the street at Sabujnagar village in Joypurhat town and informed the police. Police said criminals stabbed him to death.

Police recovered the body and set it to Joypurhat Modern hospital for autopsy.

Two separate murder cases were filed with the police stations concerned in Dinajpur and Joypurhat.

# 130 sacks of stolen rice seized in Jamalpur

Detective Branch (DB) of police seized 130 sacks of stolen rice from Sanandabari in Dewanganj upazila of Jamalpur district on Friday night.

They also arrested four people in this connection, said Imarat Hossain Gazi, officer-in-charge of DB police.

The arrestees are Anwar Hossain, 38, Ripon Miah, 30, Farhad Hossain, 38, and Raihan Miah, 45.

Police said 196 and 259 sacks of rice were stolen from Master Auto Rice Mills in Tarakanda upazila and Satata Rice Mills in Phulpur upazila on September 9 and 14.

Later, two cases were filed in connection with the stealing.

On secret information, a team of DB police led by Sub-Inspector Mafizul Islam raided Sanandabari area and arrested the four.

Following their confessional statements, the law enforcers recovered 130 sacks of stolen rice from the area.

Police are raiding different areas to recover the rest stolen rice, said the OC.

### STEALING EARTH FROM RIVERBANK

# Two jailed, one fined; 4 trawlers seized

A mobile court jailed two people and fined another on charge of illegally taking earth from the bank of the Patabunia River in Bahar Char area of Dumki upazila under the district on Friday night.

Police also seized four trawlers used for carrying the stolen earth in the area.

Of the convicts, Nasir Gazi, 30, and Dulal Khan, 28, were awarded one-year imprisonment each while and Abdur Rob Sikder, 45, was fined Tk 50,000 or to serve one year in jail in case of failure.

They hail from different villages under Dumki upazila.


Rob Sikder was freed after paying the fine and Nasir and Dulal were sent to Patuakhali Central Jail yesterday morning, said Azam Khan Faruquee, officer in charge (OC) of Dumki Police Station.

A police team led by the OC conducted a drive in the area and arrested three people when they were stealing earth from there around 6:00pm on Friday.

Sensing the presence of law enforcers, several others involved in the illegal act fled away, leaving four trawlers on the spot.

Later police produced the three arrestees before the mobile court led by Executive Magistrate Md Hafizur Rahman, also upazila nirbahi officer of Dumki, and the court delivered the judgment.

A gang is involved in stealing earth from Bahar Char area on the bank of the Patabunia River and selling it to different brick fields at Kalaskathi in Bakerganj upazila under Barisal district for long, posing threat of erosion in the area, the OC said.
