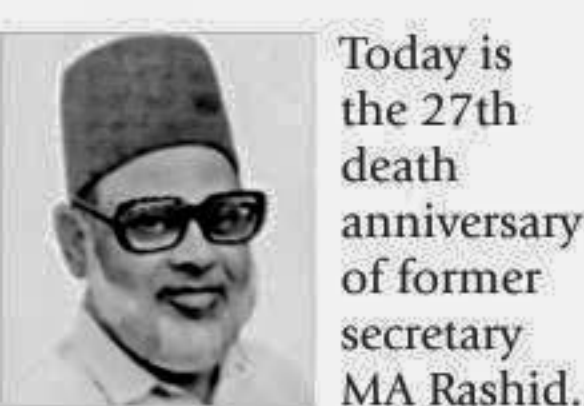


**Death anniversary**

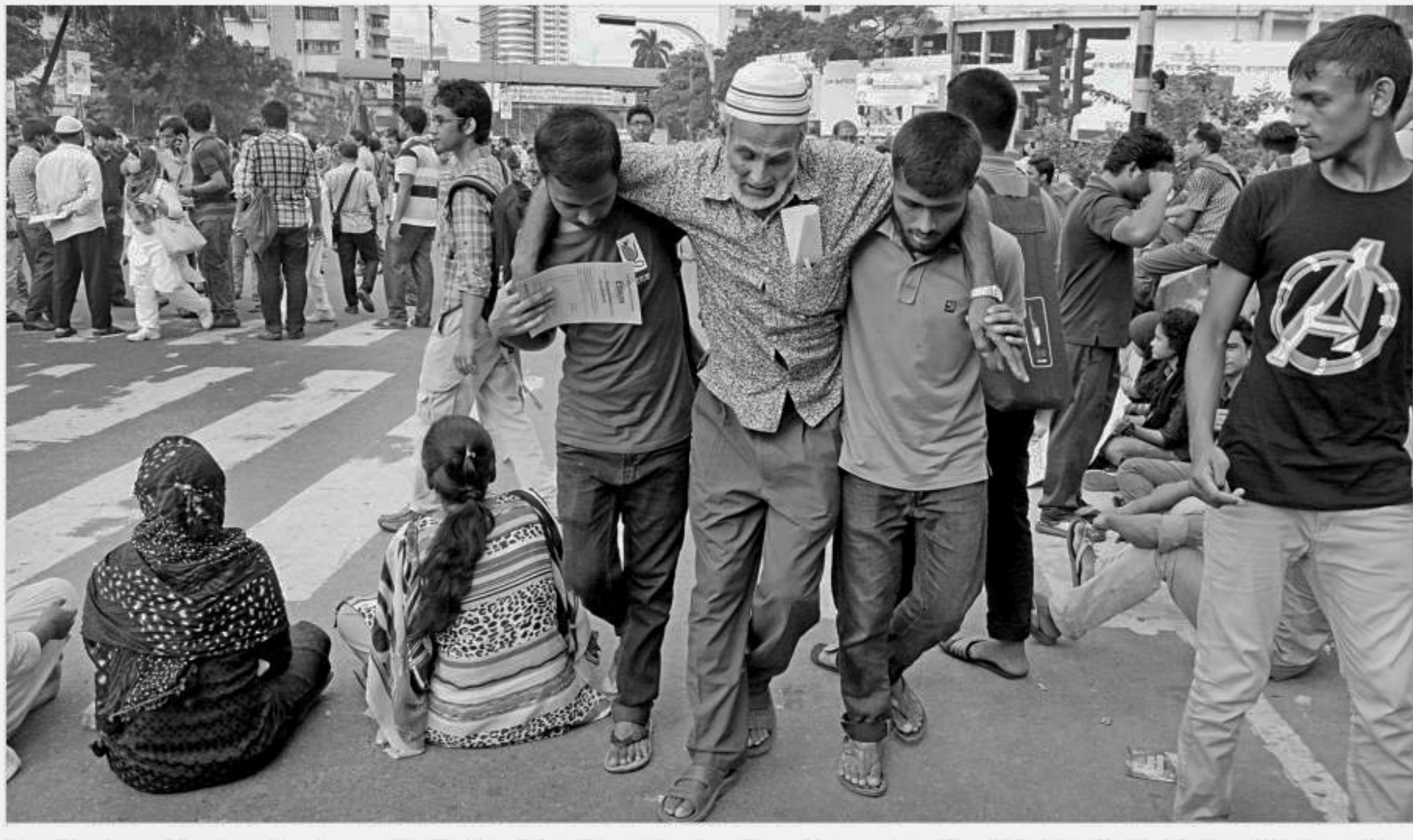

**Road crashes kill 6, injure 1**

Six people were killed and another was injured in road accidents in three districts yesterday and on Saturday. In Nilphamari, two people were killed as a motorcycle collided head-on with a tractor on Nilphamari-Saidpur road at Kachari on Saturday. The deceased were Nuronnabi of Tepur Danga village and Aduri Rani of Gobindopur village. In Tangail, two youths were killed when a covered-van hit their motorcycle on Dhaka-Tangail highway at Karatipara Bypass in Basail upazila yesterday. The deceased -- Galib Hossain, 24, of Gazipur and Yunus Miah, 25, of Tangail -- were cousins. In Chittagong, Sabuj Majumder, 25, of Uttar Banshbaria area was killed and his co-rider injured as their motorcycle collided head-on with a truck on Dhaka-Chittagong Highway in Fakirhat area of Sitakunad upazila on Saturday. Meanwhile, an unidentified youth was killed after being hit by a microbus near Karnaphuli 3rd Bridge in Chittagong city yesterday.

**Govt served legal notice for judicial probe into UGC man's custodial death**

A Supreme Court lawyer yesterday sent a legal notice to the government seeking a judicial inquiry in 24 hours into the custodial death of a University Grants Commission (UGC) official. Eunus Ali Akond issued the notice requesting the government to take necessary steps against the persons involved in the incident. Omar Siraj, an assistant director of UGC, was arrested on September 18 for allegedly leaking medical college admission question papers and died in Rapid Action Battalion's (Rab) custody on October 1. He was under remand for two days. Eunus said he would file a writ petition with the High Court seeking necessary orders if the government does not form the body. The Daily Star has reported Omar's family's allegation that he died of torture, he said in the notice.

FROM PAGE 3 that in the post 9/11 context, the dominant sense was that use of force could suppress terrorism. Fourteen years later it must be acknowledged that combatting terrorism by military means only contributes to creating more terrorism, he said. "Closer to us, in Bangladesh, how does the situation look like? The course of events that has unfolded since the beginning of this year portrays a pretty gloomy picture," added the head of the EU Delegation to Bangladesh. He referred to the political violence with indiscriminate arson attacks targeting innocent citizens over the first three months, assault on women celebrating Pabla Baishakh in Dhaka University, murder of 13-year-old Rajan in Sylhet in July, which dramatically illustrates the dark reality of violence against children; and the four bloggers being assassinated by militants in less than six months. "And now these mysterious assassinations of an Italian aid worker and of a Japanese citizen...should investigations conclude that Cesare and Kunio were killed because they were foreigners, this would open an unprecedented and somber chapter of violence in this country," said the ambassador.

JP MP SENT TO JAIL The same tribunal yesterday sent four war crimes accused, including lawmaker from Trishal (Mymensingh-7 constituency) and presidium member of Jatiya Party MA Hannan and his son Rafique Sajjad, to jail after police produced them before it. Hannan, alleged general secretary of Mymensingh Peace Committee, an

anti-liberation organisation in 1971, and his son were arrested by Gulshan police while Mymensingh police arrested Khandakar Golam Sabbir Ahmed, Mizanur Rahman Mintu and Hormuj Ali in their respective homes on Thursday, hours after the tribunal issued arrest warrants for eight people. Hormuj was admitted to Dhaka Medical College Hospital after being injured in a road accident on the day of his arrest. Police produced the four before a Dhaka court on Friday, as the

tribunal was closed on that day. Three others accused -- Mohammad Abdus Sattar, Mohammad Fakruzzaman and Khandakar Golam Rabbani -- are yet to be detained, prosecution and investigation agency sources said. Qutubuddin Ahmed yesterday submitted vocalatnama (power of attorney) for Sabbir Ahmed while the three others were yet to appoint any lawyers. The tribunal fixed November 17 for passing the next order.
