Planning Minister AHM Mustafa Kamal said Bangladesh's economy was growing with a GDP growth of six percent and agriculture was playing a critical role.

Poverty level will be brought down to 16 percent from 23 percent by 2020, he said, adding that the seventh fifth-year plan would be mostly dedicated to poverty reduction and meant to mainstream marginal people in haor and char

Dr Abdur Razzaque, former executive chairman of Barc, said farming becomes sustainable when farmers get fair prices.

Therefore, it is vital that the authorities have policies to protect the marginal and small farmers as they are the ones facing the brunt in volatility of prices, he said. The focus should be introducing technologies that are

eco-friendly and cost-effective to make agriculture more competitive and sustainable, he said. "While food production has gone up, food safety has

become an important issue now. It is related to public health," said Razzaque, stressing on mobilising farmers at the rural levels to disseminate updated knowledge.

Mike Robson, Food and Agriculture Organization's representative in Bangladesh, said social protection in agriculture means helping the poor farmers in need and that the government has a big role to play.

# No ambulance service for five months

The only ambulance of Savar Upazila Health Complex has been lying useless for the last five months as there is no driver, causing sufferings to patients, particularly in case of emergencies at night.

Hospital sources said the government allotted an ambulance and a driver for the health complex. However, there has been no driver after the previous driver, Foyez Uddin, died this May.

"At least 15 lakh people, mostly garment workers and poor families, live in Savar upazila. For them, government hospitals are very important. You can imagine how much patients have to suffer if it [the hospital] has no ambulance," said Hamid Ranju, 55, a freedom fighter who lives in Genda in Savar.

patients monthly on an average, said hospital sources.

"We have repeatedly informed the civil surgeon office about the problem but they are yet to give a solution," said Md Amzadul Haque,

resident medical officer of the hospital. The government rate for using an ambulance is between Tk 400 and Tk 600 for travelling to Dhaka from Savar, while private hospitals charge Tk 2,500 to Tk 4,000, said hospital sources. Government ambu-

lance service is free for pregnant women. One Md Mahbubur Rahman struggled to take his pregnant wife to Dhaka Medical College Hospital after the upazila health complex referred her, due to no ambulance service.

Civil Surgeon of Dhaka Abdul Malek Mridha said the entire health department is facing an acute shortage of drivers but they are working on a solution.
