Hilsa fishing resumes as 15-day ban ends

Hilsa netting has resumed yesterday as a 15-day ban on catching of the popular fish ended on Friday. The ban was imposed by the directorate of fisheries since September 25 to protect mother hilsa and ensure its safe spawning in all the coastal rivers. Bazlur Rashid, deputy director of fisheries department in the division, said the restriction against

catching, selling and transporting the fish across the division was carried out successfully. During the ban period, 1387 anti-hilsa netting drives took place, 880 mobile courts operated and 848 cases were lodged. The mobile courts sentenced 531 fishermen to different jail terms and realised Tk 16.25 lakh as fine from 298 others. The courts also seized 50.29 lakh metres of fishing nets and nearly 11 tons of

mother hilsa in six districts of Barisal division, Bazlur further said. Ajit Das Monu, president of Barisal Fish Wholesalers' Association, said over 2.55 lakh registered fishermen in the division are upbeat and the hilsa market became lively with the ban on netting the popular fish ended on Friday. Israil Pandit, president of Bangladesh Khudra Matsyajibi Samity, said they urged the authorities concerned to compensate and

rehabilitate the affected fishermen instead of jail, fine and burning their fishing nets. In Patuakhali, huge quantities of mother hilsa were seen being sold at different markets of the district at lower prices. Locals alleged that some corrupt and ill-intentioned fishermen netted the fish violating the 15-day restriction, stored those at secret places and as the ban period is over they brought them to the markets for sale.

Human trafficker arrested

Law enforcers in a drive arrested a suspected human trafficker from Sonarpara area in Ukhiya upazila yesterday.

The arrestee is Rustom Ali, 45, son of late Yousuf Ali of Sonaichhari village. On secret information, a police team raided the area around 9:00am and arrested Rustom from a restaurant, said Premananda Das, sub-inspector of Ukhiya Police Station.

Rustom is an accused in four cases for human trafficking filed with Ukhiya Police Station, said police.

Land dispute leaves one dead

A man was beaten to death over a land dispute in Mayabazar area under Singra upazila of the district yesterday.

The deceased was identified as Shamsul Alam, 30, son of Moghor Ali of Vogabasantapur area of the upazila.

Nasir Uddin, officer-in-charge of Singra Police Station, said there had been a longstanding feud between Shamsul Alam and his cousin Ruhul Amin over a piece of land.

Ruhul Amin and Shamsul Alam locked in a quarrel at noon. At one stage, Ruhul and his men attacked Shamsul with lethal weapons, leaving him critically injured.

Locals took Shamsul to Rajshahi Medical College Hospital where he succumbed to his injuries at about 2:30pm.

Abducted boy found dead, another rescued

The body of an abducted teenage boy was recovered from Chuadanga district on Friday while Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) rescued a kidnapped college student from the district yesterday.

Police recovered the body of a boy, who was abducted seven days ago, from the Nabaganga River in Alamdanga upazila of Chuadanga on Friday afternoon.

The victim is Salek Uddin, 16, son of Shamsul Alam of Kabilnagar village in the upazila, reports our Kushtia correspondent.

Locals found the body floating in the river and informed the police around 3:30pm, said Atiar Rahman, officer-in-charge of Alamdanga Police Station

The law enforcers rushed to the spot, recovered the body and sent it to Chuadanga Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy, said the OC.

On October 3, Salek was abducted for Tk 10 lakh, said police and family sources. Later, the victim's father filed a general diary with the police station in this connection.

Meanwhile, Rab rescued an abducted college boy from the same district yesterday, reports our Jhenidah correspondent.

The elite force also arrested four men for their alleged involvement in the abduction.

The victim is Imran Hossain, 24, a student of Jhenidah KC College, and son of Osman Gani of Bagutia village in

Shailakupa upazila of Jhenidah.

Accused Mostafizur Rahman, Mamunur Rashid, Toufik Ahmed and Amir Hossain hail from Palashpara in Chuadanga town.

Jhenidah RAB commander Mohammad Suruj Mia said the arrestees opened a fake Facebook account named Mim and developed a love affair with Imran.

On October 6, Mim told Imran to meet her in front of Veterinary College in Jhenidah. When Imran reached the spot the four abducted him for Tk 5 lakh ransom.

After tracking the mobile calls, Rab men raided Shantipara area in the town yesterday afternoon and rescued Imran.

They also arrested the four from the spot, said the commander.

Girl commits 'suicide'

Police recovered the body of a teenage girl at Airmari village in Islampur upazila of the district yesterday. The deceased was identified as Amena, 15, daughter of Azizul Hauque of the village. Police and locals said the girl fell in love with a youth of the village. Her parents decided to marry off her with another man a few days ago. Being upset by the situation, Amena took her life by hanging herself from a tree near their house in the morning.

SZMC reopens today

Shaheed Ziaur Rahman Medical College (SZMC) of Bogra opens today after 4 days of closure from October 7. Dr Rezaul Alam Jewel said the academic council decided to open the dormitories, both male and female, on Saturday afternoon and the College on Sunday morning as the situation has returned to normal. Contacted, Arifur Rahman Mondal, additional superintendent of police (East) of Bogra, said adequate security measures have been taken to prevent any unwanted occurrence. Earlier, the medical college was declared closed for an indefinite period on Wednesday following a clash between two rival groups of Bangladesh Chhatra League.

Arms peddler held with pistols

Members of the Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) arrested an alleged arms peddler along with pistols and bullets from Rasunchawk village in Shibganj upazila of the district yesterday. The arrestee is Mohammad Babul, 40, of Khagratala village in the same upazila. ASP Alok Biswas, commander of Chapainawabganj Rab-5 camp, said members of the elite force, acting on a tip-off, raided the village around 12:20pm and detained Babul. They seized two foreign made pistols, four magazines and eight bullets from his possession, added the ASP.

Man electrocuted

Quoting victim's family members, police said Insan came in contact with a live electric wire while he was trying to connect a bulb at his residence.

Chararhat massacre day observed

People of Nawabganj upazila under Dinajpur district observed Chararhat killing day yesterday. On this day in 1971, Pakistani occupation army with the help of local collaborators killed at least 103 innocent people of two villages in adjacent Chararat area. Dinajpur unit of Sector Commanders Forum organised the programme at the killing site. Md Nurul Alam,

Organising Secretary of Central Sector Commanders Forum, attended as chief guest. Those who narrowly escaped death on that day described their horrific experiences at the programme. Sarifa Begum is one of them. She said Pakistan soldiers along with Razakars entered Pranskrishnapur and Saraipara villages at midnight on October 9. When the villagers found that Pakistani

troops had entered their villages, they fled with their family members and took shelter at mosques, but Razakars helped the Pakistani soldiers catch 103 people. The Pakistani soldiers took them to Chararhat area, lined up all the people there and shot them to death, she said. Local philanthropists and the Sector Commanders Forum, built a memorial for the martyrs at the killing site.

School committee chief accused of corruption

Students and guardians yesterday demonstrated demanding removal of the president of Kisamat Chandrapur Government Primary School managing committee in Aditmari upazila of the district, bringing corruption charge against him. The teachers and students alleged that president of the committee Delwar Hossain Basuniya misappropriated fund for sports

accessories, school's tree plantation project and even stipend money but he always blamed the headmaster and other teachers for the embezzlement. Headmaster Mahfuzar Rahman played a great role to improve the educational atmosphere in the last one year but the president continued making 'conspiracy' against him, they said. The quality of education will certainly fall if the president is not removed immediately, they added.

The headmaster said he has been facing setback on school development work due to lack of cooperation of the president. On the other hand, the president said he is trying to do something good for the school but the headmaster does not obey him. District Primary Education Officer Nabez Uddin said investigation against the school committee president is going on and they will take necessary steps in this regard very
