### Two fake NGO officials held in Pirojpur

The Detective Branch of police on Thursday night arrested two officials of a fake non-government organisation (NGO) in Pirojpur town who used to blackmail government officials in the name of disclosing their corruption details and also swindle youths by luring them with fake jobs.

Khan Al Kawsar, 42, of Pirojpur Sadar upazila, masqueraded as the executive director while Md Masud Uddin Badal, 48, of Kawkhali upazila, as the deputy director of Janosharthe Durniti Anushandhan (investigating corruption for public interest), said police at a press conference.

The NGO has no registration and they used to change their address frequently, police added.

### Seven killed, 20 hurt in Habiganj road crash

Four die in three other dists; 64 injured

At least seven people were killed and 20 others injured in a road accident on the Dhaka-Sylhet highway in Jamalpur of Habiganj last night.

Sherpur Highway Police Station Officer-in-Charge Golam Nurunnabi said the accident occurred when a Sylhet-bound passenger bus of "Hanif Paribahan" hit a truck which was standing beside the road, killing three people instantly.

The injured were taken to Sylhet MAG Osmani Medical College Hospital where the other four died.

Our Mymensingh correspondent reports, rickshaw-van puller Md Kajal, 23, was killed and some 10 bus passengers were injured as the bus hit the rickshaw-van on Dhaka-Mymensingh highway in Boilor of Trishal upazila.

The bus plunged into a roadside ditch, police quoted locals as saying. Meanwhile, Ibrahim Khalil, 35, of Sadar upazila was killed and four others were injured after a bus hit a human hauler carrying them in Mashkanda.

The injured were admitted to Mymensingh Medical College Hospital.

Our Bogra correspondent reports, trucker Abul Bashar, 30, was killed and at least 20 people were injured as the truck and a bus collided head-on on Dhaka-Bogra highway in Dhankundi of Sherpur upazila.

Our Khagrachhari correspondent adds, Mohammad Kabir, 20, was killed while 30 others were injured as a bus carrying them overturned in Board Office area of Matiranga.

land or property eventually lose their mental balance and are brought here for treatment."

Dr Khasru Parvez, head of the forensic psychiatry department at NIMHR, said children should get special care as the way they thought was completely different from adults'.

"Though, globally, it is encouraged to treat all patients in a general inclusive system, kids should obviously be taken care of especially," he said.

NIMHR Director Prof Abdul Hamid acknowledged that criminals, drug abusers, and children should not be treated at the same place, especially when it was about mental conditions.

"The manpower shortage has thrown us into this mess," he said.

There are 165 employees against 217 positions at NIMHR, shows its website. Of the 52 vacant posts, at least 42 are supposed to be filled with class III and IV employees.

The director explained that the NIMHR build-

ing was not designed in a way wherein patients with different needs could be treated in separate wards.

**POOR SERVICES**

Though it was mentioned at different places of the hospital that emergency services were open 24/7, this correspondent found the section deserted from 7:30pm to 9:30pm on September 8.

The next day, the emergency section was found locked. The director said, "Since the outpatient department is open, we kept the emergency section closed for the manpower shortage."

Regarding allegations that doctors visit patients no more than twice a week for being involved in private practice, Hamid said it was not true. "One must take leave for private practice," he said.

Prof Shamiul Islam, director general of the Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS), said specialised hospitals took time to increase their manpower. "We are trying to build the workforce," he said.

**'TOO QUICK'**

In a recent visit to Shishu Bikash Kendra, the correspondent saw at least five children were called into a small room where five doctors listened to their problems at a time.

Mariya Akhter Jui, 14, who came from Tangail, was asked to come 20 days later but his father Abdul Jalil did not know what she was suffering from.

Doctors did not take the time to describe it to him.

A cousin of Sumaiya, 14, who took a 7-hour overnight bus ride from Meherpur to come to the hospital, expressed his disappointment.

"This should not be the way of seeing a mental patient," Rabiul Islam, 35, said, referring to the five doctors seeing five patients at a time and so quickly.

"At least half an hour should be spent for each patient," he thinks. "They are doing it just because they have to do it, denying patients a chance to open up."

### 15,000 cattle fattening pills seized
