

# IBA director, DU VC served notice about admission eligibility

A Supreme Court lawyer yesterday sent a legal notice to the authorities concerned asking them to withdraw the eligibility condition imposed recently on students regarding admission test for Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) programme at the Institute of Business Administration (IBA) of Dhaka University in 24 hours.

According to the notice, only the students, who passed the higher secondary certificate exam in 2015, can apply for admission test of IBA in the current academic session. Earlier, students, who passed HSC exams in the previous years, were able to sit for the admission test.

Eunus Ali Akond served the notice to the director of IBA and DU's vice chancellor saying that he will file a writ petition with the HC seeking necessary order if the condition is not withdrawn.

# 14 containers released with fake documents seized in Ctg

Customs officials recovered 14 loaded containers from a private depot in Chittagong city yesterday, eight days after those were released from the Chittagong Port with the help of fake documents.

On a tip-off, a team of Audit, Investigation and Research (AIR) section of Chittagong Customs House with the help of police raided a private depot "Moinamoti Marine" at Halishahar and detained one Mosharrif Hossain Masum in this connection.

Assistant Commissioner (AC) Mukitil Hasan of AIR said the 14 containers were put up for auction in 2013 as the importer did not take delivery of those on time.

One Saifuddin Haider Chowdhury bid the highest but he neither paid Tk 70 lakh as the value and duty nor took the delivery. But on September 22, the 14 containers were released from the port.

During yesterday's raid one Md Delwar went to the team to claim that he had bought the goods-laden containers from Saifuddin two months ago and also showed their agreement paper, said the AC.

Hasan said they are investigating the matter. The containers contained glycerin, said a customs official.

# Primary school enrolment of girls reaches 99.4pc

The rate of enrolment of girls for primary education increased to 99.4 percent because of various steps taken by the government for the empowerment of women, according to a report of Center of Research and Information (CRI) published in September 2015.

The present government has introduced free education for girls up to the degree level, scholarships and stipend for female students and distribution of free textbooks among the students, the report mentioned.

Various programmes undertaken by the government for empowering women and removing gender disparity include creation

of opportunities and environment for women's employment and increasing facilities for their education and participation in the policymaking process, said the report titled "Empowering Women".

The initiatives taken for increasing women's participation in policymaking include making 20 percent seats for women in parliament mandatory, recruiting one-third female workers in local government organisations, sending female police to UN peacekeeping missions and increasing women's representation in local government bodies.
