Sector Commanders Forum holds fourth national convention

Demands broader activities of International Crimes Tribunal

Sector Commanders Forum (SCF) held its fourth national convention yesterday with a 15-point declaration, including a demand to strengthen and broaden the activities of the International Crimes Tribunal.

Several hundred freedom fighters and many pro-liberation organisations' members attended the convention at Dhaka University.

Points of the declaration include set-up of a special bench at the Supreme Court for quick disposal of appeals and review petitions of convicted war criminals, formation of tribunals in every division to quicken trials of war criminals and barring political parties of anti-liberation forces from participating in elections.

Freedom fighter and cultural activist M Hamid presented the declarations. Maj Gen (ret'd) KM Shafiqullah, Bir Uttam, who was the army chief when Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman was killed on August 15, 1975, chaired the convention.

"The aim of the forum is trial of war criminals," said KM Shafiqullah.

ABM Khairul Haque, chairman of Bangladesh Law Commission, said, "Not only war criminals, but perpetrators of any crime must be brought to book for establishment of law and order."

He also urged for preservation of the site where the Pakistani occupation force surrendered on December 16 as "Independence Square".

Sammilito Sangskritik Jote President Golam Kuddus, Bangladesh Peshajibi Samannay Parishad President Justice AFM Mesbah Uddin Ahmed, Sector Commanders Forum (SCF) Vice Chairman Abu Osman Chowdhury, and DU Pro-Vice Chancellor (education) Nasreen Ahmad delivered speeches among others.

A new central executive committee of Sector Commanders Forum was also formed at the end of the convention.

KM Shafiqullah was elected as chairman and Harun Habib was re-elected as secretary general of the forum.

Sector commanders Maj Gen (ret'd) CR Dutta, Bir Uttam; Lt Col (ret'd) Abu Osman Chowdhury, Bir Uttam; and Maj (ret'd) Rafiqul Islam, Bir Uttam; were elected as presidents.

Fakhrul leaves for S'pore again for treatment

BNP acting secretary general Mirza Fakhrul Islam Alamgir left Dhaka for Singapore again yesterday morning for treatment.

He along with his wife Rahat Ara Begum left Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport around 8:45am, Sayrul Kabir Khan, a staff of BNP chairperson's media wing told The Daily Star.

Fakhrul will receive treatment at the National University Hospital in Singapore for different health complexities.

He is scheduled to return home on October 21.

Earlier, after being released from jail six months after his arrest, Fakhrul went to Singapore for treatment at the same hospital on July 27.

Girl jumps off third floor to escape molestation

Claims family

A teenager fractured her spine as she jumped from the third floor of an under-construction building to save herself from a rogue in Chittagong city on Wednesday, on her birthday, claimed her family yesterday.

However, the accused, Abid, 19, who was arrested on Wednesday evening, claimed that the 14-year-old girl, whom he had an affair with, jumped off the roof because he was unable to marry her due to his unemployment.

According to the mother of the girl, a candidate of November's Junior School Certificate exam, she went to her tutor who resides on the ground floor of the building at Hamzar Bagh on that morning but Abid dragged her to the third floor and tried to molest her.

Hearing noise, her teacher came out and found the girl on the ground and informed her family which admitted her to the neurosurgery ward of Chittagong Medical College Hospital.

The mother further said Abid had been stalking her daughter since February and a month ago her elder son warned him not to repeat such an act.

Brother of the girl said Abid along with some accomplices went to the hospital on Wednesday afternoon and threatened them with dire consequences if the family took the matter to police. However, Abid told police that he was not even on the spot on that day and later he went to the hospital only to meet the girl. A case was filed. Mobarak Ali, councillor of ward no-7 of Chittagong City Corporation, said he learned from locals that Abid used to harass the girl.

Adolescent girls must be educated to reach SDGs

Adolescent girls must be provided with proper education, healthcare and other necessary opportunities to ensure their participation in the national economy as well as to achieve sustainable development goals, said speakers at a roundtable in Bogra town yesterday.

The roundtable on "Power of the adolescent girls: vision for 2030" was arranged jointly by The Daily Star and The United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) at Hotel Naz Garden.

Addressing as chief guest, law maker Md Habibur Rahman said guardians, teachers and political leaders should work together to stop child marriage in the country to pave the way of progress for the adolescent girls in order to include Bangladesh in the list of middle-income countries by 2021.

According to Bangladesh Demographic and Health Survey-2014, South Asia has the highest adolescent fertility rate which is 113 per 1,000 live births to women aged between 15 and 19 while Bangladesh has a higher adolescent birth rate than Nepal, Indonesia, Cambodia and India.

Superintendent of Police Md Asaduzzaman said girls should be given the chance to complete their education and flourish their potentials while violence against them should be stopped for enabling them to share family and other responsibilities equally.

There are many families which still prioritise sons over daughters and also neglect them. Such mentality should be changed, said speakers.

Media personality Jamil Ahmed moderated the event while National Programme Officer of UNFPA Dr Md Munir Hossain presented the key-note paper at the event attended by many government officials, NGO members, and civil society representatives.

6 Jamaat men held in Ctg city

Couple found dead in Rajshahi house

Police recovered the bodies of a couple from their Chandipur rented house in Rajshahi city yesterday.

Abdul Momin Shihab, 22, was a fourth year student of Islami Bank Medical Nursing College; and Sharmin Khatun, 19, was a second year student of Rajshahi Diabetic Association Nursing College.

Shihab of Naogaon was found hanging from the ceiling while Sharmin of Rajshahi from a window, said Mahmudur Rahman, officer-in-charge of Rajpara Police Station.

They had been living together in the house for three months claiming to landlord Mosharrif Hossain that they were married.

However, their marriage certificate was not available till filling of this report last evening.

Police recovered a note from the room in which the two said that they committed suicide as their families were against their relationship.

The bodies were sent to Rajshahi Medical College morgue for autopsy.
