## CAR BRAND MATTERS

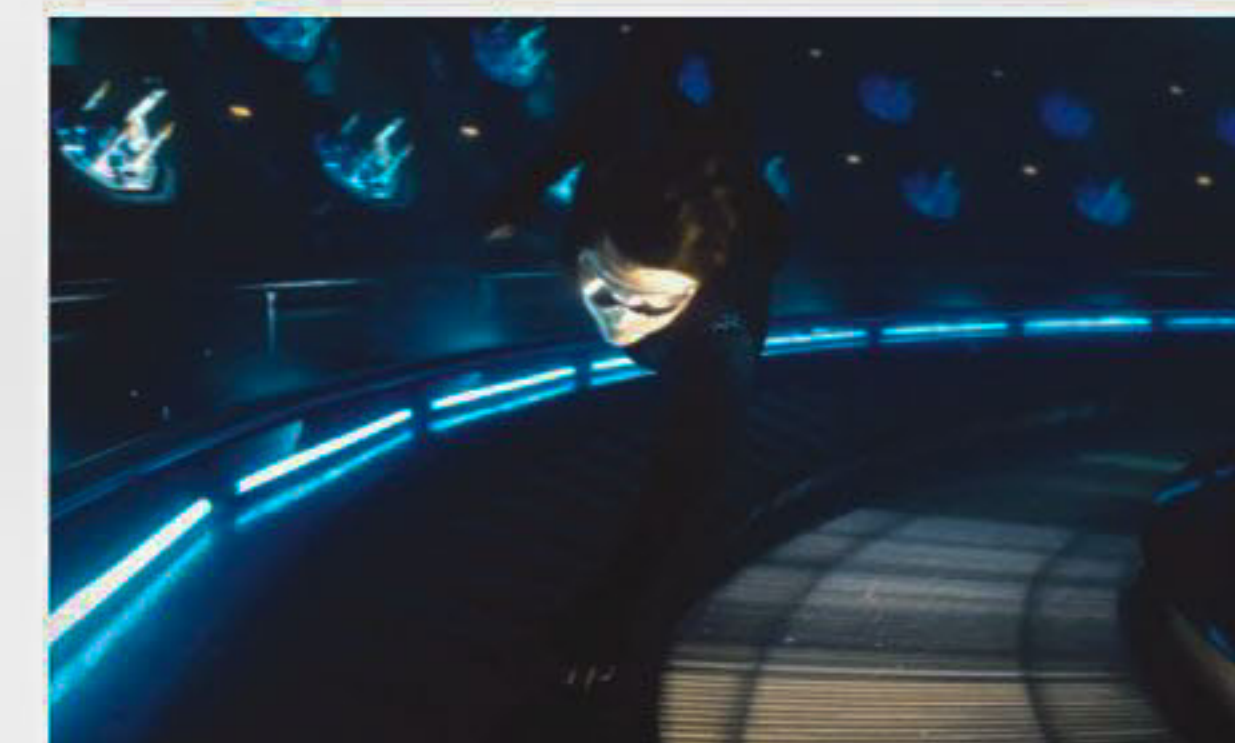
