67 fishermen missing as 10 trawlers capsize in Bay

At least 67 fishermen went missing as ten trawlers capsized during a storm in the Bay yesterday morning. Forty seven of them are missing in Patuakhali district and 20 in Barguna district.

Name of the other trawler could not be known. Ansar Uddin Mollah, president of Alipur fish traders' association, said 25 fishermen were rescued from two trawlers. Sources said a storm hit the fishermen aboard five trawlers in the Bay, about 50-km south of Kuakata sea beach in the morning. Forty-seven fishermen went missing when the boats capsized. Nearby trawlers rescued all 18 fishermen of F

B Imran and seven out of 12 fishermen of F B Hasina-Samina, while five fishermen of the trawler are still missing, Mollah said, adding that around 40 fishermen of three trawlers, F B Ratan, F B Habib and F B Sobahan, are still missing. In Barguna, at least 20 fishermen went missing as five trawlers that were fishing about 60-km south of Patharghata fish landing station in Barguna capsized during a storm, said Golam

Mostafa Chowdhury, president of Barguna Fishing Trawlers Owners' Association. Of the missing fishermen, Kuddus, Saidul Islam and Shahin of F B Khan Jahan Ali, and Anamul of F B Abdullah were identified while the identity of the rest could not be known, sources said. "We have sent a trawler to search for the missing fishermen," said Md. Siddik, president of Patharghata Upazila Majhee (Driver) Association.

Truckers protest illegal toll collection

Lightning kills farmer

A farmer was killed by lightning at Natunchar village in Baliakandi upazila on Saturday. The deceased is Abdul Khalek Sheikh, 55, son of Abdull Wahed of the village.

In another development, Mokhlesur Rahman, acting inspector general of police, yesterday claimed Friday's demonstration was "instigated by a vested quarter" and that the police action was in line with the law. He, however, did not say who "instigated" the agitation. "Sometimes a mob can turn outrageous. The law makes it clear what action should be taken in such a situation. Arrestees snatched from cops

Criminals snatched four arrested drug addicts from law enforcers after injuring three policemen at Machpotti in Alangi Bazar area under Dhunat upazila of the district early yesterday. Police arrested six pro-Awami League activists in connection with the incident. The arrestees are Shaheen Alam, 48, vice president of Alangi union unit of AL, activists Lipton Mia, 40, Abdul Mannan, 30, Shaha Ali, 30; Jubo League union member Ziarul Islam, 32, and activist Suman Sarker, 32. The injured are Sub-Inspector Faruk Hossain, ASI Fazlul Haque and Constable Anwar Hossain of Dhunat Police Station. SI Milon Kumar Chatterjee filed a case with the PS against 11 people, including the six arrestees, and MA Tarek Helal, chairman of Alangi Union Parishad, on charge of attacking policemen and preventing them from performing their duty. Police in a drive arrested the drug addicts—Ranju, 30, Hanif, 30, Lablu, 28 and Mithu, 32—in the bazar area. A gang swooped on the law enforcers on way back to the PS and snatched the four from them, said Senior Assistant Superintendent of Police Gaziur Rahman. Police are raiding different areas to arrest the accused, said the ASP.

Three get life for killing youth

A Sylhet court yesterday sentenced three people to life imprisonment for killing a youth in Kamalganj upazila of Moulvibazar in 2012. The court also fined the convicts Tk 10,000 each, in default, they are to suffer one year more in jail. The convicts are Azadur Rahman, 55, his son Jewel Ahmed, 25, and nephew Abdus Samad Rubel, 26, of Patanushar village in the upazila. According to the case statement, on August 29 in 2012, Azadur along with his family members killed Abdul Mazid allegedly for having an affair with Azadur's daughter. Later, Mazid's father Abdur Rahman filed a case, accusing 11 people with Kamalganj Police Station. After investigation, police submitted the charge-sheet on August 8 in 2013. After examining the records and witnesses, Judge Makbul Ahsan of Speedy Trial Tribunal, Sylhet delivered the verdict yesterday afternoon. The court also acquitted eight other accused as the charges brought against them could not be proved.

Missing housewife found dead

Police recovered the body of a missing housewife from a paddy field at Ghanshyampur village in Hakimpur upazila of the district yesterday. The deceased is Ferdousi Begum, 40, wife of Atiar Rahman of the village. She went missing on Saturday. Locals found the body at the field around 1:00pm and informed the police, said Harun-ur-Rashid, officer-in-charge of Hakimpur Police Station. The law enforcers rushed to the spot, recovered the body and sent it to Dinajpur Medical College Hospital morgue for autopsy, said the OC.

Killing of housewife for dowry sparks protest

Protesting the murder of a housewife, allegedly for dowry, several hundred people brought out a procession in Sylhet city at around 5:00pm on Saturday and then held a rally in front of Sylhet central Shaheed Minar demanding immediate arrest of the killer husband. They also threatened to besiege the police station concerned if the culprit was not arrested within the next three days. The victim was Morjina Begum Dipa, 28, daughter of late Siraj Miah of Mullahgaon village under Dakhin Surma upazila of Sylhet district and wife of Razu Chowdhury Jahed, 31,

son of Jamir Ali of Gupsor village in the upazila. Sahin Ahmed Khan, general secretary of the Sylhet unit of Manobadhikar Bastobayon Sangstha, demanded immediate investigation into the murder and arrest of the killers. The victim's family said Dipa married Razu in 2006, and he had been demanding dowry since then. On August 26, Razu demanded Tk 8 lakh for arranging a UK visa. The victim's brother, Delwar Hossain, said his family gave Razu Tk 4 lakh, but he was not satisfied. On Friday night, the couple had an altercation over the matter. At one stage, Razu beat up Dipa mercilessly, leaving her critically

injured. She was admitted to Ragib Rabia Medical College Hospital in Sylhet city where she died on Saturday morning. On information, police went to the hospital in the afternoon. They recovered the body and sent it to Sylhet MAG Osmani Medical College Hospital for autopsy. Delwar Hossain filed a case against Razu on Saturday afternoon. Contacted, Altaf Rahman, sub-inspector of Dakhin Surma Police Station and investigating officer of the case, said a murder case has been filed with the police station and they are trying to arrest the culprit.

Abducted kid rescued, kidnapper held

Members of Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) rescued a five-year old boy from Ishwardi Bypass Railway Station on Saturday night, two days after his abduction from Savar in Dhaka. The law enforcers also arrested the alleged abductor Monirul Islam Raju, 32, uncle of the victim, from there. The victim, Mohammad Salman, son of Mirazul Islam of Pirojpur district, was abducted from his rented house in Ashulia of Savar on September 17. Raju went to visit his brother's house in Ashulia and tactfully kidnapped the boy. Later, he demanded Tk 2.5 lakh as ransom from

Salman's father over mobile phone for release of his son. Victim's father Mirazul immediately informed the Rab of the matter. The elite force, tracking Raju's cell-phone, arrested him from Ishwardi Bypass Railway Station around 8:00pm and rescued the boy from his clutch, said ASI Abu Nawaz Sardar, duty-officer of Rab-12 in Pabna.
