## Bring college boy Sumon's killers to book

Demand human chain, rally at Bhuapur in Tangail

People of Falda and adjacent villages under Bhuapur upazila of the district formed a human chain and held a rally at Falda Bazar yesterday, demanding arrest and exemplary punishment of the killers of college student Sumon Miah.

Several hundred people, including women and children, took part in the programme with banners and placards, and gave a 24-hour ultimatum to police for arresting the culprits.

At the rally, the protesters also threatened to launch a tougher agitation programme if the law enforcers failed to nab the

culprits by the deadline. Among others, local political leaders Swaran Datta, Fariduzzaman Selim, Selimuzzaman Selu and Abdul Hannan spoke at the rally. The speakers expressed their disappointment, saying that police could not arrest any of the killers even two days after the brutal killing.

Sumon Miah, 20, son of Ramjan Ali of Falda village and a first year student of Ibrahim Khan Government College in Bhuapur upazila, was abducted by local goons from a wedding party at Sujanagar village in Gopalpur upazila on Saturday night because of enmity over love affair with a girl, police and local

sources said.

The gang tied Sumon to a tree and beat him up mercilessly.

Being informed by locals, the victim's father went to the rally, rescued Sumon and took him to Gopalpur Upazila Health Complex. He died while he was being taken to Tangail Medical College Hospital on Sunday.

Sumon's father filed a case with Bhuapur Police Station on Monday, accusing six people by name and four others who were not identified.

Contacted, Fazlul Kabir, officer-in-charge of Bhuapur Police Station, said the law enforcers are raiding different areas to arrest the rest of the accused.

### 2 youths electrocuted

UNB, Netrakona

Two youths died from electrocution at Satburikanda village in Sadar upazila yesterday. The deceased are Shamsuddin Mia, 25, son of Khaleque Mia, and Liton, 25, son of Abul Kalam of the village. Masudul Alam, officer-in-charge of Sadar Model Police Station, said the duo came in contact with a live electric wire while fixing cable TV connection at noon. On information, police went to the spot, recovered the bodies and sent those to Sadar Hospital for autopsies.

### 10 injured as villagers clash

UNB, Gopalganj

At least 10 people were injured in a clash between two groups of villagers over a trifling matter at Ulpur village in Sadar upazila on Monday. Abu Nayem, sub-inspector of Bouloli Police Camp, said one Ashraf Mollah and Ulu Mollah of the village locked in an altercation in the morning over fishing in a local canal. As a sequel, their supporters' equipped with sharp weapons swooped on each other around 5:00pm, leaving 10 people, including a woman injured. Of the injured, Ashraf, Hasmat and Mabia Begum were admitted to Gopalganj Sadar Hospital while Monir was taken to Khulna Medical College Hospital.

### Woman killed in boat capsized

A woman drowned and a girl went missing as a boat capsized in Boithakhali canal in Austagram upazila on Monday night. The deceased is Sokhila Begum, 40, wife of Hazrat Ali of the village. An engine driven boat with several passengers on board sank in the canal due to heavy current around 8:00pm, leaving Sokhila dead and Tania, 12, missing, said Kamrul Islam, officer-in-charge of Austagram Police Station.

### One held with arms, ammo

DB police yesterday arrested a criminal at Kagojpur village under Benapole Port Police Station and seized one foreign-made pistol, three bullets, one magazine and 300 grams of heroin from his possession. The arrestee is Hafizur Rahman, son of Abdur Rob of Dakkhin Kagojpur village of the district. Murad Hossain, sub-inspector of DB police in Jessore district, said a team of the DB police, acting on a tip-off, conducted a drive in the area and arrested Hafizur at 12 noon. Hafizur was the main accused in the case for looting of Tk 11 lakh in front of Benapole Sonali Bank. DB police are investigating the case.

### 2 smugglers held

Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) yesterday arrested two smugglers with Indian phensidyl and a motorbike from Rumkhana frontier under Nageswari upazila of the district. The arrestees were identified as Badol Hossain, 37, son of Mansur Ali of Singerbhita village, and Nuru Mia, 35, son of late Gendu Sheikh of Varaitari village. According to sources of 45 BGB Battalion in Kurigram, a BGB team of Rumkhana BOP raided the Ramkhana village near border pillar No 951/S-3 at around 5:00am on the day, and arrested the two smugglers with 40 bottles of Indian phensidyl and one Indian Bajaj motorbike. The arrestees were handed over to Nageswari Police Station while the phensidyl was sent to Narcotic Control Department of the upazila.

### Housewife murdered

A housewife was stabbed to death by her husband over a family feud in Bittichra village under Benapole Port Police Station on Monday. The deceased was identified as Samiran Bibi, 30, wife of Joinal Abedin, and a resident of Bitti Achra village. Apurba Hasan, officer-in-charge Benapole Port Police Station, said Samiran and her husband had an altercation at night over a family matter. At one stage, Joinal stabbed his wife with a sharp weapon. She died on the spot. Joinal Abedin fled the scene. Police recovered the body and sent it to Jessore Medical College Hospital for autopsy. A case was filed in this connection.

### Missing woman found dead

Police recovered the body of a woman at Tangail Sadar upazila yesterday, two days after she went missing.

The deceased is Jamela Khatun, 45, wife of Based Ali of Kathua Jugni village.

Local sources said Jamela had been missing after some unidentified people called her out from her house on Saturday night.

Locals informed police after they saw her body floating on a river in Pitchuria Tablapara area.

Police recovered the body and sent it to the Tangail Medical College Hospital morgue for autopsy, said Golam Mostofa, officer-in-charge of Tangail Model Police Station.

As a scarf was tied around the throat of the body, police suspect that the woman was strangled and her body was dumped in the river, he added.

# Girl rescued 5 months into abduction, one arrested

A schoolgirl, abducted from Dhunat upazila of Bogra on April 30, was rescued from Kazipur upazila of Sirajganj on Monday morning.

The victim is a Class IX student of Dhunat Girls' School. She hails from Matikora village under Dhunat upazila.

Police sent her to Shaheed Zairur Rahman Medical College Hospital (SZMCH) for medical test.

Victim's father lodged a

case accusing four people, including abductor Mukit, with Dhunat Police Station on September 11 after failing to trace her.

Police arrested the abductor, Mukit Mia, 20, son of Mofiz Uddin of Dublagari village under Kazipur upazila of Sirajganj district, from Dublagari village in the upazila.

According to the case statement, Mukit had been stalking the girl on the way to school and proposing love for one year. Being

rejected by the girl, Mukit with the help of his accomplices abducted her from in front of the fire service station at the upazila headquarters while she was going to school.

On Monday, police produced the arrestee before a Bogra court that sent him to jail.

Contacted, Milon Kumar Chattarjee, sub-inspector (SI) of Dhunat Police Station, said police are raiding different areas to arrest the rest of the accused.
