The Consultant-Firm should have the following experience: At least 10 (ten) years of experience in feasibility studies, demand surveys, financial economic technical social and environmental assessments preferably with developing economic/industrial zones, large size industrial parks, or Export Processing Zones. The firm should also have experience of implementation, knowledge and understanding of the operation of industrial zones or EPZs, verifiable success in the delivery of high-quality outputs within time and budget constraints.
