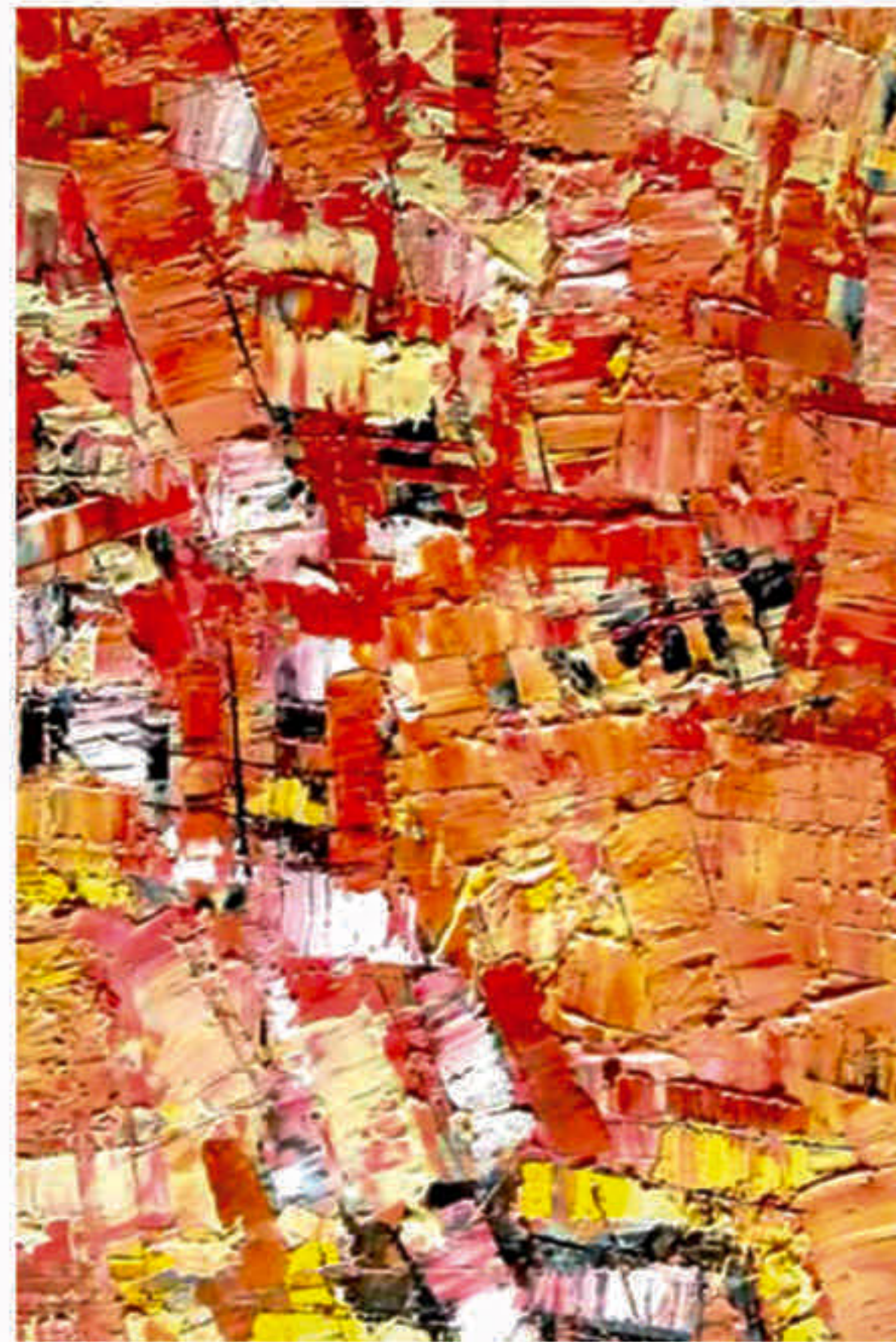
ILLUMINATED PURAN DHAKA – HERITAGE IN LIMELIGHT
