

Charges pressed against 3 for torturing schoolboy

Police submitted charge sheet against three people in a case for torturing a schoolboy in the district yesterday.

The charge sheeted accused are Khalilur Rahman, 60, Belal Hossain, 50, and Shamim Sarkar alias Minar, 30, of Manik Potal village in Dhunat upazila.

Sub-Inspector of Dhunat Police Station Rafiqul Islam, investigation officer of the case, placed the charge sheet against the trio in a Bogra court in the afternoon.

The charge sheet, however, recommended acquittal of two other accused—Al Amin, 22, son of Nayeab Ali, and Mizanur Rahman, 25, son of Shajahan Ali of Manikpotal village in the upazila, said police.



Rabbi Mia

The victim is Rabbi Mia, 8, son of Lal Mia of Manikpotal village of Nandigram upazila, and a Class III student of Morichtola Government Primary School.

On September 11, Lal Mia filed the case with the police station against five people.

According to the case statement, Rabbi had to cross the house of one Korban Ali of Manikpotal village on way to the school. At that time, neighbour Khalilur Rahman informed Korban that the boy entered his house for stealing.

Later, Rabbi was tied to a tree and brutally tortured. Being informed, police rescued the victim from the spot and sent him to the upazila health complex.

Four accused in Pabna ASI murder case remanded

A Pabna court yesterday placed four accused in the case for killing police officer Sujaul Islam on a five day remand.

The accused -- Md Khokon Hossain, 32, of Juktitola village, Jani Pramanik, 21, of Baghail village, Masud Rana, 25, of Thakurpara village, and Md Shetu, 25, of Pakshey in Ishwardi upazila of the district -- are drug peddlers and muggers, police said.

Shetu was arrested on Saturday from Pakshey while the rest three were arrested from different areas in the upazila on Thursday.

Police produced the arrestees before the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate's Court yesterday, seeking 10 days' remand for each

of them. Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate Md Rejaul Karim granted five days' remand, said Biman Kumar Das, officer-in-charge of Ishwardi Police Station.

"We have got some clues and vital information from the arrestees during interrogation," the OC said, adding that they found involvement of the arrestees with the murder during primary investigation.

Assistant sub-inspector (ASI) Md Sujaul Islam was called out of his house by an unidentified caller early Monday. His body was recovered from a turmeric field near Pakshey rail station on the day.

SI Rejaul Islam of Pakshey Police Camp filed a case with Ishwardi Police Station on Tuesday, accusing unnamed criminals.

Minor boy killed in boiler blast

A five-year-old boy was killed in a boiler blast at a rice mill in Gangapara village under Islampur upazila of the district yesterday morning.

The deceased was identified as Apon, son of Saidur Rahman of the village.

Police, quoting locals, said Apon along with other boys was playing in front of the rice mill, which belongs to one Sultan of the village, at around 9:00am.

At that time, the boiler exploded with a big bang and its broken parts hit the boy, leaving him dead on the spot, said Deen-e-Alam, officer-in-charge (OC) of Islampur Police Station.

One killed, 15 hurt in clash over land dispute

A man was killed and 15 others were injured in a clash between two rival groups over land dispute at Sikandarpur village in Dirai upazila of Sunamganj district yesterday.

The deceased was identified as Abdul Malik, 60, a resident of the village.

Bayes Alam, officer-in-charge of Dirai Police Station, said there was a longstanding dispute between Juned Ahmed, 45, and Sumon Miah, 40, over the ownership of a piece of land at the village.

As a sequel to the conflict, supporters of Juned Ahmed, 45, and Sumon Miah, 40, attacked each other at about 9:00am, leaving Abdul Malik dead on the spot and 15 others injured.

Five of the injured were admitted to Sylhet MAG Osmani Medical College Hospital while the rest 10 others took admission at Sunamganj Sadar Hospital and Dirai Upazila Health Complex.

Police recovered the body and sent it to Sunamganj Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy.

Nachole UZ health complex limping for want of doctors

Shortage of doctors and other staff badly affects medical services at Nachole Upazila Health Complex in the district, much to the sufferings of local patients, especially the poor ones.

There are only six doctors against 12 posts at the state-run health complex meant for 1.32 lakh people in the upazila.

Other important posts, including surgical consultant, junior anaesthetist, medicine consultant, dental surgeon, gynaecologist and resident medical officer are lying vacant for long, said sources at the Upazila Health and Family Planning Office.

Besides, the posts of cashier, store-keeper, assistant nurse and 14 others

are vacant.

The operational equipment is lying idle for long due to absence of anaesthetist, gynaecologist and surgeon, and doctors of the hospital often sent the critical patients to Chapainawabganj Adhunik Sadar Hospital or Rajshahi Medical College Hospital.

On an average, around 300 outpatients come for treatment daily while about a dozen patients remain admitted to the 50-bed health complex.

Only two medical officers and three assistant surgeons, who have to work at the emergency department and attend indoor patients too, treat outdoor patients.

"It is not humanly possible for only two to three doctors to deliver medical

services to so many people," said a doctor of the health complex.

"I came for treatment of my two-year-old daughter at 9:00am but I had to wait three hours to see the doctor," Khaleida Khatun of Jholmolia village in the upazila said a few days ago.

Amid lack of sufficient healthcare facilities at the health centre, many poor patients seeking treatment elsewhere fall into the trap of middlemen and end up spending huge sums of money, often borrowed from loan sharks, locals alleged.

Dr Shafiqul Islam, upazila health and family planning officer of Nachole, said they sent several letters to the higher authorities concerned asking for steps to fill up the vacant posts but to no effect yet.

Two men stabbed

Two people were stabbed allegedly by a suspended district information officer in the town yesterday. The injured are Abdul Hannan, 60, and his associate Jahangir Alam, 45. They were admitted to Khagrachhari Adhunik Sadar Hospital. The accused, Md Anwar Hossain, became mentally ill after languishing in jail for six months in a murder case, said police. Anwar attacked the duo with sharp weapons on the District and Sessions Judge's Court premises around 11:00am, leaving them injured. A case was filed in this connection, said Officer-in-Charge of Sadar Police Station Muhammad Samsuddin Bhuiyan.

Man murdered, 4 arrested

A man, who was seriously injured in an attack allegedly by his neighbours three days ago, died at Rangpur Medical College Hospital yesterday. Police arrested four people in this connection. The victim is Zikrul Mia, 38, son of late Abdul Kader of Barobhita village in Kishorganj upazila of the district. Police and locals said the family members of Zikrul locked in an altercation with their neighbours over a trivial matter on Thursday. At one stage, the neighbours attacked Zikrul, leaving him seriously injured. He was rushed to the upazila health complex and then shifted to the hospital as his condition deteriorated, said Mostafizur Rahman, officer-in-charge of Kishorganj Police Station.

Sec 144 in Nabinagar upazila

The local administration has imposed Section 144 in Pilot High School area of Nabinagar upazila under the district on Saturday. The restriction will remain in force from 6:00pm on the day until further notice. Police said there was a longstanding conflict between Abdur Rahim, organising secretary of the upazila unit of Awami League, and Khairul Amin, joint general secretary of the municipality unit of the party, over occupying a government land adjacent to the school. In the evening, a chaotic situation erupted at the arbitration meeting, the upazila nirbahari officer imposed the restriction to avert any untoward incident.

Outlawed party leader held
