Woman hammered for dowry

A woman was tortured allegedly by her husband and in-laws for dowry in Sreepur upazila of Gazipur on Wednesday.

Kulsum Akter, 19, was beaten with a hammer on Wednesday, said her father Alim Uddin and locals. Alim said Kulsum married Poran Mia, 25, of Dhonua Uttorpara village a year back. He said they gave a dowry of Tk 50,000 when the two married, but six months later Poran and his family demanded Tk 2 lakh more.

On Thursday, Alim went to visit his daughter, but was told that the couple were visiting relatives. Being suspicious, he began investigating and found his daughter unable to walk due to injuries, he claimed. He quickly admitted her to the upazila health complex. Sreepur police said they have heard of the incident but no official complaint had yet been filed.

Girl's body found in capital

Police recovered the body of a 13-year old domestic help from in front of an under construction building in the capital's Eskaton on Saturday.

Mina, who worked at a nearby house of one Jakir Ahmed, had been traceless since Friday, said police. They suspected that the girl was raped in the building and then pushed down. The caretaker and nine labourers were detained from the building for interrogation. The body was sent to Dhaka Medical College for autopsy.

On the same day, he applied for a loan of Tk 1 crore which he withdrew soon after it was granted on that very day. The private bank was hit by scams in 2005-06. In 2006, Bangladesh Bank took over it and appointed an administrator. Later, the bank was sold to a Malaysia-based business group and renamed ICB Islamic Bank in 2009.
